Introduction

Part One of Deed Book D contains deeds recorded beginning February 8, 1831, through August 30, 1833. This book contains 230 pages and is bound.

Part Two of Deed Book D contains deeds made during the fall of 1851, and recorded with the Probate Judge during December of 1851, and January of 1852. Part Two consist of 28 pages. The pages are bound at the end of Deed Book F. Book F. contains deeds recorded beginning July 9, 1834 through October 30, 1835.

Abstract of Some Indentures in Part Two

Page 416. Hamlin Caldwell and T.R. Mattox of the Mercantile business at Bellefonte operating under the name of Caldwell, Mattox and Company, hold a mortgage on one bay mare with white feet. The mortgage was signed by William S. Brooks. The Heritage Center is the owner of one Caldwell and Mattox general journal for the year of 1953. Mr. Brook is listed as a charge customer.

Page 417. Joseph G. Dixon was the first Probate Judge of Jackson County. He was elected and provided bond in 1850. Prior to this time, the County Judge and Circuit Court Clerk were appointed by a joint vote of the General Assembly of Alabama.

Page 435. Mortgage held on undivided one-half of a sawmill on Riley's Creek. Moses Jones owned other half. Riley's Creek is located in Jones Cove.

Page 450. The last entry was dated October 30, 1851, and was continued on page 451. We may never know the full story of these pages.

Introduction

At the time these deeds were recorded, the land area of Jackson County, Alabama, was different from what it is today. The northern boundary was the Tennessee state line. The Tennessee River formed the eastern and southern boundaries from Long Island to the Paint Rock River. The Paint Rock River formed the western boundary to a point where the Old Cherokee School boundary line intersected the river. From this point the boundary on the west was the Cherokee boundary to the height of the land of Keel's Mountain. The western boundary then followed the meandering "height of the land" to the Tennessee state line near Huntland, Tennessee. The northern half of the western boundary was established by the Alabama Legislature in 1825 when Decatur County was abolished.

Sand Mountain, to the east and south, was a part of the Cherokee Nation until 1836. A few other interesting facts recorded in Deed Book F may be found in the appendix to this index.

Introduction

Part One of Deed Book D contains deeds recorded beginning February 8, 1831, through August 30, 1833. This book contains 230 pages and is bound.

Part Two of Deed Book D contains deeds made during the fall of 1851, and recorded with the Probate Judge during December of 1851, and January of 1852. Part Two consist of 28 pages. The pages are bound at the end of Deed Book F. Book F. contains deeds recorded beginning July 9, 1834 through October 30, 1835.

Abstract of Some Indentures in Part Two

Page 416. Hamlin Caldwell and T.R. Mattox of the Mercantile business at Bellefonte operating under the name of Caldwell, Mattox and Company, hold a mortgage on one bay mare with white feet. The mortgage was signed by William S. Brooks. The Heritage Center is the owner of one Caldwell and Mattox general journal for the year of 1953. Mr. Brook is listed as a charge customer.

Page 417. Joseph G. Dixon was the first Probate Judge of Jackson County. He was elected and provided bond in 1850. Prior to this time, the County Judge and Circuit Court Clerk were appointed by a joint vote of the General Assembly of Alabama.

Page 435. Mortgage held on undivided one-half of a sawmill on Riley's Creek. Moses Jones owned other half. Riley's Creek is located in Jones Cove.

Page 450. The last entry was dated October 30, 1851, and was continued on page 451. We may never know the full story of these pages.
