Recorded in Madison County, Alabama; original papers in Jackson County were destroyed by fire June, 1846. Sally Green, William Greene and John Greene, executors of estate of Burkett Green, deceased, Burgess McGaha, guardian of John Green and John Baker; Sarah the widow of Burkett Green. Inventory was made 7 January 1834, as authorized on 9 October 1833. Chancery Court Records, page 289.

Answer of John Green. In February 1827, Burkett Green, who was father of said executor by a former wife, married the complainant, who was then widow of -----Lanier. In the spring of the same year, they separated. Burkett Green died June, 1833. No issue from that marriage, but he left eight children by a former wife and two grandchildren, their mother being a daughter of Burkett Green, and who died before her father.

Answer of Ezekiel Craft and wife, Lucinda Craft; states that Burkett Green married Sarah, widow of John Lanier.

Deposition of Mary Lemley. States that John Lanier died about 1819; lived and died in Franklin County, Tennessee; in 1827, Lanier's will was proven in Madison County, Alabama with Thomas Vann, executor; she thinks Sarah Lanier was his sister (Thomas Vann's?)

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF JOHN McCUTCHEN

In the name of God, Amen, I, John McCutchen of the county of Jackson and State of Alabama being weak in body but sound kind and memory Thanks be to God, calling unto mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and order this my last will and testament, That is to say, principally, first of all, I give and recommend my soul unto the hand of Almighty God that give it and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my executors. That he, Walker McCutchen was left an orphan child and was reared by his grandfather, John McCutchen. John H Gray, now of Arkansas. States that Cassandra died in 1842. Heirs unknown.

January, 1854. Joseph McCutchen has died and his children's names are unknown. M.M. McCutchen, adm'r.

Revolutionary service of John McCutchen

McCutchen, John, soldier of American "evolution, aged 78 and a resident of Jackson County, Alabama; private N C Militia; enrolled on January 2, 1834, under act of Congress June 7, 1832, payment to date from March 4, 1831; annual allowance \$80." From Revolutionary Pension Roll in Vol. xiv, Sen. doc. 514, 23rd Congress, 1st sess. 1833-34.

OBITUARY OF JOHN McCUTCHEN

From Southern Advocate, Huntsville, Ala. Jan. 27, 1835

It is our unhappy lot to announce that another Hero is gone! Col. John McCutchen, who in times that tried men's souls stood boldly forth in defense of the liberty and independence of his country, bidding defiance not only to oppression, but confronting the armed myrmidons of the Tyrant, as on the 17th (inst) in the 80th year of his age, summoned to another and better world!

He engaged early in the Revolutionary conflict, was at the defense of Fort Moultrie, the battle at Eutaw Springs, and with a true, patriotic zeal, participated in all the perils and distress that so peculiarly characterized the unfeeling warfare, then waged throughout the Carolinas; nor did he retire until he had satisfaction of beholding the independence of his country, for which he had so long and ardently struggled, permanently secured.

Having devoted his youth to the service of his country in the field, in the maturity of manhood, he engaged with those fearless enterprising pioneers, who emigrating to the West, embarked in the arduous undertaking of reclaiming the fertile valley of the Tennessee from its then savage wilderness, and preparing it for the enjoyment of all the arts, luxuries and refinements of social life.

He has ever been noted as a man of uncommon intellectual

endowments- for the last forty years has been a christianity of the Baptist order, and been esteemed by all as a worthy example and an honor to his profession. Thus ripe in years and rich in consciousness of having at two different periods of his life, rendered important services to his country and in consoling hopes of a glorious immortality, the veteran has departed leaving his relatives and numerous friends to mourn his loss.

On Monday the 19th inst. as the citizens of this vicinity had convened to pay the last honors to the deceased, on motion of Maj. John B. Stevens, they constituted themselves into a meeting for the purpose of making a public manifestation of their grief, to acknowledge the services and express the high regard they have ever entertained for the principles of their departed friend, Col. James Smith was called to the chair and Maj. John B. Stevens appointed Secretary. When the following resolutions were unanimously adopted, vobz:

Resolvedm That under a deep sense of gratitude we owe to those sages and heroes who achieved our independence, we deem it a duty incumbent upon us, their sons, with a filial piety to pay every tribute of respect to their virtues and their valor, as the only remuneration in our power for the manifold rights and privileges that we now enjoy.

RESOLVED that in the death of Col. John McCutchen, we have to lament the loss of one of that bane of aged warriors,

whose presence never fails to enliven our zeal in the cause of liberty and to remind us of what it cost- that in him we have lost a firm patriot, a worthy citizen, a pious Christian and an esteemed friend. And while we respectfully acknowledge his public services, stern integrity and private worth, we deeply sympathize with his widow and other members of his family in their bereavement.

RESOLVED, that the above resolutions be signed by the Committee and Secretary and transmitted to the Democrat and the South Advocate for publication.

June, 1846 Suit filed by C C Clay versus William H. Moore, now of Talladega County, Alabama in the Circuit Court of Jackson County 19 January 1836. Speaks of land bought of the heirs of Daniel McDuff, late of Jackson County, deceased on 12 October 1833. Richard McDuff, one of the sons of said deceased, deft, and Mary G Moore and husband William H. Moore made the deed. Said defendant conveyed the land to Robt Freeman of Jackson Co.

Deed mentions land Moore bought from heirs of Wilder, who were also heirs of Daniel McDuff. George Swink was Clerk of the Circuit Court of Jackson County in 1836

Deed May 4, 1833 from Richard McDuff to William H Moore, witnessed by Thomas McCulloch, John Bain, Bryant B. Thompson, Richard B. Clayton, clerk of county court, also Moses Jones, clerk of circuit court and Thompson M. Rector, Judge of County Court.

Answer of John McDuff, a son of Richard McDuff, deceased. States that the lands of Daniel McDuff were divided into four lots and he doesn't know which one fell to Richard. Sworn before William A. Ladden, J. P. 9 June 1840

Citation issued to Polly M'Duff, Matthew M'Duff, Richard R. M'Duff, Parmina M'Duff and Harriet M'Duff. 4 August 1840. Also, citation issued to James M'Duff, James Shelton and wife, Ruth Shelton. 4 Aug. 1840

Heirs at law of Richard R. McDuff and Jesse Shelton, which said ~~and~~ Jesse Shelton was and is the husband of one of them, the said Richard R. McDuff having died intestate. Citation issued to John McDuff and James McDuff. 6 August 1841.

Citations issued to Polly, Matthew, Richard W, Harriet and Parmina, heirs at law of Richard McDuff, deceased, who are under 21 years of age. 6 Aug. 1841.

Citations issued 15 Dec. 1841 to Jesse Shelton and wife, Ruth Shelton and Elizabeth McDuff, mother and only surviving

parent of the infants named above, who reside in Jackson Co. Ala.

Copy of deed from Moore to Freeman; land described as being in Jackson County, lots 2 and 3, assigned to William F. McDuff and Richard McDuff, ~~xxx~~ two of the legatees of Daniel McDuff, deceased. 1 Feb. 1836. Deposition of Samuel Geron states that Daniel McDuff died in the spring of 1832. Richard R. McDuff, his son, was said to have been killed by the Indians in Florida in 1837, Samuel Geron states he was one of the commissioners to divide land of Daniel McDuff. 26 May 1842.

Deposition of George W. Justice, same day. William L. ~~xxx~~ Compton judge of Co. Court. 9 Sept. 1841

William F. McDuff, one of the heirs at law of Daniel McDuff, deceased division of real estate ^{between} ~~between~~ himself and Richard R. McDuff, Bryant B. Thompson and wife, Harriet Thompson and the minor heirs and children of Elizabeth Wilder, deceased. viz: Bathaniel, Nancy, and William, James E. Daniel, John Lewis, Cannon (Kennon) Harris, Samuel Geron and Willis Ellett, commissioners to divide land.

December, 1841. Jesse Corn and wife, Margaret Corn versus
Samuel Tipton. Suit filed June 6, 1836 in Circuit Court of
Jackson County, Alabama on Chancery side. States that on June
8, 1808, one James Tate of Pendleton District, S C made a deed
to slaves to his grandchildren, the children of his youngest
daughter, Elizabeth T. Thompson, which she then had with her by
her marriage with one Farley Thompson, or should later have,
The oratrix was one of the children. When said deed was made,
said Elizabeth T. Thompson was living in the state of Georgia. In
1815, she and her husband, Farley Thompson removed to Madison
County, Mississippi Territory (now Alabama) and in 1819, Farley
Thompson died, leaving considerable property. No administration
was ever granted on his estate. In 1823, all moved to Jackson
County, Alabama. On 25 December 1825 (oratrix still a minor)
the oratrix, said Margaret Thompson married William F. Rawlins,
since deceased. One Ann C. Thompson (now ~~Margaret~~ Hargiss) one of the
children of said Elizabeth T. Thompson of age at that time.
Rawlins and wife went to Franklin County, Tennessee to his
father's, then to the Western District of Tennessee, where he
died in 1829. The oratrix went back to his father's where she
stayed until 1831, when she married the orator, Jesse Corn, and
returned to Jackson County, Alabama. Tipton had her slave, which

A demurrer of Samuel Tipton and wife (note: it isn't clear that Samuel Tipton's wife is a daughter of Elizabeth T. Thompson, but she may have been). Lyman James was Justice of Peace in Jackson County, Alabama in 1826. Shortly after the suit was brought against William F. Rawlins, Lyman James died. John H. Sneed and wife, Elizabeth Sneed, are out of the state, Abram Hargiss and wife, Ann Hargiss, Samuel, Margaret and Drury Thompson were all minors in 1825.

CUNNINGHAM versus CUNNINGHAM, bill for divorce. June, 1842
Suit brought 4 September 1838 in Jackson County, Alabama by Margaret Cunningham, formerly Shepperd, by her mother and next friend, Nancy Shepperd versus James Cunningham. States she married him on 27th of September last, while on a visit to Bedford County, Tennessee. She lacked several months of being seventeen years old. He ran away within a month to Holly Springs, Mississippi, where she is advised he lived with a lawful wife.

She thinks he has now left for parts unknown. From Chancery Court Records, also recorded in Madison Co. Ala.

June, 1841. Henry Norwood and John G. Chambers of Jackson County, Alabama made a note to Alexander Riddle of the same County, 1 January 1837. From Chancery Records recorded in Madison Co. Ala.

WOODALL FAMILY

Compiled from data furnished by Mr. Emmett Woodall, Huntsville, Ala., Mr. Howard Woodall, Dallas, Texas and Mr. P.H. Woodall, Woodville, Ala. in the year 1933.

Willis Woodall and his wife, Cara or Cary ^{Johnson} emigrated from Virginia (Franklin County apparently) to Alabama some time before 1840, traveling by ox team, down the Blue Ridge into Tennessee, thence to Marshall County, Alabama, settling in the sinks at Big Flat Rock near Old Center Church House between New Hope and the south and of Kennamer Cove, near Grantm Alabama, nine miles south of Woodville, Alabama. Later, about 1846, they moved west of Woodville, Alabama near the railroad; Cara boarded one of the ~~formen~~^{men} of the construction crew which built the Memphis & Charleston (now the Southern) Railway; this was about 1849. The date of death of Willis Woodall is not known but it was probably about ¹⁸³⁰1863; he is buried four miles southeast of Woodville on the old Jacob Kennamer place now owned by Denton Kennamer. Cary Woodall died August 6, 1868 as there is a charge against her estate (administered in Madison County) showing this. Issue:

Woodall as administrator of the estate ^{of} Stephen Kennamer, deceased, Charlotte Peters, Martha Smith, wife of William Smith, children of her deceased daughter, Molly Kennamer; 1 share to Salathiel and Presley Woodall, children of her deceased son, John Woodall.

SOME REVOLUTIONARY PENSIONERS OF JACKSON COX ALA.

William Fletcher Revolutionary War Claim S 32249. States he was born in 1758 in Stafford County, Virginia. While a resident of Wilkes County, North Carolina, he enlisted in 1778 and served seven short tours at various times as Captain under Colonels Benjamin Cleveland, Joseph Herndon, E. Isaacs and Francis Locke in the North Carolina Troops; was taken prisoner date not stated, but escaped the same night. He served in all one year and nine months. He moved from Wilkes County, N C to Georgia, date not stated and from Georgia to South Carolina, thence to Kentucky, and from Kentucky to Tennessee and in 1818 to Jackson County, Alabama in which county he was living while allowed pension on his application dated October 3, 1832. He died November 27, 1837 leaving a widow Patsy, whose maiden name is not stated.

Daniel McDuff applied June 1, 1830 for a pension at the age of 731 was a resident of Madison County, Alabama when application was made. He was in South Carolina line. Placed on Pension Rolls June 1, 1830. Died March 26, 1831. MW F McDuff, adm'r.

John Morris Pension Claim S 31868. Act of June 7, 1832; North Carolina service; Alabama Agency at Huntsville; Jackson County, Alabama 3 October 1832. W.L.Compton, one of the Justices of the County Court, sitting at Bellefonte. John Morris, aged 68, born in Halifax County, North Carolina August 31, 1764; enlisted at Rowan County, North Carolina 1781, officers being Colonel Locke, Captain Carson, Captain Coal, Colonel Loftin. Character witnesses were Charles L. Roach, clergyman, Benjamin Matthews and Joshua Browning.

Nancy Jagers widow of Jeremiah Jagers makes application for widows pension June 29, 1859, aged 83, a resident of Jackson County, Alabama. States she was married to Jeremiah Jagers in Chester District, South Carolina April 13, 1791 by one John Lewis, Baptist preacher and her maiden name was Ceherry. Her husband died in Madison County, Alabama in 1832. She had friends to vouch for her as follows: Elizabeth Sanderson and William Carnes.

Jeremiah Jagers application was made in Madison County, Alabama June 30, 1818.

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
