Note - Here is a News clipping from The Citizen, a paper that was published in Scottsboro, Jackson county, Alabama in 1883. This item bears the date of June the 7th, 1883. -

"Among our callers this week was Mr. R. C. T. Gill, who lives three miles from Fackler. He published about the first paper in Jackson County, the old "Bellefonte Democrat," way back in the halcyon days of 1846. He continued his paper up to a few years before the War when he sold it to Frazier & Jones - the paper was destroyed by the Federalists during the war. Mr Gill bought a farm and has been farming ever since he quit the newspaper business. He is a good farmer, and is highly respected in his community.

Another clipping from "The Citizen" date of August 30th - 1883, has this: Esquire R. C. T. Gill, requests us to announce that quarterly meeting will be held in the new Methodist church at Kyles' Springs, on the 7th of September. The meeting will be protracted. (He was about 58 years of age at this time). Where is he buried(?). If in this cemetery, he has no stone to mark his grave.






CHANNEY'S CHAPEL METHODIST CHURCH

Chaney's Chapel Methodist Church is located in the Hodge Community between Section, Ala. and Dutton, Ala. in Jackson County. The cemetery is well kept but has a few broken stones. The layout of the graves are sometimes haphazard in that they are not always in line which made for some difficulty in copying.

The cemetery was copied on February 20, 1977 by James W. and Doris McAlpin Russell. Every effort was made to be accurate and complete. In some cases the data was scratched on fieldstones and was very difficult to read.

Each row was indexed from north to south - the exception being the last row which is across the service road (Row 17). On Row 17 indexing was begun at the north boundary of the cemetery and followed the curvature of the road.

There were a few cases where it appeared that more than one marker existed for the same person or couple. In those cases both markers were copied - this is not a mistake in indexing.
