"MATTHEW WASHINGTON ran away from home in Virginia where he was reared by an uncle, and came to Alabama when about 16 years of age. He began working as a tailor for D. M. Martin at Bellefonte, Alabama. He later married Catharine Walker and thereby came by money. He did go back to Virginia and get some money and four slaves about the time he and Catharine Walker married in 1831. This was his part following a death of an estate.

Their daughter Mary Elizabeth was born in 1832 and died later.

The parents of Matthew Washington, were William Washington and his wife was a Hall. The father of William Washington was Samuel.

The family Bible was burned when the old Washington home was destroyed by fire.

Matthew Washington married Catharine Walker, daughter of William Walker and Mary Carrack. William Walker's mother was Mary Lawrence.
