John Lindsay, b. 12 May 1789, in Rutherford County, North Carolina, married Martha Ledford, born 27 Dec 1778, Rowan County, NC, died in Larkinsville, Alabama and buried in Blue Springs Cemetery, Larkinsville.

John Lindsay moved to Texas about 1851 and died there at Tyler, Titus County, Texas, buried David Snodgrass Cemetery, Titus County. He died 7 Sept 1853.

His second wife was Nancy Walker by whom he had more children. See full details in Volume 34, Jackson County Records by Christine Sumner, Scottsboro Jackson County Heritage Center, Scottsboro, Alabama.

Martha was the daughter of John H. Ledford, Jr. and his wife Elizabeth Bryant.

Biography

Peter G. Ledford was born in 1758 in Randolph County, North Carolina^[1]. Although there is no record to show whom his parents were, it is believed that his father was John Ledford who was in Augusta County, Virginia as early as 1738. This may not be correct as the records are fairly scarce, but it would seem to be the case as will be shown below. As it is, Peter grew up on Caraway Creek in what would become Randolph County.

The first mention of Peter in historical records is in 1779, when he appears on the tax list of Randolph County with 13 acres of land, two hogs and six head of cattle; taxed 460 Pounds Sterling^[2]. This land was adjacent to John Ledford. Having his own farm with animals leads me to believe that he was married by this time. The next reference I find for Peter is a land deed in 1789 in which John Ledford, Sr. sold to Peter 40 acres on Big Caraway Creek, which bordered on his other land on Little Caraway^[3]. This is circumstantial, but the reasoning behind why John is most likely Peter's father.

Peter was married about 1779 in Randolph County, NC to Anne Tucker (or Martha Y. Thomass?)^[4]. This date is unattested, based on the (1) the births of Peter's children, (2) Peter's age being 21 so unlikely he was married prior to this time, and (3) Peter's appearance in the tax records with land and livestock in 1779 indicating he was ready to start a family.

On 1 Mar 1781, Peter joined the Revolutionary effort as a trooper in the Company of Cavalry and served for six months as a private. Most of his service was spent in pursuit

of a Toy colonel by the name of Thomas Fanning who terrorized the citizens of central North Carolina. He wasn't caught while Peter was serving, but they did their best. For his service, Peter was given back pay of \$66.30 and an allowance of \$26.52 per year from 1833 on^[1]. From then life seems to have been relatively peaceful for Peter and his family.

In 1789 he purchased 40 acres adjoining his other thirteen acres on Caraway from John Ledford, Sr. He sold this land to Elizabeth Fouts in August 1792^[3]. The following year he applied for 320 acres in Burke County, NC, on the North Cove of North Fork of the Catawba River^[5]. This land is now in McDowell County.

In 1805 Peter was ordered by the Court to oversee the road from the forks of the Pleasant Gardens (on the Catawba River) to the Pigeon River^[6]. Generally only men of some importance were given this duty, so I've been told. Also, between 1805 and 1820 Peter appears often in the juror lists of Burke County^[7].

In 1813, Peter purchased 100 acres on Tom's Creek between Marion and Pleasant Gardens, McDowell County, which he then sold 1823^[5]. That same year Peter is shown buying 56 acres on the Little Tennessee River in the newly opened land of Macon County. He and his wife stayed here for 15 years, until the removal of the Cherokees further west. Peter sold his land on the Tennessee River to James Bradley on 5 Aug 1837.

In 1838, an auction was held to sell the land that had previously been inhabited by the Cherokee. Peter purchased 76 acres in District 3, tract 187 for \$39.52^[8]. This is the land on which both he and his wife later died^[9]. In studying the census records from 1790 through 1820, Peter and Anne had five sons and three or four daughters. Three of the daughters and one son are unknown.

Family tradition states that in the final years of his life Peter was living with his son Jason D. Ledford. He died 22 May 1848 in Cherokee County, NC and was buried in the Old Ledford Chapel Cemetery^[10], which supposedly was on his land. When Lake Chatuge was built in the 1940's, the cemetery would have been flooded so it was moved across the road to higher ground.

Timeline

1758 - Peter was born *some time in the year 1758*, in Rowan County, North Carolina as he testified in his application for pension for Revolutionary War service in 1833. He goes on to state, "I have no record of my age, nor never had." [1]

1779 - Peter is listed in the 1779 tax list of the newly formed county of Randolph, North Carolina with a small amount of land and some livestock. [2] This land is later shown to be on Little Caraway Creek. Peter should have been married about this time.

1789 - Peter purchases 40 acres from John Ledford, Sr on Caraway Creek in Randolph County. [3] The deed states that this land adjoined his other 13 acres crossing Little Caraway, placing Peter and John Ledford Sr. at the confluence of the Little Caraway with Caraway Creek.

1790 - Peter is enumerated in the census of Randolph County, North Carolina [11]. His household consists of two male age 16 and over (1784 and before), two male age under 16 years (1784-1790) and three females.

1792 - Peter sells 40 acres to Elizabeth Fouts [3]. I don't have a sale of the other 13 acres.

1793 - Peter applied for 320 acres in Burke County, NC, on the North Cove of North Fork of the Catawba River [5], now located in McDowell County.

1800 - In the 1800 census, Peter is living in Burke County, North Carolina [12] age of 26 and under 45 years (1755-1774) with his wife of the same age, one daughter and two sons of age ten and under 16 years (1784-1790; one son is Eli), and one daughter and two sons age under ten years (1790-1800; sons are Peter Jr and Levi).

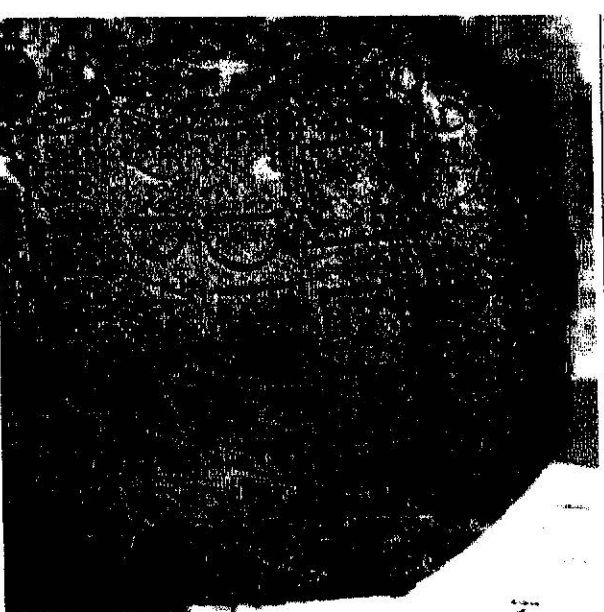
1810 - Peter is still living in Burke County, North Carolina in the 1810 census [13] age over 45 years (1765 or before) along with his wife of the same age. Also in the household are one daughter and one son age of 16 and under 26 years (1784-1794), two sons age of ten and under 16 years (1794-1800; Peter Jr and Levi), and one son age of under ten years (1800-1810; Jason D.).

1813 - Peter purchased 100 acres on Toms Creek in present McDowell County [5]. Toms Creek flows into the Catawba River between Marion and Pleasant Gardens.

1820 - The 1820 census has Peter living in Burke County, North Carolina [14] age over 45 years (1775 or before) with his wife of the same age and one son age of 16 and

under 26 years (1794-1804; Jason D.) and one daughter? age of ten and under 16 (1804-1810).

1823 - Peter sells land on Toms Creek and buys 56 acres near the Little Tennessee River in what will become Macon County, North Carolina in 1828.

1830 - Peter is now in Macon County, North Carolina^[15], age of 70 and under 80 years (1750-1760) with his wife, age of 60 and under 70 (1760-1770). No children in the household.

1833 - Peter files for pension for service in the American Revolution^[11] in Jun 1833, Macon County, North Carolina. He was awarded \$66.30 back pay and \$26.52 per year after that in semi-annual payments. They did not mail payments to veterans at that time. The veteran had to travel to the nearest office and appear in person, or have an agent appear on his behalf. The nearest office, I believe, was in Asheville.

1836 - Peter purchased an unknown tract in the 1836 sale of Cherokee lands^[16].

1837 - Having purchased land in the yet unopened county of Cherokee, Peter sold his Macon lands to James Bradley, James' daughter Elizabeth was married to Peter's son Jason.

1838 - Peter purchases 76 more acres at the Cherokee Land Sale^[8] in September 1838. There were other entries under his name (or that of his son) which were let go soon after winning the bid.

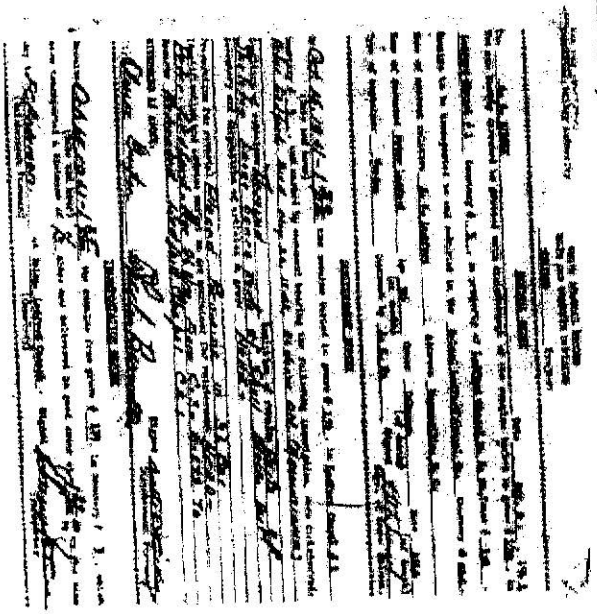
1840 - Peter has settled into his new land in the new county of Cherokee, North Carolina and appears on the census^[17] this year age of 80 and under 90 years (1750-1760) with his wife of the same age. **Note that Peter's wife is still alive** in this and the previous census indicating that she had not passed away in 1824. In this census, the exact ages of pensioners were given; Peter was 86 years old (1754).

1844 - Peter's wife NY dies in Cherokee County, North Carolina on 24 Jun 1844. She was buried in the Old Ledford Chapel Cemetery.

1847 - Peter collected his Revolutionary War pension for the last time in the 4th quarter of 1847.^[18]

1848 - Peter dies in Cherokee County, North Carolina 22 May 1848 and was buried next to his wife in the Old Ledford Chapel Cemetery. Both he and his wife were later relocated to the Relocated Ledford Chapel Cemetery, across the street from the old one, in 1941.

Generally, in more recent years, there have been a few Ledfords who have been attached to Peter G. Ledford the Revolutionary soldier. It should be pointed out that to date there are no documents from Peter's time to indicate with certainty whom his children actually were. What we have to go on is older clues from people who lived in his era.

In the 1860's, Peter Ledford, Jr. attempted to collect more money from Peter Sr.'s pension, to no avail. In his letters to the War Department he states that he is the son of Peter Ledford (Senior).^[1]

In historical records, Jason D. is usually living quite close to Peter Senior, it is known that he went to Tennessee with Peter Junior^[19], and family tradition claims that Peter lived with Jason in his last years^[20]. On top of that, Jason's daughter Matilda Crumley, in the 1920's, also attempted to draw on Peter's pension, as "Peter's only surviving grandchild"^[1], and in the late 1930's, when the TVA was preparing to move Peter's grave they needed an heir to sign off, John E. Ledford, son of Merritt Daniel, son of Jason D., was that heir^[21]. All circumstantial, really, but then Jason was buried next to Peter in the cemetery (original and relocated)

In the 1890's, descendants of Eli and Levi Ledford, brothers, applied for Cherokee pensions on the claim that Levi's wife, Jerusha Pittman, was part Cherokee. Eli's family gets involved because their children intermarried. In these applications, they claim that both Eli and Levi were the sons of Peter Ledford and Annie Tucker. The oldest applicant was Elbert Burton Ledford, born in 1828, son of Levi, who would have been old enough to have personally known his grandmother, who died in 1844 when Elbert was 16 years old.^[22]

Then there is Ellender Ledford who married Thomas Knight. Thomas was the son of Jonathan Knight, and when Peter moved to Burke County in 1792 and purchased his land, the deed showed a map of the property that also happened to show that both Thomas and Jonathan owned adjoining properties. This isn't conclusive, but the best we have to go on.

Using the above statements by children and grandchildren and the census records for Peter Ledford Sr between 1790 and 1820, one can put together a fairly reasonable picture of Peter's family:

1. Daughter born before 1790, not at home in 1800; **Ellender Ledford** if she is actually a child of Peter.
2. Son born 1784-1790, left home between 1800-1810; **Eli Ledford**.
3. Son born 1784-1790, left home between 1810-1820; unknown (Absolom fits).
4. Daughter born 1784-1790, left home between 1800-1810; unknown.
5. Daughter born 1790-1794, left home between 1810-1820; unknown.
6. Son born 1794-1800, left home between 1810-1820; **Levi Ledford**.
7. Son born 1794-1800, left home between 1810-1820; **Peter Ledford, Jr.**
8. Son born 1800-1804, still at home in 1820; **Jason D. Ledford** who wasn't married until 1824.
9. Female born 1810-1820, not in 1810 census, but in 1820 as 10-16 years, so if Peter's daughter, born 1810. Unlikely that Anne was still having children at age 50, so this girl is more likely to be a grandchild of Peter.

Hello, my name is C. Stiles

My mother was a Ledford whose family came from Clay County, N.C. Our first known ancestor was a William Ledford born 1685 - 1690 in England. There is a story of a William Ledford's living near the Scottish border around a town called Dundee on the Irish Sea. They were farmers and the land was pretty good but the Ledford sons decided to make their way to America. A sea captain named John Patton sailed out of ports there on the Irish Sea. He made a business of transporting people across to America in order to get land for themselves. In 1738, Patton docked the ship Walpoole at a harbor in Lancaster. When he left, bound for Virginia, he took Henry Ledford, age 18, William Ledford age 16 and John Ledford age 14 as his indentured servants. They agreed to work for him for seven years to pay for their passage to America. After the trip across the Atlantic they arrived at a port on the Roanoke River called Belhaven. They set out on an overland journey to Patton's plantation what was then called Augusta County Virginia. This was a huge area of land which is now divided into several Virginia and West Virginia counties. By the time the Ledford brothers had worked off their seven years they were all married. Patton was settling more land further down the Shenandoah Valley to the southwest. The Ledford brothers went with Patton buying land along the west fork of the Roanoke River near Bradshaw. (Deeds are recorded for all three brothers in Augusta County Virginia. Their land was located about 10 miles east of the town of Backsburg, present day Montgomery County Virginia. The Ledford family left Virginia because of Indian uprisings. Many of their neighbors were migrating down the great Carolina road to Rowan County north Carolina area. (Elder brother Henry and Patton both were killed by Indians in Virginia.)

When the other Ledford families arrived in the large county of Rowan they settled a good distance from each other. The two remaining brothers and Henry's 3 sons, Stadhah, Henry and Frederick settled on Abbott's Creek. Smaller counties were carved from the larger Rowan county. John's land was included in first Guilford, then Randolph County. William's land remained in Rowan until well after his death when it later became Davidson County. Our line of Ledford descended from the youngest brother John.

John Ledford had been born in Lancaster, North England in 1724 In America he

marked as the only one still living in Virginia in 1745. They had 9
known children. One died without leaving a will it is hoped all
his descendants are known.

County, North Carolina, and died May 22, 1848 in Scrougetown, Clay County, North Carolina. He married MARTHA YOUNG THOMAS Abt. 1790 in Randolph County, North Carolina. She was born Abt. 1760 in Maryland???, and died June 24, 1844 in Scrougetown, Clay County, North Carolina.

Notes for PETER G. LEDFORD, SR.:

Peter G. Ledford, Sr. served as a private in the continental line of the American Revolution. His Pension #S7146 was granted for service in the American Revolution.

The first mention of Peter in public records is in the year 1779, in the Randolph county, NC tax list. He is listed with thirteen acres improved land, two hogs, and six head of cattle, for a total of 460 pounds taxable. The fact that Peter was living in his own house in 1779 leads me to believe that he had married by this time. Peter's wife is another name which is not definitely known. Her tombstone in the old Ledford's cemetery reads either N.Y. or M.Y. One source gives her name as Martha Y. Thomas, daughter of Richard Thomas though I find no proof of this. I, perhaps mistakenly, took the "Y." as being her maiden name, there being Yount families in close proximity to the Ledfords since 1755. Then I came across some depositions made by some Ledfords in 1908. One made by Margaret Williamson, born 1847, claimed that her mother was the daughter of Levi Ledford, and her father was the son of Eli Ledford, both being sons of Peter G. Ledford and his wife Annie Conseene. Levi was born in 1797, and Eli about 1784. Then another deposition by William Pressfield Ledford, born 1838, claimed to be the son of Levi Ledford and his wife Jerusha Pittman, Levi being the son of Peter Ledford and Annie Tucker. Another deposition by Elbert Burton Ledford, born in 1824, states that he is the son of Levi and Jerusha Ledford, Levi being the son of Peter Ledford and Annie Tucker, then at a later date, he filed an affidavit claiming his grandmother's name to be Annie Conacene, though this document was signed with a mark, where the earlier application was signed with a full name. There were Tuckers living near the Ledfords since 1755 also, and in light of this evidence, it seems logical to say that Peter's wife was Annie Tucker. In 1768, in the Carraway Creek area of Rowan county, there were three Ledford families listed in the tax list:

Nicholas Ledford, John Ledford with his son John, and William Ledford living with Samuel Tucker. There were also three Tucker families: the Samuel named above, Robert Tucker (living near Jacob Yount), and George Tucker with his sons William and Nathan. This George Tucker was listed in the 1759 Rowan taxes, and most likely, Robert and Samuel are his sons.

The next reference I find for Peter is a land deed in 1789, in Randolph County, for the purchase of forty acres from John Ledford, Sr. on Big Carraway creek bordering his other land to Little Carraway. He later sold this same tract to Elizabeth Fouts in August 1792. This deed shows that Peter and John were living on land bordering each other, which may be a good reason to assume that John senior was his father, as often a man would divide his land among his children.

He is then listed in the 1790 census for Randolph County living in the same community as Frederick Ledford, John Ledford Senior and Junior, another Frederick and several Younts. Living in Peter's household were his wife and two daughters, two sons, both under the age of sixteen, and another male over the age of sixteen.

In 1793, Peter applied for 320 acres of land in Burke county, North Carolina, this land was located on the head of the North Cove of the North Fork of the Catawba River. In 1805, the Court of Pleas and Quarter Sessions ordered that Peter would oversee the road from the forks of the Pleasant Garden to the Pigeon River. Generally, only men of importance were assigned this duty. Between 1805 and 1820, he appeared often in the Burke county jurors lists. The 1805 Burke county tax list, has Peter with 200 acres and just himself taxable, and listed next to him is another Peter Ledford with no acres and just

himself as taxable [taxables were only the males over sixteen.] The 1815 Burke county tax list has Peter along with Eli and Samuel Ledford all living on Tom's Creek. This 100 acres on Tom's Creek was purchased in 1813, with Levi Ledford as a chain-bearer. Later that same year Edward Ledford purchased fifty acres on Tom's creek with Eli Ledford as a chain-bearer.

In February of 1823, Peter purchased fifty-six acres on the Little Tennessee River in Macon county, and then in 1838, he bought seventy-six acres in district #3 of Cherokee county for forty dollars. This tract of land is the same on which he later died. Family history passed down through the generations states that he was living with his son, Jason D. Ledford, when he died. He is buried at the old Ledford's chapel cemetery, which was also on his land. The land on which the church and cemetery are was donated by Samuel Ledford.

Peter's grave stone reads:

96Y.OALD

PETER:LD

E:DE:MAY

22DA:1848

REVOLUTIONER

This appears to say that Peter died 22 May 1848 at the age of 96 years. Something is wrong here, either his age, which would have been ninety in 1848, or the date of his death. A much more recent stone gives his birth date and death dates as 4 March 1758 and 13 Oct 1854, respectively. How these dates were arrived at is unknown. His wife's original stone reads:

M.Y. LEDFORD

JUN 24 184-

The year appears to be 1844, though the stone is very worn. The newer stone gives her date of death as June 24, 1828. In June of 1833, Peter applied for a pension for service in the Revolutionary War. His application named him as Peter Ledford, Senior of Macon county, North Carolina, about seventy-four years old. It stated that he entered service on the first day of March, 1781 as a trooper in the Company of Cavalry, and served his entire six months as a private. Most of his service was spent in pursuit of a Tory colonel named Thomas Fanning in Randolph and adjoining counties, along the River Pee Dee, and along the border of South Carolina. Following his application was a questionnaire which was filled out by him, in which he gives the statement

"I was born in Randolph County North Carolina some time in the year 1758," and that he had no record of his age "nor never had." This questionnaire was followed by a statement from Rev. Amos Curtis and John Howard affirming the above information. He was given a back payment of \$66.30 and an allowance of \$26.52 per year for his service.

Now comes the issue of Peter's children. A reconstruction arrived at by the censuses shows that his family would have looked something like this:

None of the daughters' names are known for sure, but it has been proposed that he had a daughter named Samantha born in 1776, and that she died in 1860. There may also be other children, as I don't have the 1810 census at my disposal, this leaves a gap of twenty years in which a couple children may have been born and been married before the 1820 census. I will now list those men who are claimed to have been Peter's sons.

I. Peter G. Ledford, Jr: born between 1784-1796. He married Anna M.

II. William H. Ledford: born about 1796?

III. Jason D. Ledford: born 11 Oct 1798. He married Nancy Elizabeth Bradley on 22 Jan 1824, in

Haywood county, North Carolina. She was the daughter of James and Elizabeth Bradley. Both died after 1880 in Clay county, NC.

I. Eli Ledford: born about 1784. He married Hannah, who may have been a Cherokee, about 1809/10. He died sometime between 1840 and 1850 in Cherokee county, NC. Hannah was still living in 1850.

V. Levi Ledford: born about 1797. He married Jerusha Pittman and moved to Gilmer county, Georgia sometime after 1840.

Peter Ledford, Jr. is an obvious candidate for Peter's son. William H. is not so obvious. According to the 1850 census of Cherokee county, NC, there was a William Ledford, age 56 living there with his wife Ellender. I'm not sure who associated him with this family, or how he came to be placed as a son of Peter.

A long standing oral tradition states that Jason D. is the son of Peter, and that Peter was living with Jason when he died. Peter and Jason were also buried near each other, with only Jason's wife between them. In the 1920's, Elizabeth Crumley, the daughter of Jason, wrote to the U.S. War Dept. to inquire about her grandfather's Pension, and named Peter as her grandpa.

Thomas has been claimed to be both the son of Peter by some people, and the son of John Ledford by others. In 1936, Ellis Smith, who was 78 years old at the time, made the following statement-- that John Ledford came to Cherokee county from Buncombe county sometime before the Indians left (in 1838) and settled on Licklog creek. John's children as well as Ellis could remember were

William Ledford who married a Sanderson,

John Ledford who married Sallie Israel,

Amos Ledford who settled on Shooting Creek,

Thomas Ledford who married Eliza Tanner,

Samuel Ledford who married Phoebe Dunn,

Center Ledford who settled on Sweetwater,

Benjamin Ledford,

Elizabeth Ledford who married William Leatherwood,

and another daughter who married William Spring.

Eli and Levi are attested as children of Peter's by their grandchildren and two of Levi's Sons, Elbert and William P. In 1908, Elbert, William, and about thirty other descendants of Eli and Levi's filled out applications to obtain allotments for having Cherokee blood. In these applications Eli and Levi are named as sons of Peter Ledford and Annie Tucker (or Conscene). There were three Peter Ledfords mentioned in early records. This Peter, born in 1758, his son Peter, Jr., who would have been too young to father either Eli or Levi, and the third Peter, nephew of our Peter, was born about 1775/6. He may have been old enough to be the father of Levi, born in 1796, but Eli was born about 1785. Besides, this Peter wasn't married until about 1804, and then he moved up to Yancey County. Eli and Levi were always associated closely with Peter G Ledford where ever he went.

In 1829, Macon County, North Carolina Peter G. Ledford was selected for jury duty in the June 1829 Court Session. It was customary that only prominent land owners were called for such duty.

Buried at Ledford's Chappel Cemetery, Scrougetown, Clay County, North Carolina.
