## **Wood-Rutherford Families**

#### WOOD-RUTHERFORD FAMILIES

The Sumner connection to the Wood family was through Susan Mariah Wood, wife of James Exum Sumner Jr.

I have done very little research on the Wood family but I found the following in Volume 2, p. 1, Annie Coleman Proctor Collection, Scottsboro Public Library, Scottsboro, Alabama:

Rev. T. J. Wood was a minister of the Gospel and was born in 1798 in South Carolina according to the 1850 census records. He died after a brief illness on Monday morning the 3rd of November, 1884, aged 86 years.

The wife of T. J. Wood was Maria-Mary-Mariah Rutherford, daughter of Archibald Rutherford and his wife (Barabara?). Her father died in 1814 in Cocke County, Tennessee, then his wife came to Jackson County, Alabama and lived with her daughter. She died in (1824?).

Maria Wood was born 26 February 1802 in Tennessee (Cocke County?) and married T. J. Wood (Cocke Co., Tenn.?) 24 February 1818, died on Tuesday, 11 October 1887 at her residence in Scottsboro, Jackson County, Alabama. They were the parents of 15 children. Twelve of these children were still living when their mother died. Below is a list of their names as I have record of them:

John M. D. Wood was also a minister of the Gospel and always lived in Jackson County, Alabama. He married twice. In the 1850 census he was living in his own home with his first wife and four children that had been born to them by 1850. He was listed as John W. Wood and was called "Uncle Johnny." He was age 31, a farmer born in Tennessee. His wife was Margaret (Barclay) age 29 born in Alabama. Their children were William, Mary M., John Calvin (called Jack) and James ages 7, 6, 5, 1, respectively, all born in Alabama. Deborah Wood, a daughter of this couple must have been born after the 1850 census. She married J. Harve Cunningham as his first wife and she died on 15 February 1870 and I suppose is buried in Woods Cove Cemetery but no tombstone.

Mrs. Gordon Young tells me that her father, John Calvin Wood died at the age of 35 with lung disease (consumption). She knows nothing about his sister Mary or brothers William or James, so they must have died young. She has no Bible records of her grandparents, John M. D. Wood or anything. John Calvin Wood married Prudence Wilson and they had three children: Hettie married Mack Finney, Donald married Etta Pierce and Eva married Gordon Young.

Note by Mrs. Proctor; Information given to me by Mrs. Don Cunningham of Scottsboro on this family:

Uncle Johnny Wood (John M. D. Wood) and Aunt Jennie Benson Wood (his second wife) gave 2 acres of land for Randall's Chapel Church where it now stands and Mrs. Cunningham has the deeds to it in her possession. Jennie Benson Wood lived at Langston, Jackson County, Alabama and is buried there.

Browder Wood lived at the George Baker homeplace. Mrs. Ida Law's husband's mother was a Wood.

Thomas Browder Wood estate--Book D, p. 27, 491, Jackson County, Alabama; Will Book 1, p. 213, 1892-1895. Will recorded July 14th, 1893. His children and heirs were: Paulina A. Swaim and husband Moses Swaim; Sallie Ellen White and husband W. S. White; Nancy Missouri Swaim and husband F. P. Swaim; T. J. Wood (Thomas James) and wife Rutha Wood; Susan Mariah Sumner and husband J. E. Sumner; Hugh Charlie Wood and wife Ruthie Wood.

Death notice from an old book in the County Judge's Office, Scottsboro, seems to be several certificates of deaths by doctors of Jackson County: Died: Thomas Browder Woods, on May 25th, 1893, Aged 66 years. A married man, place of birth, Alabama, by Dr. Andy Boyd.

The following also given by Mrs. Proctor. She did not give her source but she interviewed many people in <u>Jackson County</u> over a period of 30 years.

Children of Thomas J. Wood and his wife, Mary, or Marie-Mariah:

- 1. Thomas Browder Wood, born September 7, 1827, died May 28, 1893. His wife, Nancy A. Wood, 1828-1896, buried Woods Cove Cemetery. He married Nancy Ann Rutherford December 23, 1853, by Joseph Minor, J. P.
- 2. Minerva E. Wood, born about 1831 married F. M. Rutherford on 12 December 1854 by R. B. Skelton, J. P.
- 3. Martha A. Wood married Joseph Pickens Barclay on August 3, 1856, by M. P. Brown, M. G. Their children: Laura married Anderson; Barton Brown; Martha J. married William B. Gross; Julia married Sam Hollis; Tom married a Cooper; Kitty married Isam Kennamer; James P. Barclay.
- 4. Rev. Thomas J. Wood, born 6 December 1832 (tombstone) died 15 January (1905?). Living at (Junetown?) Indian Territory on 25 November 1854.
- 5. Jane Wood born 15 November 1834 married Reuben Z. Gideon (or Giddens)
  - 6. Lucinda Wood born about 1837



- 7. Ambrose Wood born about 1839
- 8. Henry M. Wood born about 1840 married Mary Missouri Childress, daughter of John Kirby Childress and Ruth Burgess. He died and she married Samuel Houston Green.
- 9. Virgil Wood born about 1842 married Martha J. Mitchell 20 August 1865 by M. P. Brown, M. G. Was living in Beebe, Arkansas 25 November 1884
- 10. Hester A. Wood born about 1844 married Hugh H. Shelton on 23 August 1863. May be buried in Atlanta.
- 11. Amanda M. Wood married I. W. Law on April 5, 1863. She and her husband were living at Gainsville, Texas on 25 November 1884.
- 12. Sarah Caroline Wood married (a Williams?) She was living, a widow, in Las Cruces, New Mexico on 25 November 1884. Had a son, Thomas J. Williams who married in 1883.
  - 13. B. F. Wood living Green Hill, Texas on 25 November 1884.
- 14. John M. D. Wood born about 1819 in Tennessee, married Margaret Barclay born about 1821, married about 1842. Children: William, Mary M., John Calvin, James and Deborah.

Note by Mrs. Proctor: Thomas J. Wood, son of Thomas Browder Wood, married in July, 1883, Julia Rounsavall, daughter of W. L. Rounsavall by Parks Kirby, Esq. "Died Wednesday of this week, Mrs. Thomas J. Wood at her home in Woods Cove, May 31, 1888."

Somewhere in the Proctor collection is probably the obituaries of Thomas J. Wood and his wife. I took the following information from their obituaries some years ago:

The Rev. Thomas J. Wood was born in 1798 in South Carolina (Mrs. Proctor says Laurens County). His wife, Mrs. Maria Wood of Woods Cove, Jackson County, Alabama. Rev. Wood died after a brief illness on Monday morning the 3rd of November 1884, aged 86 years. His wife was born February 26, 1802 in Tennessee and married T. J. Wood in Tennessee on February 24, 1818 and died in Jackson County on Tuesday October 11, 1887 at her residence in Scottsboro. They were the parents of 15 children. Twelve of them were still living when their mother died.

James Rutherford is the ancestor of William Parks Sumner Jr. through his grandmother Susan Mariah Wood, wife of James Exum Sumner Jr. Susan Mariah was the daughter of Thomas Browder Wood and his wife Nancy Ann Rutherford.

Notes from Dr. Wilson: James Rutherford born in Virginia married Susan Henry born in Virginia and moved to Cocke County, Tennessee, accompanied by Archibald, Jr. between 1796 and 1799. The family moved to Alabama where James died in Jackson County. His children included Archibald, James Claibourn, Francis Marion, Joseph, Sarah, Nancy, George and William.

James Rutherford and Thomas B. Wood, Adm. of James Rutherford, deceased. Heirs, nine children: William Rutherford who resides in Franklin County, Tennessee; Missouri who married Sevier Bolton, Jackson County, Alabama; Archibald Rutherford, full age, Jackson County, Alabama; James Rutherford, of full age, Tishimingo County, Mississippi; F. M. Rutherford of Jackson County, Alabama; Sarah who married David L. Starkey, resides in Miss., County unknown; Nancy who resides in Mississippi, county unknown; Joseph W. Rutherford who resides in Jackson County, Alabama. October 12, 1867.

Notes by Dr. Wilson: James Rutherford served in the War of 1812, enlisting at Knoxville, Tennessee on October 7, 1813 and serving until January 7, 1814. He served under Capt. William Jobe and Col. Samuel Bunch. His service was with the Tennessee Mounted Volunteers in the Creek Indian Campaign. He was awarded two land grants in Jackson County, Alabama, as a result of his military service.

Kenneth Rutherford, who wrote the Rutherford book (Scottsboro Public Library), thinks James' father was probably a Robert Rutherford but he has no proof and James did not name any of his children Robert. I think his father was the William Rutherford, born at Cripple Creek, Wythe County, Virginia June 10, 1748. He married Agnes Beard, daughter of John Beard. He died Knox County, Tennessee November 16, 1833. He served two tours in the American Army during the Revolutionary War. For this he received a pension No. S 1869, at Knox County, Tennessee, in 1833. Need his will of property settlement.


This census record proves that Thomas J. Wood was the father of Thomas Browder Wood.



# **Revolutionary War Pension Information**

Information from "Virginia/West Virginia Genealogical Data from Revolutionary War Pension and Bounty Land Warrant Records", Vol. 4, compiled by Patrick G. Wardell, Lt. Col. U.S. Army Ret.:

Rutherford, Robert - entered service 1780 in Shenandoah County, Virginia or Augusta County, Virginia in Virginia regiment; received pension at age 56 in Clark county, Ohio in 1818 [age 62] when residing in Champaign County, Ohio, at German; resided 1824 in Cabell County, Virginia, occupation farmer, when wife age 66 [born 1758] per County Court Clerk John Samuels; Christopher Keezer made affidavit there then, per county Justice of the Peace Solomon Thornburgh; Levi Shorridge & Thomas Syrus made affidavit there then, per County Justice of the Peace Levi McCormick; query letter in file says soldier resided in Cabell County, Virginia, 1840 age 77 [born 1763] with Thomas Rutherford (no kinship given); query letter in file 1915 from descendant J.R. Rutherford of Los Angeles County, who also was descendant of Revolutionary War soldier Larkin Rutherford who was also granted Pension. F-S38341, R2105.

## Records

1780 October. **Robert Rutherford** enlisted in the Continental Line for a term of 18 months during the Revolutionary War.

1782 - Elizabeth HILL widow of - - - FORD m. **Robert RUTHERFORD** 30th April 1782, [Shenandoah Co., VA, Marriage Records]

1791 November 8. **Robert Rutherford** and his brother Reuben served on a jury in Greene Co., TN.

1812 September 27, to 1813 February 9. **Robert Rutnerford** volunteered for 6 months service from Cabell Co., VA, during the War of 1812. Applied for bounty land, June 10, 1850, from Wayne Co., VA, and received a warrant for 80 acres.

1818 July 2. Robert Rutnerford applied for a pension from Champaign Co., OH. See pension # S-38,341 page images at Footnote.com.

## Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements & Rosters

Pension Application of Robert Rutherford S38341

Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris

State of Ohio } SS Champaign County }

Personally appeared before me Alex'r McBeth of Urbana Township one of the associate Judges of this court of common pleas of the County of Champaign in the State of Ohio Robert Rutherford who upon his Solemn oath according law deposeth & saith that he is at present in reduced circumstances of life and That He did faithfully serve in the capacity of a private soldier eighteen months at one period of the American revolutionary War That He the said Robert Rutherford did in the County of Shanandoa [sic: Shenandoah] in the State of Virginia in the month of October in the year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and eighty enlist as a private soldier in Capt Andrew Wallace's company for and during the term of eighteen months, and the af'd Robert Rutherford further saith that He marched under the command of the af'd. Capt Andrew Wallace through north and South Carolinas That the af'd company belonged to the Eighth regiment commanded by Colo Bluford [see endnote] in the Virginia line and the afd Robert Rutherford further saith That He remained faithfully to serve in the af'd company and regiment until the af'd Capt Andrew Wallace was killed at the Battle of Gilford in north Carolina [sic: Guilford Courthouse, 15 Mar 1781] and the af'd Robert Rutherford further saith that He was then ordered by Major Mazard [sic: John Mazarett] to drive a Baggage Waggon & that He remained faithfully in the United States Service in driving said Team until the expiration of the American revolutionary war and the af'd Robert Rutherford further saith that shortly before the expiration of the af'd war He had been ordered by the af'd Major Mazard to drive the baggage belonging to the af'd Major Mazard to Mazards residence in Leads Town [sic: Leedstown] in the state of Virginia. That Major Mazard granted the af'd Robert Rutherford a short furlough to go home and that before the expiration of said furlough the american revolutionary war had expired that He did not return in order to receive his discharge That He gave his furlough to one Zara Delena in order to recover pay for his services af'd That He has never since seen nor heard of the af'd Zeke Delena That He never did receive any pay for his services af'd and the af'd Robert Rutherford further saith He is a resident of the Township of German in the county of Clark and State of Ohio and is fifty six years of age and from his present indigent circumstances in life needs the assistance of his country for support Robert hisXmark Rutherford

Sworn & subscribed before me the 2<sup>nd</sup> of July A.D. 1818




