

1907 Confederate Veteran Census (1)

In 1907, a census was made of the Confederate soldiers still living in the county. A considerable amount of information was given in this census, such as present address, place and date of birth, when he entered service, what outfit he served with, what rank held and sometimes, reason for discharge. At this time there were 266 of the old veterans still living in the county. ~~according to this census.~~ There may have some that were missed by the census taker.

JAMES MARTIN ADAMS, Dutton, was born Feb. 22, 1840, LaFayette Co., Ga.; entered as Pvt. May 15, 1861, at Knoxville, Tenn., in the 40th Georgia Reg't., Co. G.

JOHN MELTON ADAMS, Stevenson, was born Jan. 8, 1846, at Mt. Cona (Eona?) White Co., Ga.; entered as Pvt. June 28, 1862, Springplace, Ga., in the 28th Ga. Reg't., Co. G, and continued until wounded at Gainesville, Va., on June 5, 1863, and was rendered unable for service.

SIMEON WEST ALSPAUGH, Prin^{ce}ton, was born Apr. 8, 1845, Garrett Co., Ky.; entered as Pvt. in the summer of 1864, Corinth, Miss., in the 4th Tenn. Cav., Co. K, and continued until the surrender at Dalton, Ga.

MILTON WARD ANDERSON, Bridgeport, was born Feb. 19, 1839, Winchester, Frederick Co., Va.; entered as 2nd Lieut., in the spring of 1861 at Nashville, Tenn., in the 1st Tenn. Reg't., Co. F; after 9 months service, "detailed me rail road engineer.."

FELIX MARTIN ARNOLD, Hollywood, was born in Feb., 1844, at Larkin (Larkinsville?), Jackson Co., Ala., entered as Pvt. in Aug. 1861, at Scottsboro, in the 4th Confederate Tenn. Reg't., Co. D, and continued until battle of Chickamauga, Ga.; "was cut off from command and never reached command again."

STEPHEN B. AUSTIN, Paint Rock, was born Oct. 15, 1843, at Coal Mountain, Precise Co., Ga.; entered as Pvt. in spring of 1861 at (left blank), in the 12th Ala. Reg't., Co. G; served 2 years; captured and kept in prison until close of war.

ANDREW JACKSON BAKER, Fackler, was born Nov. 21, 1832, Viana, Madison Co., Ala.; entered as Pvt. about Feb. 1, 1863, at Tullahoma, Tenn. in the 33rd Ala. Reg't., Co. A, and continued until latter part of 1864 when captured at Ringold, Ga.

JAMES L. BANKSTON, Section, was born Nov. 2, 1839, Greenville, Cowetta Co., Ga., entered as pvt. May 13, 1861, Atlanta, Ga., in the 7th Ga. Regt., Co. A, and continued until April 30, 1865; paroled at Atlanta; re-enlisted as pvt. May 7, 1862, at Petersburg, Va.

WILLIAM JAMES BARCLAY, Woodville, was born July 29, 1845, at Hunt's Store, entered as pvt. in fall of 1861 at Maysville, Ala., in the 25th Ala. Cav. Regt., Co. F., and continued until surrender in May, 1865.

JOHN MARTIN BARRIER, Stevenson, was born Jan. 29, 1838, Stevenson, Ala., entered as 2nd Sgt. Oct. 15, 1861, at Stevenson, in the 17th Tenn. Regt., Co. I, and continued until captured at Chickamauga, on or about Sept. 15, 1863.

CRAWFORD CARLTON BEAN, Sunset, Ala. (no county given), was born April 10, 1836, Gainsboro, Jackson Co., Tenn.; entered as pvt. in Aug., 1862, at Stevenson, Ala. in Major Gunter's Battalion; later attached to 33rd Ala. Co. B, and continued until last of December, 1864.

JAMES BEESON, Hytop, was born Dec. 13, 1863, near Bellefonte; entered as pvt. Feb. 15, 1861, at Mt. Adams, Arkansas in the (blank)..; re-enlisted as pvt. in Feb., 1862; for 3 years, or enduring war, and cont'd until April 26, 1865, when J. E. Johnston surrendered at Greensboro, N. C.

DAVID LARKIN BELLAMY, Scottsboro, was born Feb. 8, 1844, at Bellefonte; entered as pvt. Feb. 3, 1863, at Bellefonte, in the 4th Tenn. Regt., Co. F, and cont'd 17 months; resigned July 4th 1864.

JOHN BISHOP, Milan (Paint Rock Valley), born Jan. 11, 1840, at Milan, Jackson Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. in Aug., 1861, at Scottsboro in the 4th Tenn. Regt., Co. D., and cont'd until close of war, 1865.

JAMES OSCAR BLACK, Section, was born Jan. 10, 1844, at Jacksonville, Cherokee Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. at Cumberland Gap, Tenn., in the 4th Tenn. Regt., Co. K, and cont'd until captured in July, 1863; remained in prison until discharged Mar. 2, 1865.

JORDAN B. BLANCETT, Yucca, (no county given) Ala. was born May 14, 1824, Doran's Cove, Jackson Co., Ala., entered as pvt. April, 1862, at Stevenson, in the 33rd Ala., Regt., Co. A, and cont'd until captured in September, 1863; remained in prison until close of war and paroled May 24, 1865.

PETER BOOZER, Section, was born April 7, 1840, Jacksonville, Calhoun Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. Aug. 9, 1861, at Goshen, Ala., in the 19th Ala. Regt. Co. I, and cont'd until 20th April, 1865; surrendered at Columbus, Ga.; paroled at Macon, Ga.

ELIJA BOOZER, Section, was born Dec. 15, 1845, Calhoun Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. Aug. 4, 1864, at Center, Ala. in Millsaps Co. D, and cont'd until discharged at Talladega, Ala., May 1, 1865.

JAMES ROBERT BOWLIN, Hollywood, was born in March, 1835, at McMinnville, Warren Co., Tenn., entered as pvt. in fall of 1861 at Courtland, Ala. in the 5th Ala. Regt. Co. E, and cont'd until captured at Murfreesboro, Tenn. in spring of 1863; paroled at same time.

DANIEL WEBSTER BRADFORD was born Nov. 28, 1828, Wilks Co., Ga., entered as pvt. April 3, 1861, at Waldo, Fla., in the 15th Ga. Regt., Co. F, and cont'd until captured April 9, 1865.

ANDREW P. BRAY, Pisgah, was born May 11, 1833, Greenville, Greenville Co., S.C., entered as pvt., March 11, 1862, Rome, Ga., in Smith's (Smath's?) Battalion, Co. G, and cont'd until discharged Dec. 26, 1862; re-enlisted as pvt. Feb. 17, 1863, Coosaville, Ga., in the Division, Co. G. and continued until end of war; was mustered out at Cartersville, Ga., 1865.

SHERRELL ALLEN BREWSTER, Hollywood, was born March 15, 1844 at Dalton, Whitfield Co., Ga., entered as pvt. 1861 at Union City, Tenn. in the 21st Regt., Co. F, "Dixie Greys" and cont'd until discharged in 1862; re-enlisted as pvt. in fall of 1864 at Trenton, Ga., in the 4th Ala. Cav. Smith's Co. and cont'd until May, 1865, at time of surrender.

EMERSON BREWER, Estill Fork, was born Feb. 20, 1842, Winchester, Franklin Co., Tenn.; entered as pvt. on or about Nov 1, 1861, at Winchester, Tenn., in the 2nd Tenn. Regt., Co. H. Captured at Fort Donelson, Tenn, about Feb. 16, 1862. Exchanged sometime in September, 1862. Re-enlisted as pvt. in Sept. 1862, at Vicksburg, in the 55th Ala. Regt., Co. I, and cont'd until latter part of Dec., 1864.

JOHN OLIVER BRIDGES, Hollytree, was born Nov. 2, 1840, at Larkin (Larkinsville? Larkin's Fork?), in Jackson Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. June 10, 1861, at Bellefonte, in the 55th Ala. Regt., Co. B, and cont'd until close of war; discharged at Greensboro, Ala.

JOSIAH BROOKS, Hollywood, was born Dec. 15, 1843 at Broomtown, Cherokee Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. at Broomtown in the 19th Ala. Regt., Co. G, and cont'd until close of war.

GEORGE WASHINGTON BROOKS, Bridgeport, was born Feb. 13, 1845, at Center, Cherokee Co., Tenn. (Ala. ?); first entered service as pvt. in May, 1864, at Dalton, Ga., in the 19th Ala. Regt., Co. I, and cont'd until captured near Rome, Ga. in June 1864 and kept in prison at Burnside, Indiana, until close of war.

IRA POLK BROWN, Aspel, was born April 15, 1839, at Pulaska, Giles Co., Tenn; first entered service as pvt. on Apr. 29, 1861, at Larkinsville, Ala. in the 4th Ala. Regt., Co. K; discharged at Bristo Station in Sept. 1861. Re-enlisted as pvt. in Jan. 1862, at Larkinsville in the States Service in Capt. John Dillard's Co. and served about 4 months.

Re-enlisted as pvt in Jan., 1863 at Larkinsville, in Capt. James H. Young's Co. as Guard and continued until close of war.

GEORGE W. BROWN, Kash, born May 13, 1832, Farmington, Clarke Co., Ga., entered as pvt. Nov. 1862, at Stevenson, in Capt. James Cowan's Co., 55th Ala., Regt., and cont'd until close of war; surrendered and paroled in N. C.

JAMES ROBERT BUCKNER, Fabius, was born Nov. 12, 1834, Athens, McMinn Co., Tenn.; entered as pvt. in Dec., 1861, at Greenville, Tenn., in the 43rd Tenn. Regt., Co. D, and cont'd until (blank). Re-enlisted as First Sergeant *in* Sept. 1862, at Castlewood, Va., 43rd Tenn. Regt., Co. D, and continued until captured and paroled at the surrender of Vicksburg July 4, 1863.

NAPOLEON BONAPART BURCH, Stevenson, was born Sept. 1, 1843, at Stevenson, entered as pvt. in May, 1862, in Huntsville, Ala., in the 33rd Ala. Regt., Co. A, and continued until captured in Oct. 1863. Was imprisoned at Camp Morton, Indiana, and kept in prison until close of war.

WILLIAM BREWSTER BURK, Kash, was born July 2, 1828, Pickens Co., Pickens, S. C.; entered as pvt. at Cleveland, Ga., in Co. C, and cont'd until close of war being honorably discharged.

SAMUEL BUTLER, Larkin, was born Oct. 6, 1829, at (blank); entered as pvt. in 1862 in the 4th Tenn. Cav., Co. K, discharged in 1864.

JOHN POOL BYNUM, Scottsboro, was born Nov. 10, 1835, Scottsboro; entered as pvt May 15, 1861, at Lynchburg, Virginia, in the 4th Ala. Infantry Regt., Co. K, and cont'd until Feb. 15, 1862; discharged at Dumfries, Virginia.

MALDEN BYRAM, Woodville, was born Jan. 28, 1837, at Montevallo, Shelby Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. Sept. 15, 1861, at Millsboro, Ala. in the 20th Ala. Regt., Co. K, and cont'd until captured Dec. 18, 1864, at Nashville, Tenn; was discharged from prison June 16, 1865.

ANDREW JACKSON BRYANT, Febius, Ala. was born Aug. 27, 1843, Atlanta, Fulton Co., Ga.; entered as pvt. on Mar. 22, 1862, at Atlanta in the 22nd Georgia Regt., Co. A; ^{Surrendered} /May 25, 1865, Andersonville, Ga.

GEORGE W. CAMPBELL, Hollywood, was born Aug. 4, 1840, at Bellefonte, Ala.; entered as pvt. March 6, 1861, at Bellefonte in the 2nd Confederate Cav., Co. A., later served with 55th Ala. Regt. 18 months. Got sick; obtained prolonged furlough; re-enlisted as pvt. (do not remember date) in Capt. Young's Co. and continued until close of war.

JOHN H. CARLTON, Olalee, Jackson Co, Ala., was born Aug. 12, 1842, at Olalee; first entered as pvt. in March, 1862, at Cumberland Gap, Tenn., in the 4th Tenn. Regt., Co. D., wounded at Chickamauga, Ga., September, 1862; got furlough, not being able for service any longer.

J. H. CARTER, Gray's Chapel, was born ^{Jan. 27, 1840,} /Milan, Jackson Co., Ala.; entered as 5th Sgt., Gunter's Battalion, Capt. Money's Co., later served at Battle Creek, Tenn., in the 33rd Ala., Regt., Capt. Englis Co. B, and continued until furloughed in Dec., 1864. "Was cut off from my command and could not return to the command."

JOHN LOWERY CARTER, Section, was born Jan. 20, 1834, at (do not remember), Tenn.; entered as pvt. in Spring of 1862 at Scottsboro, in the 4th Tenn. Regt., Co. K, and cont'd until the Spring of 1863. Re-enlisted as pvt. in Spring of 1863 at Guntersville, Ala. in Capt. May's Home Guard Co. and cont'd until close of war.

CHRISTOPHER A. CARTER, Pisgah, was born Nov. 2, 1845, at Covington, Newton Co., Ga.; entered as pvt. at Tyler, Texas, in the 35th Texas Cav., Co. H, and cont'd until about May 25, 1865; was discharged at Galveston, Texas.

JOHN BRUCE CARSON, Dutton, was born June 8, 1838, Jacksonville, Calhoun Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. in April, 1861, at Talladega, Ala, in the 5th Ala. Regt., Co. E, and continued until close of war; paroled at Talladega, June, 1865.

SAMUEL CASON, Pisgah, was born Sept. 30, 1844, Monroe, Walton Co., Ga. entered as pvt. May 22, 1861, Clarksville, Tenn., in the 1st Tenn. Regt., Co. K.; discharged at Frederick, Va., May, 1862; re-enlisted as Captain of Scouts in fall of 1862 at Bridgeport, Ala. and continued until close of war.

MACKLY WAYNE CHISENHALL, Section, was born March 8, 1861 (this was written clearly but the year is in error); entered as pvt. Feb. 12, 1862, at Scottsboro in the 4th Tenn. Regt., Co. K, and cont'd until the close of the war; paroled at White's Landing May 11, 1865.

HORACE J. B. CHRISTIAN, Section, was born June 22, 1834, at Covington, Rockdale Co., Ga.; entered as pvt. in April, 1861, at Conyers, Ga., in the 18th Ga. Regt., Co. B, and cont'd until May, 1865; captured at Appomatox Court House, Virginia, with General Lee about May 10, 1865.

JOHN FEEMSTER COLLINS, Estillfork, was born Dec. 15, 1835, at Redhill, Marshall Co., Ala; entered as pvt. Sept., 1861, at Summersville (Somerville?) Ala., in the 1st Ala. Cav., Co. D, and continued until close of war.

WILLIAM D. COOK, Section, was born Feb. 23, 1843, at Zebulon, Pike Co., Ga.; entered as pvt. at Griffin, Ga., in the States Volunteers, Co. I, and continued until May 1, 1865; discharged at Knoxville, Tenn.

SAMUEL RICHARD CORN, Hollywood, was born June 12, 1842, Bellefonte, Ala.; entered as pvt. at Vertrace, Tenn., in the 1st Ala. Battalion, Co. B, later attached to 33rd Ala. Regt.; captured Feb. 11, 1865.

WILEY COTTON, Larkinsville, Ala., was born Jan. 14, 1847, at Larkinsville; entered as pvt. April 1, 1863, at Rome, Ga., in the 4th Ala. Cav., Co. C; captured at Mt. Pleasant, Tenn., April 5, 1864. Sent to Camp Chase, Ohio, prison and kept in prison until close of war.

SIMON YOUNG CROSSLAND, Stevenson, was born Sept. 2, 1841, Walker Co., Ga.; entered as pvt. at Stevenson, in the 7th Ala. Regt. and cont'd until discharged at Bowling Green, Ky., in Feb. 1862; re-enlisted as pvt. in summer of 1862 at Stevenson in the 18th Ala. Battalion, Co. C, and continued until attached to 33rd Ala. Regt., wounded at New Hope, Ga., and was at home at close of war; took the oath (of allegiance to the United States) at Fort Payne, Ala.

DANIEL TURNEY CROWNOVER, Bridgeport, was born Sept. 19, 1842, Anderson, Franklin Co., Tenn; entered as pvt. May 10, 1861, at Camp Harris in the 17th Tenn. Regt., Co. I, and cont'd until captured near Knoxville, Tenn. in Dec. 1863; paroled in 1863.

MARTIN VANBUREN CULVER, Maxwell, was born Oct. 7, 1840 at Tupelo, Jackson Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. at Stevenson, in the 44th Ala. Regt., Co. C, in Nov. 1863. Was sick and at hospital; was sent home from hospital; "I then hired a substitute to take my place."

JOHN JENKINS CUNNINGHAM, Hollytree, was born July 12, 1838, in Bingham's Cove, Jackson Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. in October, 1862, at Knowlingsville, Tenn. in the 4th Tenn. Cav., Co. K; in the fall of 1864 was cut off from command until Hood's raid to Nashville; at that time the Capt. released me and sent me home.

WILLIAM DANIEL DARWIN, Hollywood, was born June 15, 1839, at Bellefonte in Jackson County, Alabama; entered as pvt. in fall of 1861 at Bellefonte, in the 42nd Tenn. Regt. Co. G; later transferred to 42nd Regt. for 12 months; later attached to 55th Ala. Regt. after battle at Franklin, Tenn., Jan. 1st 1865.

THOMAS DAVIS, Hollytree, was born Sept. 12, 1833, at Hollytree; entered as pvt. in Oct., 1862, at Knowlingsville, Tenn., in the 4th Tenn. Cav. Co. H, and continued until winter of 1864 when "I resigned near Kingston, Tenn."

GEORGE WASHINGTON DAVIS, Bridgeport, was born Feb. 25, 1828, Lumpkin Co. Ga.; entered as pvt. Sept. 1, 1862, at Bridgeport in the 3rd Confederate Cav., Co. G, and continued until 1865; paroled about May 1, 1865.

JOHN PATRICK DAVIS, Hollytree, was born Jan. 14, 1846, at Hollytree; entered as pvt. in fall of 1864 at Hollytree in the 4th Tenn. Cav., Co. K, and cont'd until April 9, 1865. Surrendered on banks of Savannah River, Georgia.

ROBERT DAVIDSON, Kash, was born Aug. 13, 1845, at Homer, Banks County, Ga.; entered as pvt. on Aug. 10, 1864, at Homer, Ga., in the 11th Ga. Regt., Co. A, and cont'd until May, 1865, when discharged at Atlanta.

ISAAC LARKIN DAWSON, Section, was born Sept. 1837, at Cassville, Barto County, Ga.; entered as pvt. on Oct. 6, 1861, at Calhoun, Ga., in the 8th Ga. Regt., Co. E, and continued until May, 1865. Captured at Kingston, Ga.

RODEMAN DEVERS, Narrows, Ala., was born in the year 1822 in the state of Tennessee; entered as pvt. as a drummer on Dec. 26, 1861, at Stevenson, in the 49th Alabama Regt.; re-enlisted as pvt. in fall of 1863 at Chattanooga, Tenn. in Capt. Lattimore's Co. and continued until captured while in hospital service at close of the war.

JOHN WHITMORE DUCKERT, Trenton, was born Sept. 27, _____ at Gravelly Springs, Lauderdale Co., Ala.; entered service as pvt. Dec. 20, 1862, at Shelbyville, Tenn., in the 50th Ala. Regt., Co. C, and cont'd until paroled under Joseph E. Johnson in Georgia, in 1865.

Enlisted in State troops under Capt. Preston Brown about July 15, 1862--
Cavalry Co., served 3 months; discharged about Oct. 15, 1862.

THOMAS DUDLEY, Hollywood, was born March 15, 1837, at Stevenson; first
entered as pvt. in Spring, 1861, at Bellefonte in the 3rd Confederate
Inf., Co. D, and cont'd until captured at Nashville, Tennessee, in
December, 1865. Imprisoned at Camp Chase, Ohio; released from prison
June 6, 1865.

J. W. DULANEY, Aspel, was born March 18, 1844, at Aspel in Jackson Co.
Ala.; entered as pvt. Aug. 15, 1862 at Aspel, in the 4th Ala. Cav., Co.
G, and cont'd until Jan. 9, 1865, when discharged at Gadsden, Ala.

R. M. ERWIN, Paint Rock, was born Jan. 4, 1843, at _____ (blank) _____;
entered as pvt. on March 7, 1862, in the 12th Ala. Regt., Co. G;
wounded at Gettysburg and later served with the 4th Ala. Cavalry.

JOHN (BACHER?) EVANS, Woodville, was born May 31, 1841, at Woodville,
Ala.; entered as pvt. in June, 1862, at Paint Rock, Alabama, in Capt.
Dicus Company D, and transferred to the 4th Confederate Tenn. and
cont'd in service until May 5, 1865, when paroled.

JAMES W. FANNING, Francisco, was born Aug. 17, 1839, Jackson Co., Ala.;
entered as pvt. in 1862 in Madison Co., Ala. in the 50th Ala. Regt.,
Co. C, and cont'd until captured at Nashville, Tenn. in Hood's raid;
served 2 years and 6 months.

THOMAS THEODORE FOSTER, Stevenson, was born on Aug. 27, 1840, at Stevenson,
Jackson Co., Ala.; entered as 3rd Lieutenant in October, 1861, at Camp
Cheatum in the 42nd Tenn. Regt., Co. H, and continued until captured at
Fort Donalson in February, 1862; exchanged in September, 1862; re-enlist-
ed as First Lieutenant in September, 1862, at Vicksburg, Miss., in the
55th Alabama Regt., Co. H, and continued until captured at Peachtree

Creek July 20th, 1864; remained in prison until April, 1865.

SAMUEL WILEY FRAZIER, Scottsboro, was born Nov. 22, 1837, at Larkinsville, Jackson Co., Ala.; entered service at Bellefonte in the 2nd Alabama Regt., Co. K, and continued until discharged at Fort Pillow, Tenn., in March, 1862. Re-enlisted as pvt. in May, 1862, at Woodville, Ala., in the State Troops, Capt. John Dillard's Company and continued until October, 1862; re-enlisted as pvt. in February, 1863, at Baldwin, Miss. in the 11th Miss. Regt., Co. K; elected 1st Lieutenant and continued until close of war. Was wounded and captured at Selma, Ala., 2nd Sunday in April, 1865; paroled in May, 1865.

WILLIAM CORNELIUS GAITHER, Paint Rock, was born Dec. 7, 1844, at Athens, Limestone Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. in fall of 1862 at Fayetteville, Tenn., in the 8th Penn. Inf., Co. K, captured near Nashville, Tenn., in Dec., 1864; was kept in prison until the surrender.

MERRITT RICHMOND GALLOWAY, Pisgan, was born Jan. 1, 1844, in Clay Co., N. C.; entered as pvt. in August, 1862, at Hayesville, N. C. in the 62nd North Carolina Regt., Co. B, and continued until surrendered at Cumberland Gap, Sept. 19, 1863; re-enlisted as Orderly Sergeant in Oct., 1863, at Hayesville, N. C., in Whittaker's Battalion and cont'd until discharged at close of war in May, 1865.

THOMAS SHELTON GAMBLE, Hollywood, was born Feb. 7, 1844, at Stevenson, Jackson Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. in fall of 1861, at Stevenson, in the 31st Ala. Regt., Co. C, and cont'd until captured at Fort Hudson, La. Paroled July 8, 1863.

BERRY GAMBLE, Bass, was born April 16, 1830, at Bass, Jackson Co., Ala. entered as pvt. in May, 1861, at Anderson, Tennessee, in the 17th Tenn. Regt., Co. I, and cont'd until after Battle of Nashville, Tenn., in latter part of December, 1864, was cut off from command. Never got with command again.

WILLIAM GREEN JANE, Dutton, was born Sept. 3, 1845, at Marietta, Cobb Co., Ga.; entered as pvt. on March 4, 1862, at Kennesaw, Georgia in the 40th Georgia Regt., Co. A, and continued until discharged April 17, 1863. Re-enlisted as pvt. on Aug. 28, 1863, at Bolton, Ga., in the 1st Georgia Regt., Co. E, and cont'd until captured at Kingston, Ga.; was paroled after close of war.

JEFFERSON LEE GENTRY, Long Island, was born April 11, 1845 at Stevenson; entered service as pvt. in Jan. 1863, at Port Hudson, La., in the 49th Ala. Regt, Co. C; was taken prisoner July 8, 1863, was paroled July 13, 1863.

JAMES LEROY GLASSCOCK, Bridgeport, was born Jan. 6, 1840 at Bridgeport; entered as pvt. in fall of 1861 at Bridgeport in the 42nd Tenn. Regt, Co. THOMAS FINLEY KNIGHT, Narrows, Ala., was born July 14, 1837, at Stevenson, Jackson Co., Ala., entered as pvt. on Dec. 26, 1861, at Stevenson, in the 49th Ala. Regt, Co. C, and cont'd until captured at Port Hudson, July 8, 1864; paroled July 16, 1864.

I then went

Re-enlisted as private and continued until April 6, 1865, when was captured and Lee retreated from Richmond. Sent to Johnson's Island and paroled in June or July. Served as Captain and Inspector General on General D. R. Johnson's Staff and at time of capture had been transferred to regular Marine Corps and held rank of Lieutenant in regular service. Was Lieutenant of Marines on Confederate Gun Boat "Columbia" in Charleston Harbor until surrender of city and then rejoined army and served at Dury Bluff, near Richmond, until evacuated. Captured on retreat.

WILLIAM WARREN SMITH, Fabius, was born February 16, 1835, at Stevenson; ~~xxxxxxx~~ entered as pvt. Nov. 2, 1861, at Camp Cheatum, Tennessee,

in the 55th Alabama Regiment, Co. N(H?). Captured near Rogersville, Ala. in January, 1865; released from prison June 16, 1865.

WILLIAM R. SMITH, Stevenson, was born March 25, 1840, at Spartanburg, S. C.; entered as pvt. in fall of 1861 at Stevenson, in the 42nd Alabama Regiment, Co. F; captured at Fort Donalson in 1862. Exchanged and served until close of war. Surrendered in Spring of 1865.

JOHN T. SMITH, Bryant, was born Oct. 9, 1833, at Guntersville; entered as pvt. in fall of 1862 at Tullahoma, Tennessee, in John Gibson's Battalion, Co. C, and captured at Shellmound, Tenn., in fall of 1863; paroled and annexed to 33rd Alabama Regiment at Stevenson, Ala. same fall.

PLEASANT AYLER SMITH, Pisgah, was born Jan. 22, 1842, at (Ballplay?), Cherokee Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. at Warrenton, Marshall Co., Ala., in the 48th Ala. Regiment, Co. JACKSON STEPHENS, Stevenson, was born in 1835 at Trenton, Dade Co., Ga.; entered as private in spring of 1862 at Trenton, Georgia, in the 39th Georgia Regiment, Company D, and continued until captured at Vicksburg, Mississippi. Paroled at Vicksburg.

CALVIN STEEL, Stevenson, was born April 25, 1845, at Trenton, Dade Co., Ga.; entered as pvt. in summer of 1862 at Trenton, Ga., in the 34th Georgia Regiment, Co. F, and cont'd until close of war. Surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. in May, 1865, with General Joseph E. Johnston.

ISAAC STEEL, Bass, was born (left blank), in the state of Kentucky; entered

as private in 1861, at Shelbyville, Tennessee, in the 17th Tennessee Regiment. Later transferred to the 33rd Alabama Regiment and cont'd until some time in 1863.

CHARLES O. STEEL, Pisgah, was born September 3, 1840, Valley Head, Dekalb Co., Ala; entered as 1st Corporal on Dec. 20, 1861, Trenton, Ga., in the 34th Georgia Regiment, Co. F, and continued until May 3, 1865. Captured at Raleigh, N. C.

DAVID STEWART, Paint Rock, Ala., was born April 27, 1834 at New Hope, Madison Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. in fall of 1861 in the 49th Alabama Regiment, Co. H, and cont'd until captured at Fort Hudson, La., in July, 1863.

ENOCH STORY, Section, was born Feb. 8, 1845, Marshall Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. in December, 1863, in the 55th Alabama Regiment, Co. E, and cont'd until was home on furlough on account of being wounded at time of surrender.

SAMUEL CEPHUS STOVER, Section, was born June 14, 1833, in Abby District, South Carolina; entered as pvt. in spring, 1862, at Jasper, Ga. in the 43rd Alabama Regiment, Co. C, and cont'd until close of war; surrendered at Kingston, Georgia.

WILLIAM HARRISON STOVALL, Princeton, was born May 8, 1840, at Huntland, Franklin Co., Tenn.; entered as pvt. in fall of 1862 at Huntland in the 4th Georgia Regiment, Capt. Ashton's Co., and cont'd until close of war; was cut off from my command, "I was paroled at Scottsboro, Ala."

JOHN ALLEN SWAFFORD, Scottsboro, was born May 19, 1837, at Larkinsville, Jackson Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. in December, 1862, at Scottsboro, in the 55th Ala. Regt., Co. I, and cont'd until captured at Nashville, Tennessee in December, 1864; was kept in prison at Columbus, Ohio; discharged from prison in June, 1865.

DAVID CROCKETT SWEARINGIN, Milan, Ala., was born Oct. 14, 1837, at Milan, Jackson Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. on Jan. 1, 1862, at Tullahoma, Tenn. in the 33rd Ala. Regt, Co. B, and continued until discharged at the close of 12 months.

THOMAS W. SWORDS, Hollytree, was born in Nashville, Tennessee (no birth date given); entered service in Heavy Artillery in 1861 at Nashville and continued until discharged at Vicksburg, Mississippi, after serving 16 months. "Cause of being too young was why I was discharged." Re-enlisted as private at Atlanta, Ga. in the 1st Tennessee Infantry Regiment, Co. C, and continued until captured at Cold Water, while with General Hood in December, 1864. Paroled at Nashville, Tennessee.

WILLIAM RILEY TANKERSLEY, Milan, was born February 14, 1835, at Trenton, Dade Co., Ga., entered as pvt. on, or about, November 1, 1861, at Camp Cheatum, Tennessee, in the 42nd Tennessee Regiment, Co. H, and continued until "I was paroled December 22, 1864."

JACOB LAWRENCE TATE, Dutton, was born Feb. 17, 1846, at Ruckerville, Elbert Co., Ga.; entered as pvt. Feb. 5, 1862, at Keseta, Ala. in the 8th Confederate Regiment, Co. I, and cont'd until close of war. Paroled at Greensboro, N. C. about April 26, 1865.

EDMOND RAGSDALE TAYLOR, Section, was born Oct. 6, 1832, at Newnan in Cowetta Co., Ga.; entered as private in fall of 1862, at Mobile, Ala., in the 38th Ala. Regt, Co. B, and cont'd until captured at Tinners Station, Tenn.; was kept in prison at Rock Island, Ill, until close of war.

AMOS JOHNSON THIGPEN, Fabius, was born Sept. 7, 1844, near Louisville, Jefferson Co., Ga.; entered as pvt. March 4, 1861, at Louisville, Ga., in the 28th Georgia Regiment, Co. I, and cont'd until furloughed just before Lee's surrender.

WILLIAM JESSEE THOMASON, Woodville, was born Dec. 6, 1843, at Ackwerth, Cobb Co., Ga.; entered as pvt. April 15, 1862, at Huntsville, in the 35th Ala. Regiment, Co. E, and cont'd until close of war; paroled in March, 1865, at Nashville, Tenn.

ARCHIBALD H. THOMPSON, Scottsboro, was born Sept. 26, 1847, at Bridgeport, Ala. Entered as pvt. in winter of 1864 at Johnson Crook(Creek?), Dade Co., Ga., Home Guard Co., Capt. Witherspoon's, Company and continued until close of war. Surrendered at Caperton's Ferry; sent to Chattanooga, Tennessee, and paroled.

JOSEPH THOMAS, Bridgeport, was born June 6, 1840, at Bridgeport. Entered as private April 1, 1861, at Bridgeport, in the 6th Alabama Regiment, Capt. William Gunter's Company K, and continued until surrendered at Richmond, Virginia. Paroled at City Point, June 21, 1865.

MASON THOMAS, Bridgeport, was born October 23, 1843, at Doran's Cove, Jackson Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. in July, 1863, at Bridgeport, in the 3rd Confederate Cavalry, Co. G, and continued until captured at (Eleven, Ala.?), carried to Camp Douglas prison; paroled about June 10, 1865.

JOHN THOMAS, Pisgah, was born Sept. 29, 1829, at Arlington, Washington, Co., Va.; entered as Second Sergeant in the spring of 1861 at Trenton, Ga. in the 34th Georgia Regiment, Capt. William Brooks' Co. F, and cont'd until discharged May 3, 1865.

JAMES LAWLER THOMAS, Bridgeport, was born in 1832 at Bridgeport. Entered as private in fall of 1861 at Bridgeport, in the 42nd Tennessee Regiment, Company F, and cont'd until captured at Fort Donalson in February, 1862. Exchanged in August, 1862. Re-enlisted as private in September, 1862, at Clinton, Mississippi, in the 55th Alabama Regiment, Co. F, and continued until close of war; was home on furlough at time of Lee's Surrender.

JOSEPH C. THORNTON, Hymer, Alabama, was born Sept. 7, 1832, at Old Homestead, Marion Co., Tenn.; entered as pvt. on, or about, September, 1862, at Shelbyville, Tennessee, in George Cowan's Company and cont'd until transferred in November, 1862, to Nitric and Mining District No. 9, according to General Order No. 1, from the Secretary of War.

OBEDIAH TINKER, Pisgah, was born March 6, 1848, at Rising Fawn, Dekalb County, Alabama(?); entered as pvt. May 10, 1864, at Lebanon, Alabama, in the 3rd Confederate Regt, Co. G; and continued until surrendered with General Wheeler in April, 1865.

JAMES J. TIPTON, Garth, Ala., was born Jan. 20, 1840, at Killingsworth, Madison Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. in January, 1862, in Jackson Co., Ala. in the 25th Alabama Cavalry Regiment, Capt. Nelson's Co. C, and continued until surrendered at New Hope, Alabama; paroled at Huntsville May 5, 1865.

WILLIAM BRADFORD TIPTON, Garth, was born Nov. 1, 1840, at Maysville, Madison Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. in summer of 1862 at Maysville in the 35th Alabama Regiment, Co. F, and cont'd until in the spring of 1865; captured near Russellville, Ala., near May 15, 1865.

WILLIAM TOON, Scottsboro, was born May 6, 1828 at Scottsboro(?), Jackson Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. in fall of 1862 at Tullahoma, Tenn., in the 4th Alabama Cavalry Regiment, Co. G, and continued until captured at Chickamauga, Ga., in the fall of 1863 and remained in prison until close of war.

BENJAMIN THOMAS TRIBBLE, Limrock, was born Dec. 25, 1831, at Danielsville, Madison Co., Ga.; entered as pvt. in April, 1862, at Calhoun, Ga., in the 3rd Georgia Cavalry Regiment, Co. G, and cont'd until January, 1864. Wounded at Strawberry Plains and left in East Tennessee.

JAMES LEROY VAUGHT, Langston, was born April 11, 1844, at Langston; entered as pvt. Sept. 13, 1862, at Carpenter, Alabama, in the 4th Alabama Cavalry Regiment, Co. G, and cont'd until close of war May, 1865.

ROBERT JACKSON WALLS, Limrock, was born Sept. 10, 1846 at Wedowee, Randolph Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. July 5, 1864, at Talladega, Alabama, in the 62nd Alabama Infantry Regiment, Co. F, and continued until captured August 10, 1864; exchanged Jan. 9, 1865, and cont'd until May 11, 1865.

JAMES NEWTON WALKER, Princeton, was born February 1, 1844, at Larkin's Fork, Jackson Co., Ala.; entered as Corporal in July, 1862, at Ashville, Tenn. in the 26th Alabama Regiment, Co. C, and cont'd until served 2 years and was captured at Atlanta, Ga. July 23, 1864. Paroled March 3, 1865, at Richmond, Va.

JACOB TALLY WALKER, Bass, was born August 25, 1840, at Bass; entered as pvt. Sept. 21, 1861, at Carpenter, in the 4th Alabama Cavalry Regiment, Co. E, and continued until captured at Gainsville, Ala. in April, 1865. Paroled in May, 1865.

ALEXANDER WALKER, Bridgeport, was born October 13, 1832, at Sparta, White Co., Tenn.; entered as pvt. in fall of 1862, at Milan, Ala. in Gunter's Battalion, Capt. Money's Co. and continued until taken sick and sent home.

WILLIAM WALKER, Bridgeport, was born December 31, 1844, at Stevenson, Ala.; entered as pvt. in December, 1861, at Nashville, Tennessee, in the 49th Alabama Regiment, Co. C, and continued until captured at Stevenson, in August, 1862; was kept in prison until March 25, 1863; was paroled on above date.

JEREMIAH WALKER, Stevenson, was born Nov. 5, 1839 at Stevenson; entered as First Corporal on December 31, 1861, at Stevenson, in the 31st Alabama Regiment; afterwards in the 49th Alabama Regiment, Co. C, and

continued until captured at Port Hudson.

ASBERY FLETCHER WATKINS, Pisgah, was born Sept. 18, 1842, at Blairsville, Union Co., Ga., entered as pvt. on March 4, 1862, at Blairsville, Ga. in the 52nd Georgia Infantry Regiment, Co. G, and continued until was transferred in July, 1862, 1st Ga. Cavalry Battalion. Afterwards it became the 6th Regiment and continued until May 1, 1865.

ANDREW HENDERSON WEBSTER, Holland, Ala., was born March 23, 1844, at Huntsville, Ala.; entered as pvt. in fall of 1863 at Huntsville with General Forrest's Co. C, and cont'd until captured in March, 1865, and held as prisoner until close of war.

JAMES BRADLEY WESTMORELAND, Stevenson, was born March 10, 1840, at Stevenson; entered as pvt. in December, 1862, at Bolivar, Jackson Co., Ala., in the 6th Alabama Regiment, Co. K, and continued until close of war; surrendered at Appomatox Courthouse, Va.

JAMES R. WHITE, Bridgeport, was born December 10, 1842, at Madisonville, Monroe Co., Tennessee. First entered August 5, 1861, at Knoxville, Tenn., in the First Tennessee Cavalry Regiment and continued until surrendered with General Wade Hampton on North side of Potomac River April 9, 1865.

ANDREW JACKSON WHITE, Princeton, was born May 28, 1840, at Batesville, Spartanburg^{Co.}, S. C. Entered as pvt. May 13, 1861, at Rome, Ga., in the 8th Georgia Infantry Regiment, Co. H, and continued until taken prisoner May 6, 1864. Paroled for 90 days the 19th of March, 1865, by R. H. Ewell, Lieut. General. Re-enlisted as pvt. Feb. 17, 1864, at Morristown, Tenn., in the 8th Georgia Regiment, Co. H, and cont'd until discharged May 13, 1865.

MILES AUGUSTUS WILBANKS, Section, was born July 29, 1845, in Penalton, ^(Pendleton?) Anderson Co., S. C.; entered as pvt. Sept. 12, 1861, at Lebanon, Ala.

in the 3rd Confederate Regiment, Co. K, and continued until May, 1865.

ELIJAH WILSON, Pisgah, was born August 29, 1833, at Greenville, Green Co., S. C. Entered as pvt. in September, 1861, at Valley Head, Ala., in the 3rd Alabama Regiment, Co. A, and continued until May, 1865... Paroled at Augusta, Ga.

Dr. Lemuel Gilliam Wilson, Stevenson, was born February 28, 1835, at Sulphur Springs, Dekalb Co., Ala., entered as private in March, 1861, at Trenton, Ga. in the 39th Georgia Regiment, Co. D, and cont'd until close of war; surrendered at Saalsberry, N. C. with Joseph E. Johnston.

WILLIAM WILSON, Pisgah, was born in 1835, Green County, Tenn. Entered as pvt. October 1, 1862, at Trenton, Ga. "I was detailed to work at Confederate works at Trenton, Ga." Paroled May 19, 1865, at Pisgah, Ala.

GEORGE WASHINGTON WILHELMS, Scottsboro, was born Jan. 10, 1824 at Gurløy, Madison Co., Ala.; entered as pvt. on, or about, Dec. 15, 1863, at Bellefonte, in the 4th Confederate Regiment, Co. D, and cont'd until taken sick, when Capt. Dicus sent me home. Never entered service again.

ANDREW JACKSON WOODALL, Alto, Ala., was born (about 74 years old), at Cleveland, Polk Co., Tenn., first entered as pvt. in fall of 1861, at Chattanooga, Tenn., in the 19th Tennessee Regt, Co. I, and cont'd until discharged at Shiloh, Miss., at close of 12 months. Re-enlisted as pvt (do not remember date) at Trenton, Ga. in the 3rd Confederate Cavalry Regiment, Co. I, and continued until close of war.

ABNER BENTON WOMACK, Fackler, was born April 3, 1843, at Bellefonte, Ala.; entered as private on Dec. 20, 1862, at Bellefonte in the 49th Alabama Regiment, Co. C, and continued until captured at Port Hudson, La., July 7, 1863; paroled July 13, 1863.

ALEXANDER PATTON WOMACK, ^{Fackler}~~Fackler~~, was born May 30, 1835, at Bellefonte;

entered as 2nd Sergeant (later elected to 1st Lieutenant) at Stevenson in the 49th Alabama Infantry, Regiment, Co. C, and continued until captured at Fort Hudson, La., 8 May 1863. Sent to prison at Johnson's Island, Ohio; released from prison in June, 1865.

AARON WALDEN WOOSLEY, Larkinsville, Alabama, was born September 14, 1824, at Larkinsville, Ala.; entered as 4th Sergeant in September, 1862, at Larkinsville in Capt. John Dillard's Company and continued until close of war.

ELIJAH WORLEY, Hytop, Ala., was born Nov. 18, 1819, at Pikeville, Bledsoe Co., Tenn.; entered about August, 1862, at Murfreesboro, Tennessee, in the 5th Tennessee Regiment, Co. E, and continued until surrendered at Avington, Va., about April 28, 1865.

THOMPSON HENRY WRIGHT, Scottsboro, was born Sept. 16, 1838, at Cluttsville, Madison Co., Tenn. Entered as pvt. in May, 1861, at Bellefonte in the 2nd Confederate Regiment, Co. B, and continued until re-enlisted in another command in May, 1862, Port Hudson. Re-enlisted as pvt. in May, 1862, at Port Hudson, La. in the 4th Alabama Battalion, Co. B, and cont'd until captured at Peachtree Creek, Ga. in June, 1864. Sent to Camp Douglas, Illinois prison and remained in prison until June, 1865.

SAMUEL WYNN, Paint Rock, was born March 9, 1828, at Bolivar, Jackson Co., Ala.; entered in May (March?), 1861, at Paint Rock in the 2nd Confederate Regiment, Co. C, and continued until wounded and discharged after battle of Shiloh, Mississippi; 3 or 4 months later was discharged at Vicksburg, Miss.

WILLIAM STEPHEN YOUNG, Scottsboro was born March 31, 1836, at Franklin, Franklin Co., Tenn.; entered service as private on or about Dec. 1, 1862, at Port Hudson, La., in the 55th Ala. Regiment, Co. I, and cont'd until captured at Edwards Station, Miss. in June and paroled.
