Introduction**

The volunteer staff of the Heritage Center has prepared full name indexes for several Pre-Civil War record books in the Jackson County Courthouse. As the deeds, mortgages and minutes were read, we were aware that slaves were named in many of the indentures. In presenting this listing of the slave population, we advise the researcher to realize that it is not a complete census. Many slave owners were not involved in transfers of titles, mortgages, or estate settlements.

The 1820-1830 Probate (Orphans Court) Minute Book is the earliest known public record. There were fifty-seven cases brought before the Orphan's Court in this ten year period. Seventeen of the estates had a total of 68 slaves. One estate had nine slaves, one had seven, two had six, one had five, six had four, one had three, three had two, and two estates had one slave.

In conclusion, it is apparent that during the pioneer settlement era 1820 to 1840, slavery was not profitable on a small farm where subsistence farming was practiced. Most slave holders had fewer than four slaves. However, with a better means of transportation and market economy, the slave population grew.
