PRELIMINARY REPORT ON CEMETERIES

GUNTERSVILLE RESERVOIR

CEMERTERY #1, MYLH, PRIVATE, 3 GRAVES

This cemetery is located on the property of Foster A. Kyle in Section 27-Twp. 7 S. - R 3 E. Marshall County, Ala. - Elev. 602. This is an old abandoned cemetery and the possibility of identifying any of the graves is very remote. Present accessibility to same is by a field road and will not be greatly impaired by the flood waters from Guntersville Dam. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved nor means of accessibility be increased.

CEMETERY # 3, KING, PRIVATE, 16 GRAVES

The above cemetery is located on the property of Buck King and R. L. Lytle in Section 19 - Twp. 8 S - R 3 E, Marshall County, Alabama. Elev. 601 This cemetery seems to be abandoned and the identity of all graves unknown. Present accessibility is on foot only and will not be impaired by the flood waters from Guntersville Dam. I recommend that no graves be removed and that no access road to same be provided.

CEMETERY # 9, KENNAMER, PUBLIC, 64 GRAVES

This cometery is located on the property of Maggie Kennamer in Section 18
Twp. 7 S - R 4 E in Marshall County, Ala. - Elev. 604. From all information obtainable, this cometery has been in existence for well over 100 years and that it has never been known by any name. Information is that there are Whitos, Negroes and Indians buried here and that the last burial was made probably 40 years ago. Present accessibility is by field road over private property which will not be impaired by the flood waters from Guntersville Dam. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved nor means of accessibility be provided.

CELETERY #10 - HENRY PRIVATE - 8 GRAVES

This cemetery is located on the property of W. G. and Oscar Henry (Heirs) in Section 13 - Twp. 7 S - R 3 E, Marshall County, Alabama - Elev. 608. Present accessibility to this cemetery is by old County Road and a field road and the same will not be impaired by the flood waters from Guntersville Dam. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved nor additional means of accessibility be provided.

CEMETERY #12 - COOLEY PUBLIC - 157 GRAVES

The above cemetery is located on the property of William G. Jordan in Section 20 - Twp. 7 S - R 3 E, in Marshall County, Ala. - Elev. 636. Present accessibility to this cometery is by a wagon road thru the Jordan property which is in a very poor condition and will be flooded. This road extends on across Georgia Mountain to the Highway but is in very poor condition. Accessibility to this cemetery wil not be greatly impaired and I recommend that no graves be moved and that no additional access road to same be provided.

CEMETERY #15 - HONEYCOMB PUBLIC- 411 GRAVES

This cemetery is located on the property of the M. E. Church, South in Section 9 - Twp. 7 S - R 3 E, Marshall County, Ala. - Elev. 603 This cemetery is located beyond the T. V. A. purchase line and will be accessible by new highway being constructed by T. V. A. in lieu of Highway #241 which is flooded in this vicinity. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved and new means of accessibility be used.

CEMETERY # 8 - KELLEY PUBLIC - 61 Graves

This cemetery is located on the property of S. D. Presley et al in Section #29 - Twp. 5 S - R 5 E, Jackson County, Alabama. Elev, 608 Present accessibility is by County Road and on foot and the same will not be impaired by the flood waters from Guntersville Dam. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved.

CEMETERY #11 - GRANTHAM PRIVATE - 47 GRAVES

This cemetery is located on the property of the Grantham (Heirs) in Section #19 - Twp. 6 S - R 3 E, Marshall County, Alabama. Elev. 621. This cemetery seems to be approximately 75 years old and the majority of the graves are well marked with monuments. Present access to the cemetery is by private road from the County Road. This private road, approximately .3 miles long is in poor condition. The County Road will be flooded and is to be relocated. New access will necessitate constructing a low class road from the proposed road, a distance of approximately .6 miles. Should the cost of this proposed access road make construction of same prohibitive, I recommend that we contact surviving relatives of the deceased and offer to move the graves. I believe we can write the majority to remain.

CEMETERY #13 - PRESTON PUBLIC - 208 GRAVES

This cometery is located on the property of Solomon Benson in Section #14 - Twp. 6 S - R 4 E, Marshall County, Alabama. Elev. 643. Present accessibility is by State Highway and County Road and the same will not be impaired by the flood waters from Guntersville Dam. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved.

CEMETERY #17 - RESERVATION BLUFF - 97 GRAVES

This cemetery is located on the property of P. B. Lusk in Section 72 Twp. 8 S - R 3 E, Marshall County, Alabama. Elev. 698.

This cemetery seems to have been abandoned since about 1864 and there seems to be no one living who can possibly identify any of the graves. Present access is by State Highway and on foot and the same will not be impaired by the flood waters from Guntersville Dam. I recommend that no graves be moved from this cemetery.

CEMETERY #16 - HARDIN PRIVATE - 61 Graves

This cemetery is located on the property formerly owned by Emma Kate Hardin in Section 13 - Twp. 7 S - R 2 E, Marshall County, Alabama. Elev. 637. This cemetery has 61 graves, well kept and with interrements as recently as 1936. Present access is by a private road along the river which will be flooded by the building of Cuntersville Dam. This cemetery will be accessible only by an old private wagon road approximately 5 miles over the top of Bishop Mountain. Mr. R. E. Rush of the Highway Section informs writer that the cost of constructing an access road to this cemetery is prohibitive and that no such road will be built. We will be able to identify approximately 50 of these graves and locate surviving relatives of the same. We have interviewed nearest relatives to the majority of the deceased and Andrew Hardin and Mrs. Dona Morrow insist that we either build road into cemetery or move their deceased relation, 13 in number, to some other suitable cemetery. The relatives of the other deceased desire to have their relation remain.

I recommend that we contact surviving relatives of all the identified graves and secure removal or remain permits.

CHMETERY #18 - UNNAMED ABANDONED - NUMBER OF GRAVES INDEF.

This cemetery is located on the property of the First Joint Stock Land Eank of Montgomery, Ala. in Section #8 - Twp. 7 S - R 4 E Marshall County, Alabama. Elev. 595. This is an old abandoned cemetery in a sassafras thicket. The physical evidence of all the graves is obliterated and we are unable to determine the number of graves or the exact location of the same. We interviewed Mr. Jim Taylor, Scottsboro, Ala. who is 87 years old and the oldest resident of this community and he stated that he had lived in this community his entire life and that he had never known nor heard of any persons name who is buried in this cemetery. He assured me that there has been no burial here since 1864 and that the general belief is that it is an old slave cemetery, owners unknown. Fresent access is by foot across a cultivated field. We are unable to write removal or remain permits for same and I recommend that this cemetery be not moved.

CEMETERY #19 - KIRBY PRIVATE - 3 GRAVES

This cemetery is located on the property of W. N. Bain in Section #9
Twp. 7 S = R 5 E, Marshall County, Alabama. Elev. 651
The cemetery seems to be old and abandoned but we have located a
surviving relative of the deceased therein. Present access is by
private road, in poor condition, and by foot. This road will be
flooded by the backwaters of Guntersville Dam. I recommend that
we contact the nearest relatives of the deceased and secure removal
or remain permits for the same.

CEMETERY #20 - CHANDLER PRIVATE - NUMBER OF GRAVES INDEF.

This cemetery is located on the property of S. J. Walls in Section #4
Twp. 7 S - R 4 E, Marshall County, Alabama. Flev. 600.
The physical evidence of all the graves has been obliterated and we are unable to determine the exact number or location of graves.
Records indicate there has not been a burial here for the past 83 years. Present access is by a private road which will be inundated by the flood waters of Guntersville Dam. I have contacted C. F. Chandler, A. G. Chandler and Jesse Jones, the nearest surviving relatives to all the deceased and executed an agreement with them whereby all the bodies will remain.
I recommend that this cemetery be not moved nor access be provided for same.

CEMETERY #21 - VAUGHT PRIVATE - 10 GRAVES

This cemetery is located on the property of D. M. Vaught (Heirs) in Section #10 - Twp. 6 S - R 5 E, in jackson County, Alabama. Elev. 621. Present accessibility is by County Road and the same will not be impaired by the flood waters from Guntersville Dam. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved.

- CEMETERY #24 - BOYD PUBLIC - 35 GRAVES

This cemetery is located on the property of T. E. Morgan and H. O. Weeks in Section #3 - Twp. 6 S - R 5 E, Jackson County, Alabama. - Elev. 617. This is an old abandoned cometery, grown up in woods and underbrush, with graves barely discernable. Present accessibility is by farm road and on foot. The primary purpose of this farm road is to serve farm and not the cemetery. This road is to be flooded and the land in this vicinity acquired by T. V. A. Road accessibility to this cemetery is not greatly impaired. Another field road that is above the pool contour may be used. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved.

CEMETERY #25 - ROMAN (ABANDONED) - 11 GRAVES

This cometery is located on the property of T. P. Davis in Section #10 - Twp. 6 S - R 5 E, Jackson County, Alabama. Elev.612. This is an old abandoned cometery on a knoll in a cultivated field. Identity of any graves unknown. Present access is on foot and same will not be impaired by the flood waters from Guntersville. Dam. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved.

CEMETERY #26 - CHANEY PUBLIC - 62 GRAVES

This cemetery is located on the property of Veda Spivey in Section #8 - Twp. 5 S - R 6 E, Jackson County, Alabama. - Elev. 684.

Present access is by County Road and on foot and same will not be impaired by the flood waters from Guntersville Dam. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved.

CEMETERY #27 - DELANCY PRIVATE - 2 GRAVES

This cemetery is located on the property of Charles K. Bradford near Bellfonte, in Jackson County, Alabama. - Elev. 617.

Present accessibility is on foot only and the same will not be impaired by the flood waters from Guntersville Dam. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved.

CEMETERY #28 - PIERCE PUBLIC - 41 CRAVES

This cemetery is located on the property of the Pierce (Heirs) in Section #17 - Twp. 5 S - R 5 E, Jackson County, Alabama. Elev. 660. Present accessibility is by County Road and on foot and same will not be impaired by the flood waters from Guntersville Dam. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved.

CELETERY #29 - CHISENHALL PUBLIC - 106 CRAVES

this cemetery is located on the property of Lottie A. Hembree in Section #21 - Twp. 5 S - R 6 E, Jackson County, Alabama. Elev.607 Present accessibility is by County Road and on foot and the same is not impaired by the flood waters from Guntersville Dam. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved.

CEMETERY #30 - COLORED PUBLIC - 49 GRAVES

This cemetery is owned by the general public in this community. Located in Section #21 - Twp. 3 S - R 7 E, Jackson County, Alabama. Elev. 621. This cemetery is located outside the T. V. A. purchase line. Severance lines were established around this cemetery with a 20' roadway for ingress and egress. Same is not impaired by the flood waters from Guntersville Dam. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved.

CEMETERY #31 - HENRY PRIVATE - 3 GRAVES

This cometery is located on the property of John F. Armstrong (Heirs) in Section #28 - Twp. 4 S - R 6 E, Jackson County, Alabama. Elev.620 This is an old cemetery and seems to be abandoned. Present access is by a farm road and on foot for about 1000. A section of this road to be inundated by flood waters from Guntersville Dam. I cant see any responsibility on the part of the T. V. A. to maintain this road as the prime purpose for same is to serve farm, which is being acquired by the T. V. A., and not the cemetery. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved nor access road for same be provided.

CFMETERY #32 - CHISENHALL FRIVATE - 21 GRAVES

This cemetery is located on the property of the Chisenhall (Heirs) in Section #1 - Twp. 5 S - R 6 E, Jackson County, Alabama. Elev. 607 Present access is by County Road and same is not impaired by flood waters from Guntersville Dam. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved.

CEMETERY #35 - CLAYTON PRIVATE - 1 GRAVE

This grave is located on the property of Maggie Parks in Section #26 Twp. 5 S - R 5 E, in Jackson County, Alabama. Elev.706 This grave is located on top and is accessible only on foot. Access will not be impaired by the flood waters from Guntersville Dam. I recommend that this cemetery be not moved.

CEMETERIES #34 - #35 -#36 - #37 - UNNAMED ABANDONED

These 4 cemeteries are located in the Brown Creck Valley near State H/W No. 32 below the 595 contour. Exact location of these cemeteries and number of graves in same unknown. We interviewed Mr. B. F. Brown, Guntersville, Ala., Route #lwho has lived in this community for 59 years and he states that these cemeteries have been cultivated over and the possibility of ever locating any of the graves or relatives or relatives of the deceased is very remote. He remembers seeing 2 of these cemeteries seeing 2 of these cemeteries about 50 years but is unable to point out the exact location. We are unable to write removal or remain permits for same and I recommend that these cemeteries be not moved.

CEMETERIES TO BE FLOODED

CEMETERY # 5 RUSSELL PUBLIC, 31 GRAVES

This Cemetery located on the Property of J. G. Russell in Section 20, TWP 8 S, R 3 E, Marshall County, Ala. Elevation 590. Final action on this cemetery now pending. Mr. J. G. Russell owner of the land adjoining the Cemetery, will not permit the TVA to enter this property to remove any graves. He states that his reasons for so doing is that the TVA has not yet acquired his property and that his wife is ill and he does not want any operations in the Cemetery, which is located near his residence, until he has moved from property. Mr. Russell is the nearest relative to 10 of the deceased in the Cemetery and he states that "he does not wan't them moved" but he will not sign any permit for them to remain. We have contacted nearest relatives of 17 of the deceased and executed permits for 11 to remain and 6 to be moved to the Clear Springs Cemetery. There are 4 graves we are unable to identify or locate relatives for same. To complete this Cemetery it will be necessary to send a removal crew here some time after Mr. Russell has bean removed from Property and move graves No. 22-23-24-25-26 and 27 to the Clear Springs Cemetery. Advise Mrs. Eula E. Smith, 1012 N. 30th Street, Birmingham, Ala., a few days prior to the this operation, the exact day of the operation, so that she may attend if she so desires. The remainder of the graves will be inundated. Removal orders and Permits may be found in the file for Russell Cemetery.

CEMETERY # 23, COFFEETOWN PUBLIC, 29 GRAVES

This Cemetery is located on the Property of W. H. Campbell in Section 11, TWP 6 S, R 5 E, Jackson County, Ala. Elevation 598. We identified 6 graves and executed 3 removal and 3 remain permits. 3 graves have been moved to a new location and 26 graves will be flooded.

CEMETERY # 2 EASLEY PRIVATE, 13 GRAVES

Located on the Property of R. L. Lytle in Section 18, TWP 8 S, R 3 E, Marshall County, Ala., Elevation 596. This Cemetery moved to new location.

This Cemetery located on the Property of William G. Jordan in Section 17, TWP 7 S, R 3 E, Marshall County, Ala. Elevation 596. We executed removal permits for 28 graves and remain permits for 4 graves. Permits for the removal of 4 Monuments from the graves that are to remain were executed and Cemetery has been relocated accordingly.

CEMETERY # 22, MOODY PRIVATE, 2 GRAVES

This Cemetery located on the Property of Milo Moody in Section 11, TWP 6 S, R 5 E, Jackson County, Ala. Elevation 596. 2 remain permits were executed and Cemetery is to be flooded.

CEMETERY # 34, ASHMORE PRIVATE, 1 GRAVE

This Cemetery located on the property of W. N. Bain in Section 3, TWP 7 S, R 4 E, Jackson County, Ala. Elevation 585. A removal permit was executed for this grave. The exact location of grave is remote and after a thourough search and a number of excavations were made, we failed to find any evidence of grave. Mr. John Ashmore was present and stated he was satisfied with our efforts to find grave. This Grave to be flooded.

CEMETERY # 19, KIRBY PRIVATE, 3 GRAVES

This Cemetry located on the Property of W. N. Bain in Section 9, TWP 7 S, R 5 E, Marshall County, Ala. Elevation 651. This Cemetery to be inaccessable by road-way. We have contacted nearest relatives of the deceased and executed 3 Remain Permits. All Graves to remain in original location.

CEMETERY # 20, CHANDLER PRIVATE, NUMBER GRAVES UNKNOWN

This Cemetery located on the Propeerty of S. J. Walls in Section 4, TWP 7 S, R 4 E, Elevation 600. This Cemetery to be inaccessable by road. Number and location of graves very indefinite as all physical evidence of same obliterated. We have executed an agreement with the nearest relatives of the deceased whereby graves are to remain in their original location.

CEMETERY # 39, WHEELER PRIVATE, APPROXIMATELY 12 GRAVES

This Cemetery is located on the Property of E. L. Franklin in Jones Cove, Jackson County, Ala. To be inaccessable by roadway. Physical evidence as to exact location of individual graves is very vague. We have executed an agreement with the nearest relatives of all deceased whereby the Cemetery is to be not disturbed but remain inaccessable by roadway.

Pursuant to an application filed with the State Department of Health of Kentucky by Dr. E. L. Bishop, Director of Health of the Authority, permission is hereby granted the Tennessee Velley Authority, and their authorized representatives, to disinter, remove and re-bury any and all dead bodies now buried in the Gilbertsville Reservoir area in Marshall, Livingston, Calloway, Lyon and Trigg Counties, Kentucky, and which by reason of the building of the Gilbertsville Dam will be covered or affected by the said impounded waters, provided:

- 1. That before any of the said bodies are disinterred or removed the nearest of kin of the deceased will be consulted and such arrangements for the removal are made as meets the approval of the said kin or family.
- 2. That the Authority agrees to furnish the State Department of Health of Kentucky a complete list of all removals, which, insefer as is possible will include name of the deceased, color, sex, date of birth or approximate age, place of present burial and place of burial after removal.
- That all disinterments and removals made under this permit shall be made in accordance with and conformity to Rules 171 and 172 of the Rules and Regulations of the State Board of Health of Kentucky, which read as follows:

FRULE 171. Disinterments. No dead body shall be disinterred between May 1st and October 1st of any year unless such body has been buried five years or longer. No dead body shall be disinterred or removed at any time except upon a special permit issued by the State Registrar upon application filed by the party desiring to make such disinterment and removal. Provided: Local registrars may issue permits for disinterment of bodies to be removed from one grave to another in the same cemetery in their own district if death did not result from any of the diseases mentioned in Rule 48."

RULE 172. Preparation of Disinterred Bodies. Every disinterred body, dead from any disease or cause, shall be treated as infectious or dangerous to the public health and shall not be removed or accepted for transportation until said remains or coffin or casket containing same has been wrapped in a sheet thoroughly saturated with an approved disinfectant fluid and inclosed in a hermetically sealed metal or metal lined box. The foregoing requirement may be waived at the discretion of the State Registrar if it shows in the permit that the body to be
