During the development of Skyline Farms Project, a new school building was built about one mile west of the Alto Post Office. About 1935 a new Junior High was developed. By 1938, eleven grades were being taught. The students in the 12th grade were transported to the Jackson County High School in Scottsboro.

Later, Federal Court orders prohibited the county from transporting students to Scottsboro School. The Jackson County Board of Education developed Skyline Junior High School into a 12th grade high school.
