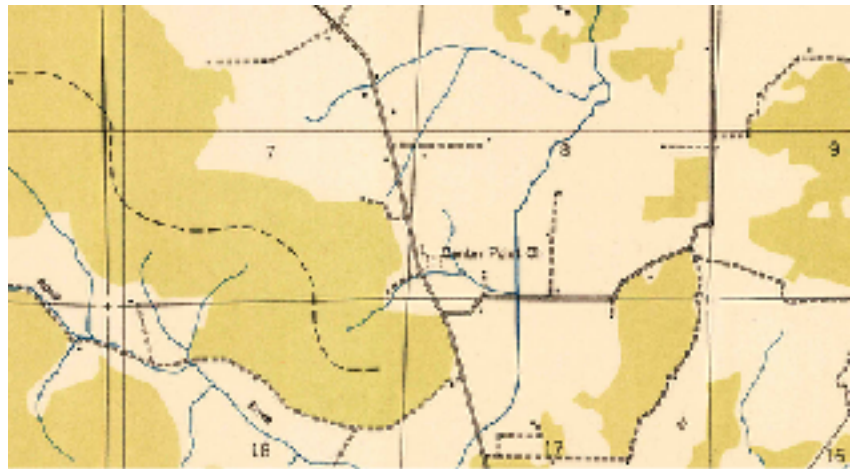

## NOTICE OF SPECIAL THREE-MILL ELECTION

Center Point District No. 54.  
Notice is hereby given that a Special Election will be held in Center Point School District No. 54, Jackson county, Alabama, at the residence of Mrs. Robertson, in said district, on the 10th day of February, 1922, for the purpose of determining whether or not a special tax shall be levied and collected annually, at the rate of thirty cents on each one hundred dollars' worth of taxable property in Center Point District No. 54, said county, and to be continued for a period of 8 years from September 30th, 1922, the same to be for the support of the public school within said district.

The boundaries of said School district No. 54 are as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner Section 18, Township 4, Range 6, E; thence East 3 miles; thence North 2 miles; thence West 1 mile; thence North one-quarter mile; thence West 1 mile; thence South one-quarter mile; thence West 1 mile; thence South 2 miles; to point of beginning, containing in all Sections 12, 13, Tp. 4 South, Range 6 East; also Sections 7, 8, 17, 18, south half of SE 1/4 of Section 6, and South half of SW 1/4 Section 6, Township 4, Range 6, Jackson county, Ala.

Isid McClellan, Frank Thompson and W. G. Harrington are appointed managers of said election, and Geo. Phillips Returning Officer for said election.
