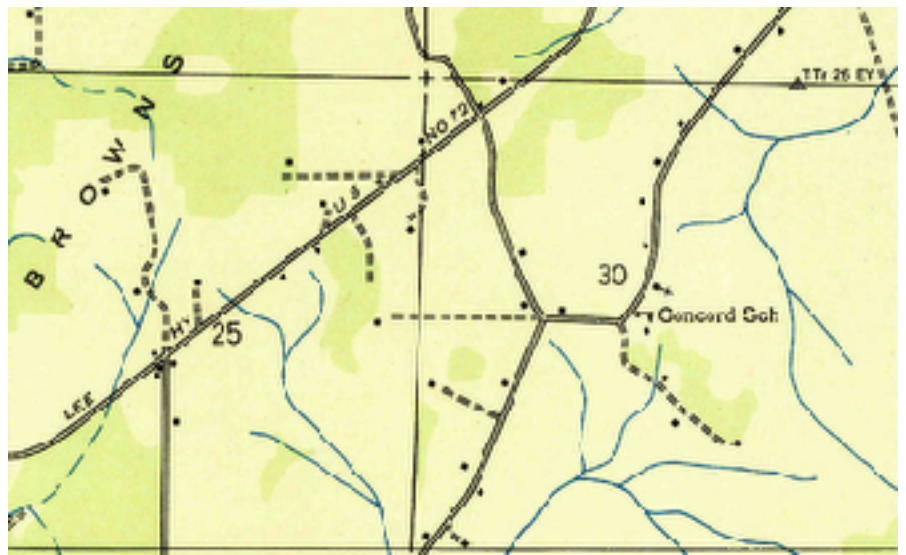

NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that a special election will be held in
Concord District No. 31,
at School House
Jackson County, Alabama, on the
26th day of July, 1928, for the purpose of determining whether or not a special tax shall be levied and collected annually, at the rate of 30 cents on each one hundred dollars worth of taxable property in
Concord District No. 31,
in said county, and to be continued for a period of two years from September 30, 1928, the same to be for the support of the public schools within said district. The boundaries of said district are as follows:
Beginning at the northwest corner of section 25, Tp 1, R 8, east; thence east to the west bank of Tennessee River; thence with said Tennessee River to the point where said Tennessee River intersects with the north and south section line separating section 1 and 2, Tp 2, R 8; thence north to point of beginning. Said district contains sections 25 and 36, Tp 1, R 8; also section 1, Tp 2, R 8, and that part of section 12, Tp 2, R 8, lying north and west of the Tennessee river. Also sections 29, 30, 31, and that part of 32 lying north and west of Tennessee river, Tp 1, R 9. That part of section 6, Tp 2, R 9, lying north and west of Tennessee river. All of said district being in Jackson County, Alabama.
