

References to the Dutton School can be found as early as 1901.

**Jan 31, 1901 PA**: Miss Laura Smally of Dutton entered school here [in Pisgah] this week. indicating that there was no school in Dutton. John Smalley entered Pisgah school in 1915.

**Nov 23, 1911 PA**: "County Superintendent C. S. Brewton visited the Sul[hur Springs public school Wednesday night and will visit the Flat Rock school Thursday a.m. the Rosalie School Thursday p.m., the Pisgah School Friday a.m., and Chalybeate Springs school Friday p.m. He will also attend public land sales at Dutton Saturday.

**Sep 4, 1913 PA:** Opening of the Dutton School: "Prof. Jarnagin is of this county and is one of the foremost educators of the state. Having been teaching here for a number of years, he now has the position of principal at the Dutton school with Mrs. Jarnagin as assistant. Prof. and Mrs. Jarnagin will reside near Pisgah until the opening of their school.

Oct 20, 1916 PA: Mr. and Mrs. J. D. Garren will leave in a few days for Dutton where they will have charge of the Dutton school."

Mar 5, 1925 PA: Meeting with J. T. Blue, the county agent

Mar 12, 1925 PA: Dutton school had an auditorium. A play "The Dust of the Earth" was presented in the auditorium of the Dutton school building by the Junior High School of Dutton.

**Apr 16, 1925:** Commencement at Dutton School, contest between literary societies and the junior high play also presented.

June 2, 1927 PA: Prof. F. M. Butteram was employed a Principal of the school at Dutton. He comes highly rec commended and his appointment was requested by the trustee of the school district.

**Jul 25, 1929:** School Board meeting minutes. "Earl McGriff was made a trustee of the Dutton school."

Aug 6, 1925 PA: Farm Bureau presentation at school

**Sep 24, 1925 PA:** Dutton School to open Monday, October 5th. "The Dutton Junior High School will open Monday, October 5th at 10 a.m. The following is the faculty: J. H. Jarnagin, principal; Mrs. J. H. Jarnagin, Miss Beryl Stockton, Miss Clarice Kennamer, Mrs. C. R. Chambers. Ten grades will be taught. Parents, pupils, and friends of the school are earnestly request to be present at the opening. Supt. Wheeler and J. S. Benson will be present."

Feb 18, 1926 PA: Dutton school is progressive nicely with an enrollment of about 250.

Mar 25, 1926 PA: Dutton School Closing this week with Programs. Three days of programs by various age groups.

Jul 15, 1926 PA: Vaccination clinic

**Sep 23, 1926 PA:** Dutton School to open Next Week: "The Dutton School will open on next Monday, October 4th, with Prof. H. R. Campbell principal, and Misses Eva Johns, Lexit Burkhalter, Pearl Dance and Thelma Wilson assistants.

**Feb 14 1929 PA:** Dutton girls and boys defeated Coffey girls and boys here last Friday night in basketball. The scores for the boys were 24 and 6. The score for the girls was 11 and 5.

**Feb 21, 1929 PA:** "Our school is progressing nicely. There were three interesting ball games here last Thursday night. Dutton boys played Section boys. The scores were 20 to 11 in favor of Dutton. Dutton school girls played Section school girls. The score was 19 to 0 in favor of Dutton, the first half and Coach Nichols slipped in an extra girl and that made Section six girls to Dutton's five. The score being 23 to 6. Last Friday nigh Dutton school girls played Powell's Store girls. The score was 20 to 10 in favor of Dutton. Dutton school boys played Powell's Store boys The scores were 25 to 17 in favor of Dutton. There will be a negro minstrel here Friday night, feb. 22nd. Admission is 15 and 20 cents. Everybody come and bring someone with you."

Mar 7, 1929 PA: Minstrel show took in \$38. Boys basketball played Hollywood and Scottsboro Junior and Section.

**Sep 29, 1932 PA:** Dutton News. "Our school is progressing nicely the attendance is very good although it is cotton picking time. We have two new teachers with us this year Miss Austin and Mrs. Jones the old ones Mr. Wharton, Mr. Wheeler. We feel that we should do some splendid work under this faculty."
