

According to Wendell Page, Fabius School was in operation from 1908 to 1939 as a one teacher school and probably consolidated with Stevenson. The school was still in operation in 1950 when the newspapers carried profiles of local schools. In this profile, the Fabius school a two-room frame building on two acre of land serving an average of 41 students per day, 100% of whom were farm children and 75% of whom rode buses to get to school. The school had no lunchroom or janitor.

Nov 18, 1909 PA: Politicians lectured at all existing schools in 1909 for passage of Alabama Constitutional Amendment 1909 that prohibited the "manufacture, sale and keeping for sale of alcoholic and malt liquors and other intoxicating beverages." It was defeated 61% No, 39% Yes. Rev. Marion Briscoe spoke for the amendment at Fabius School Nov 19, 1909. Nov 11, 1915 SC: "The school opened again Monday morning after five weeks vacation."
