

## Fackler Rosenwald School

Also referred to a Fackler Colored School  
Location: S8/T3/R7E

1922-23 Olive Branch, 5 months at \$40  
1923-24 Dan Cross, 4 months as \$35

The first mention of "Fackler Rosenwald" school was January 29, 1931 when the Progressive Age reported that the average attendance at the school was 92%. The same high figure was reported in March. The school was profiled as "Fackler Negro School" in the 1950 survey of county schools in the Jackson County Sentinel. And in July 1952, the Progressive Age ran a series of notices that the Fackler Colored School Building would be sold. The bid covered only the building "as the land reverts back to the original guarantor."
