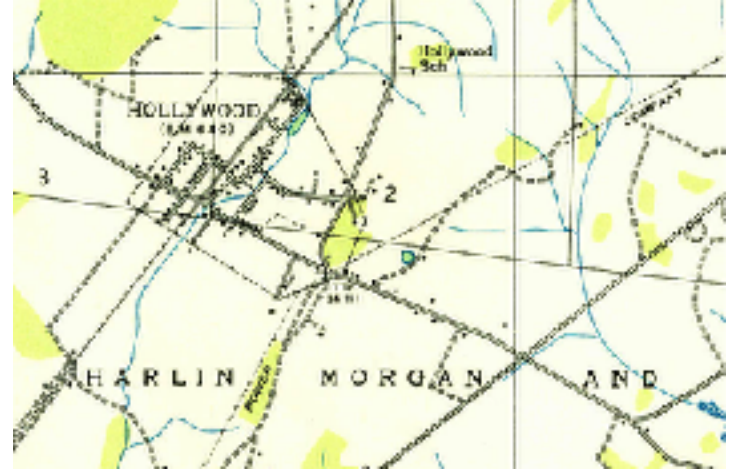

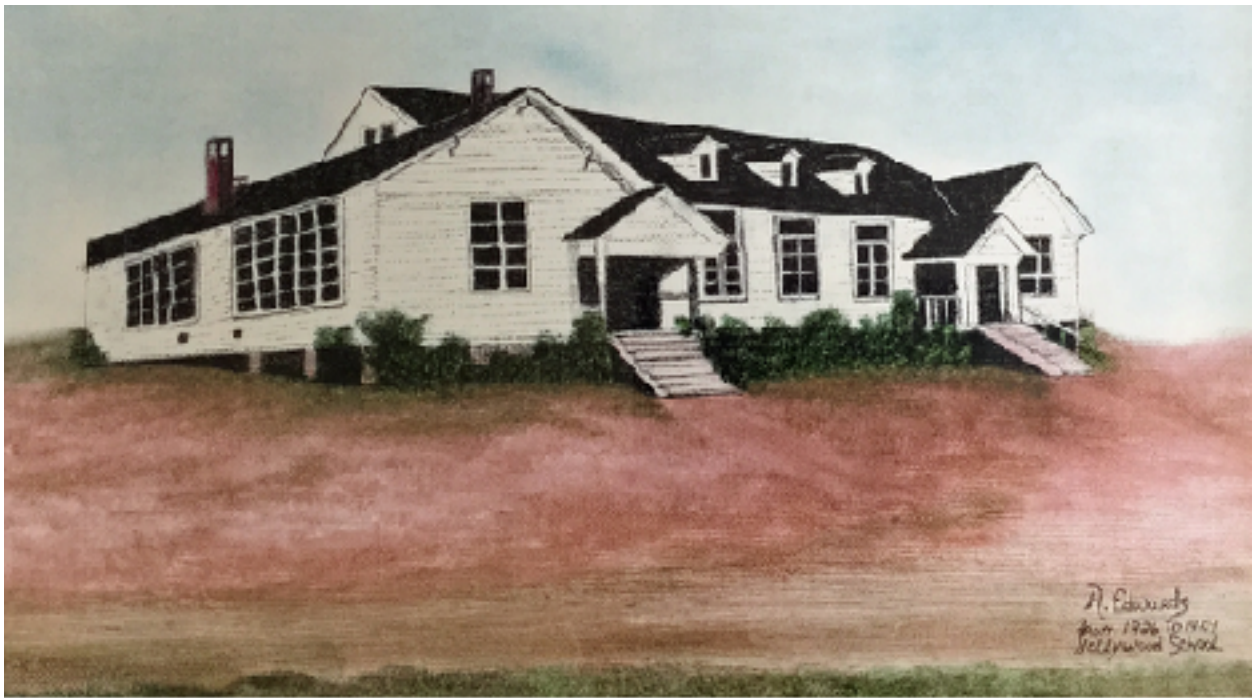

Jan 26, 1894 PA: "Hollywood is putting on city airs. The school bell at that place can be heard distinctly each morning."

Nov 26, 1903 PA: Pisgah News. "Miss Daisy Beeson has closed her school near Hollywood and returned home."

Feb 12, 1931 PA: "Last Friday afternoon the second team from Hollywood won easily over Tupelo in a fast game. The score being 14-6 in favor of Hollywood....Our attendance continues good."

Feb 26, 1931 PA: "J. S. Benson visited our school Tuesday and gave a very interesting talk. His talk was featured by taking the advantage of educational opportunities....The Hollywood Junior High School defeated Princeton last Friday afternoon by a one sided score. The score being 21-11 in favor of Hollywood. The game was featured by the the accurate shooting of Sebring of Hollywood, who accounted for a total of 16 points. Hambrick was the outstanding player of Princeton."
