
## **King's Cove School**

1908-1939: One-teacher school. Probably consolidated with Bridgeport.

In 1927, King's Cove was a one-teacher school. Teachers at this school include Rose Brewer (1923), Irene Matthews (1928), and Allie Mae Loyd (1927, 1937). King's Cove as a place name can be found as early as the 1898 *Scottsboro Citizen*. Teacher in 1928 was Miss Irene Matthews.

**Mar 15, 1927 PA:** School Pages, edited by Miss Haynes. Edna Sparkman, a fifth grader at Rocky Springs, wrote the newspaper about their Arbor Day exercises with King's Cove.

**Sep 19, 1929 PA:** Special election inspectors for the school tax election were J. M. Matthews, T. B. Stewart, Jim H. Rogers, and Walter Arendale.

**Mar 31, 1932 PA:** The health department came to King's Cove School to show movies about diphtheria, hookworm, malaria, sanitation, and drainage.

**Jun 9, 1932 PA:** "The Kington's Cove Community extends to the public a very pressing invitation and hearty welcomes to attend the celebration of the forth0eighth anniversary of Uncle Hope Stewart's Superintendancy of Sunday School work, on the ground of the King's Cove School on Sunday, June 12th, 1932.

Bridgeport, March 6. Dear Miss Haynes: When are you coming to see as again? I hope it will not be long. Rocky Speings is the name of our little rand school. We are two miles rest of Bridgeport. Friday we had a fine time. Our itnecter, Miss Alie Mae Lord, invitof the King's Cove school down to our Arbor Day exercises. So their teacher, Miss Brene Matthewa, came with her school. They said they enjoyed our program. After the program was over, we went out into the yard and planted several trees and some schoolberg. I am ten years old, and in the fifth grade. I like to go to school EDNA SEARKMAN.

Jan 17, 1935 PA: Attendance report for school, King's Cove averaged 61.1 attendance.

**Jul 4, 1935 PA:** DPT and Smallpox vaccination clinics held at King's Cove School. Also Jul 2, 1936.

**Nov 4, 1937 PA:** County School Board report. J. B. Cooper was paid \$8.00 for providing coal to King's Cove School.

**Nov 18, 1937:** Miss Allie Mae Loyd, teacher at King's Cove, did a presentation on local history at the Teacher Meeting.

Jun 2, 1938 PA: Rabies vaccination clinic at King's Cove School. Also Jen 15, 1939

**Nov 19, 1938 PA:** School Board Report. W. W. Sparkman was paid \$5.00 for repairs to King's Cove school, and W. T. Badger was paid \$21.18.

**Jun 13, 1940 PA:** DPT and Smallpox vaccinations given at the school. Also Aug 7 1941 and Jul 23, 1942.

No other information turned up from a newspaper search on this school name. King's Cove was not included in the 1950 school report in the local newspaper.s
