Nov 18, 1909 PA: Politicians lectured at all existing schools in 1909 for passage of Alabama Constitutional Amendment 1909 that prohibited the “manufacture, sale and keeping for sale of alcoholic and malt liquors and other intoxicating beverages.” It was defeated 61% No, 39% Yes. Rev. Marion Briscoe spoke for the amendment at Kyles Spring School Nov 24, 1909.

Jan 17, 1929 PA: Kyles News. “School at this place is progressing nicely with A. N. Varnell as teacher.”
