
Pikeville School

Mike Bradford on Facebook: There was a one room school house at one time about 100 yards up the road from the Pikeville Store as you travel towards Tupelo. My dad attended there as a child it was not far from the house my ggf Dave Bradford lived. Both buildings no longer exist but I think I could find the site of the school. Dwayne Wilkerson who owns the store could probably remember the site too. It sat back from the road about 50 yards. On the Northside of the road. The big old wooden Pikeville Store was on the site of the current building. Next was Ruby and Al Wilkerson's house then my GGPARENTS Dave and Myra Bradford and then further back from the road in the woods stood the old schoolhouse. I remember exploring it as a kid.

Dec 29, 1927 PA: "The Christmas tree was enjoyed by a large crowd. School will begin Monday after a week's vacation for Christmas."
