No records for this school in minutes of the Jackson County Board of Education.

Apr 27, 1894 PA: Parks Store News. "Quite a crowd attended the singing at Union school house last Sunday night."

Oct 1, 1896 SC: Aspel News. "Prof. J.P. Brown's school at Union school house closed last Wednesday, and he is at work on his father's farm."

May 8, 1902 PA: Sauta News. "Prof. Shelton is preparing an entertainment, which will be given at Union school-house Friday night, May 9."

Apr 23, 1903 PA: Sauta News "Professor Johnson's school closes at Union schoolhouse Friday. At night a concert will be given—something good and entertaining. everybody come and enjoy it. An entrance fee of 15 and 10 cents will be charged. The proceeds will be used in getting seats for the school."

Jul 19, 1906 SC: In an article about the farmers' union meeting all over the county. "After dinner the second day it was decided to hold the next county meeting at Union schoolhouse near Larkin's Landing on the 3rd and 4th of October."

Jan 9, 1911 PA: "Mr. Dan Porter Jr. won the corn club prize offered by Skelton Bros. for the best acre of corn in the Union School District."

Mar 9, 1916 PA: Oak Grove News. "There will be an entertainment at the Union School House Saturday night for the benefit of our school. Everyone invited."
