

The first reference to Wannville school is found in the December 21, 1922 Progressive Age. "School is progressing nicely with good attendance. Misses Elizabeth Wann and Elora Schrader are teaching in Prof. A. D. Collins' room during his absence....Prof. Orville W. Schrader went to Scottsboro Saturday on business."

Feb 15, 1923 PA: "The Wannville school will have a program for Washington's birthday and a pie supper to follow."

Nov. 3, 1927 PA: "There will be a pie supper at Wannville School house Saturday night, Nov. 5th. Also a free program will be rendered. Everyone invited."

May 3, 1928 PA: The School Page in the PA recognized the students from Wanville school who had graduated from 6th grade: "Doris Wann, Lorene Beaver, and Walter Foshee."

Jun 21, 1928 PA: Vote called for 3-mil tax.

Aug 9, 1928 PA: Report on the special 10 mil tax election in District 16 (Wannville School District) on the election held July 26. "40 votes were cast in said election for the proposed taxation and 29 votes were cast in the said election against proposed taxation." W. R. Bogart, Judge of Probate, W. H. Cox, W. W. Trice, R. S. Skelton, and Raymond Bradford, County Commissioners

May 2, 1929 PA: "School at this place will close Friday. A program will be given Saturday night."

March 13, 1930 PA: "The honor roll from the fifth month at Wannville School is as follows; Sixth grade—Jimmie Edward, Ernest Welch, Christine Owens. Fifth grade—Bertha Lee Ferguson, Ilah Holder, Daisy Shrader, Billie Grace Thornhill. Fourth grade—Ruby Maud Akin, Maud Ferguson, Emma Holt. Third grade—Douglas Corbett. Second grad—Elizabeth Edwards, Clyde Holder, Thomas Holt, Gordon Beavers. First grade—Florence Edward, Mae Mackels, and W. O. Long."

Notice is hereby given that a special election will be held in Wannville District No. 26, at School House

Jackson County, Alabama, on the 26th day of July 1928, for the purpose of determining whother or not a special tax shall be levied and collected annually, at the rate of 30 cents on each one hundred dollars worth of taxable property in

Wannville District No. 26, in said county, and to be continued for a period of two years from September 30, 128, the same to be for the support of the public schools within said district. The boundaries of said district are as follows:

Beginning at NW corner of section 10, Tp 3, R 7; thence E ½ mile; thence south ½ mile; thence east to Tennessee river; thence with said Tennessee River to SW corner of section 34; thence north 2 miles; thence west 1 mile; thence north 1 mile; thence west ½ mile; thence north 1 mile to point of beginning. Said district contains sections 14, 15, 21, 22, 23, 27, the NW ¼ and the S ¼ of section 10, the S½ of 11, the SW ¼ of 12, tha tpart of the SE¼ of section 12 lying north and west of Tennessee river; the cast ¼ of section 16, tha tpart of sections 13 and 24 lying west of Tennessee river and that part of sections 26, 34, 35 lying north and west of Tennessee river. All of said district being in Tp 3, R 7, Jackson County, Ala The following officers are appointed to hold said elserion:

Holder, Oliver Long, clerks; W. J. Jones, R. O. R. R. Skelton, W., W. Trice, W. H. Cox, Raymond Bradford, Members, Board of Commissioners, Jackson County, Als., M. C. Thomas, Sheriff of Jackson County, Ala. **Sep 3, 1931 PA:** Health clinics held at Wannville School on dates in September.

Nov 19, 1931 PA: "Wannville School will give a free entertainment Saturday night, November 21st, and following the program a pie supper will take place, the proceeds of the sale of pies goes for benefit of Wannville School. The Little Four Quartet of Scottsboro have been especially invited and we hope that every one will be present, and hear this young quartet.

Aug 13, 1936 PA: Diptheria, Typhoid and Smallpox vaccination clinic at Wannville School

Dec 17, 1936 PA: Entertainment described in the article.

Nov 4, 1937 PA: County school board report shows that Ada M. Wann was paid #4.40 for supplies for Wannville school, and C. W. Craze was paid \$2.50 for wood.

Nov 19, 1938 PA: County school board report shows that Pomp Stewart was paid \$15.00 for cleaning the toilets at Wannville School.

Apr 6, 1939 PA: Vaccination clinics held because "There are several cases of smallpox in and about Fackler, Wannville, Hollywood, and Bellefonte. Many persons in the county, including Scottsboro, have been exposed. Everyone is urged to be vaccinated."

Nov 20, 1941 PA: Forestry film shown at Wannville School.

Last mention of this school.
