planting seed in different types of soils, writing, and many other activities too numerous to mention, are carried on in connection with these projects.

Besides the regular textbooks, a great many magazines and newspapers are used. Encyclopedias, world books, current magazines, daily newspapers, current events are among the materials used.

The class is organized, having a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer. All committees for housekeeping and other things are appointed by the president—also, he or she takes care of all elections and leads the class in deciding questions concerning them all. The secretary keeps all records. This helps prepare the students for living in a democratic country by giving them an opportunity to think for themselves and to have a voice in running their own affairs. All these things are done with the guidance and help of the teacher.

Several periods each week are given over to the reading and the discussing of books. The books are obtained from the public and school libraries and some have been brought by members of the class from their home libraries. We have a librarian, chosen by the class who is in charge of our room library. A record is kept by the teacher of the books read by each student. Some very interesting written reports are often made.

In this way the student is given fuller educational facilities to help him in every way.

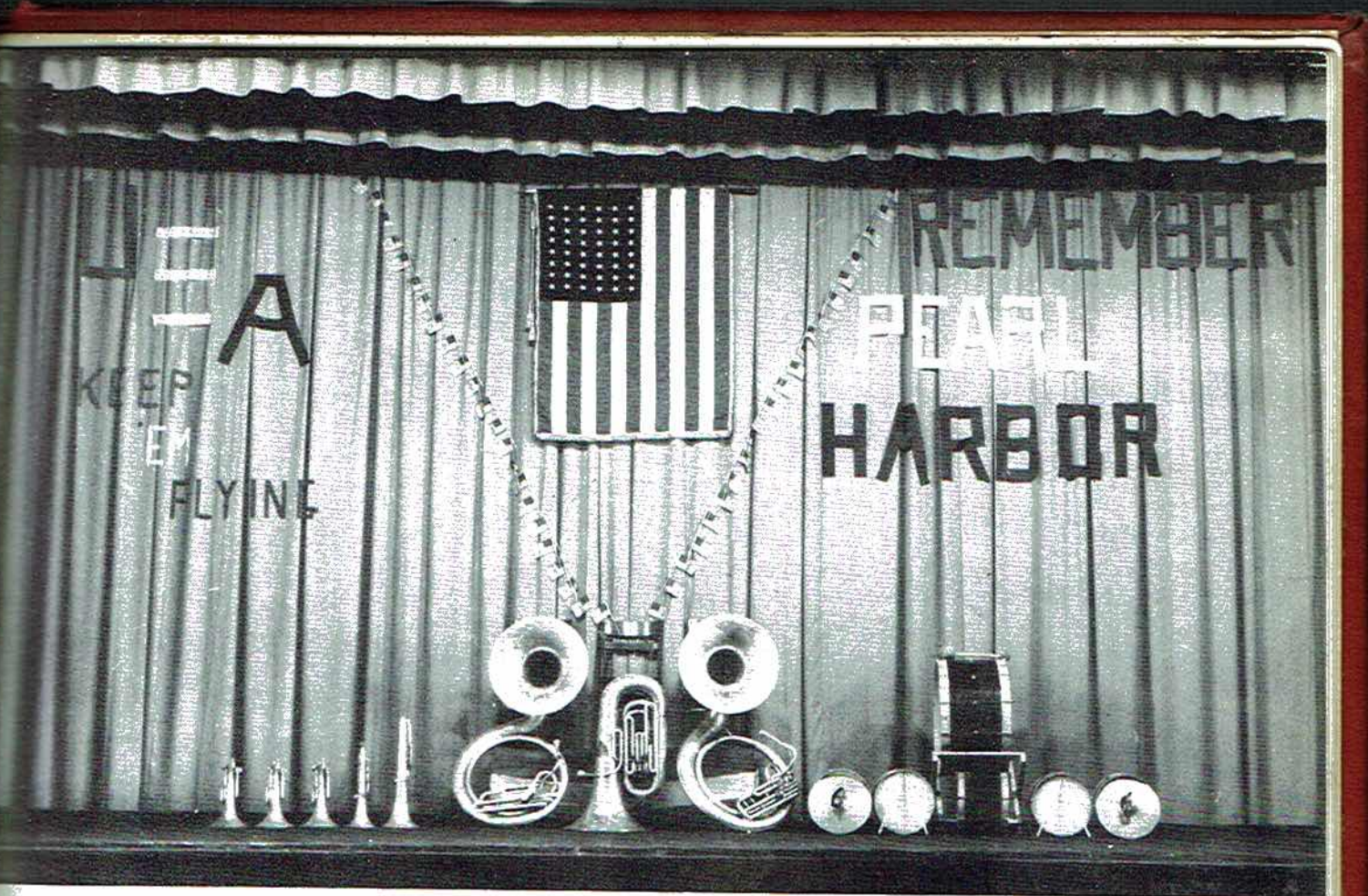

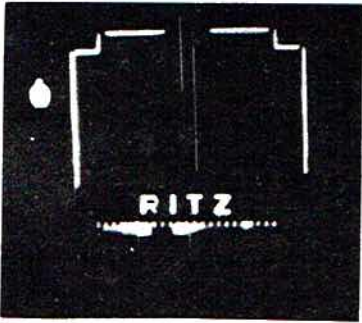
