The Wildcats won the game 48-0 under the coaching of Eugene Gant and Larry Crawford.

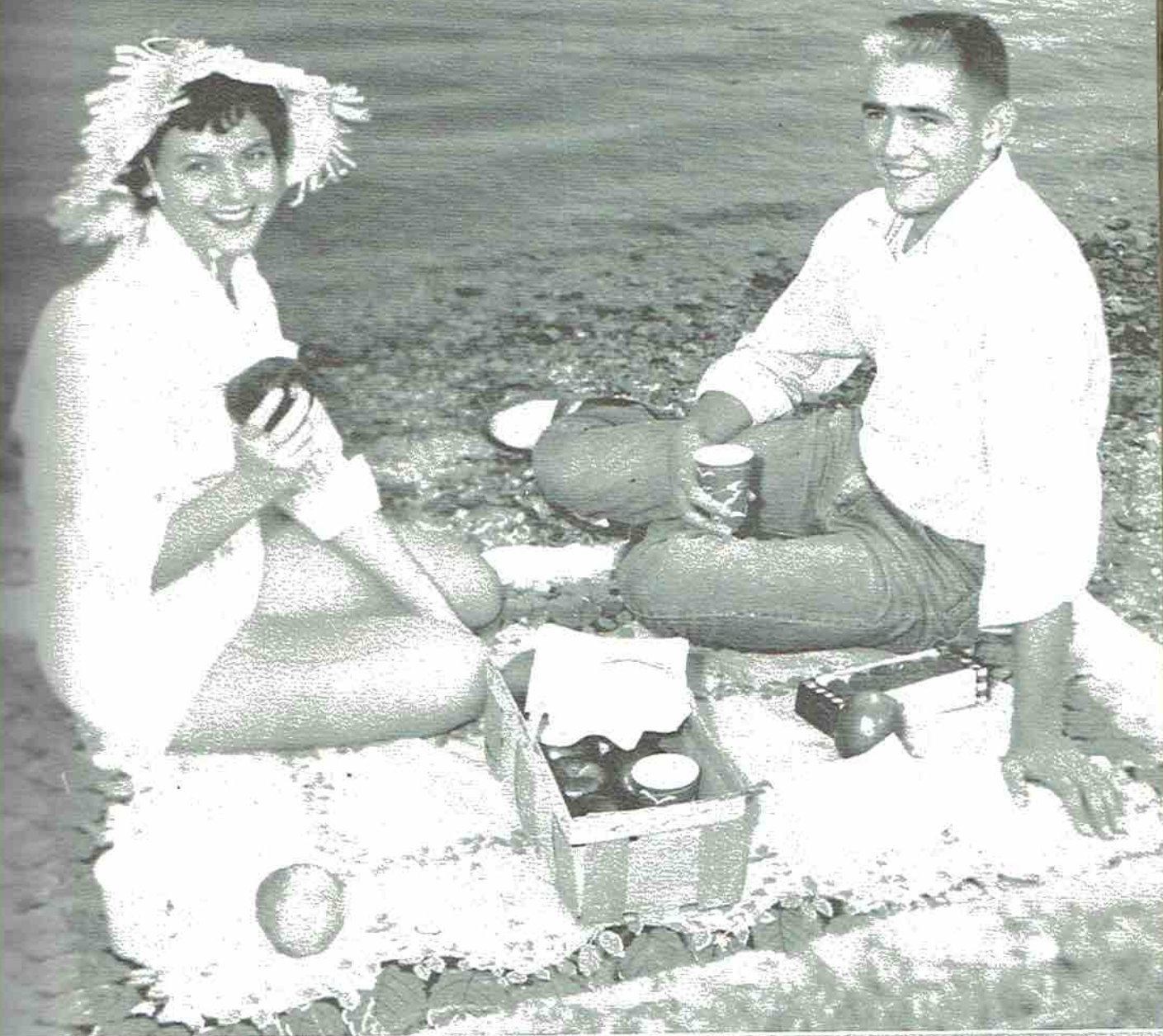
