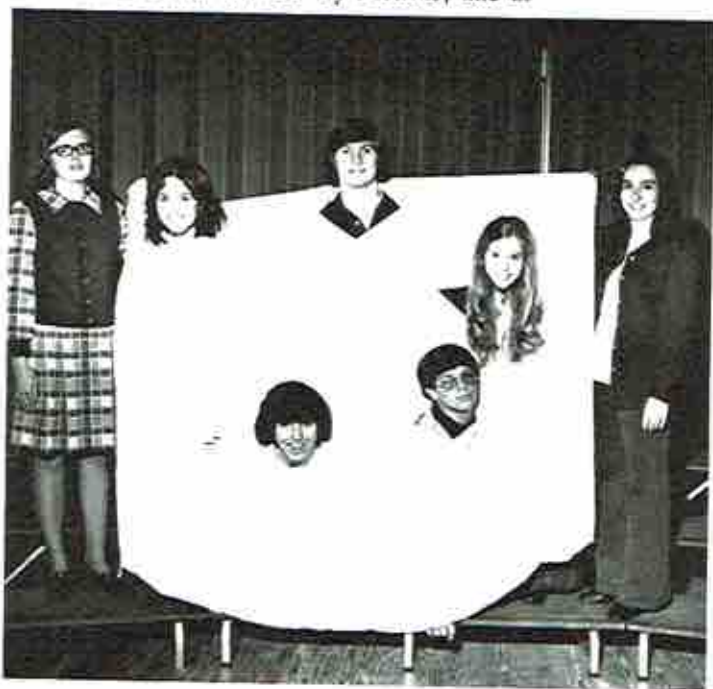


Drama Club
