## Drama Club

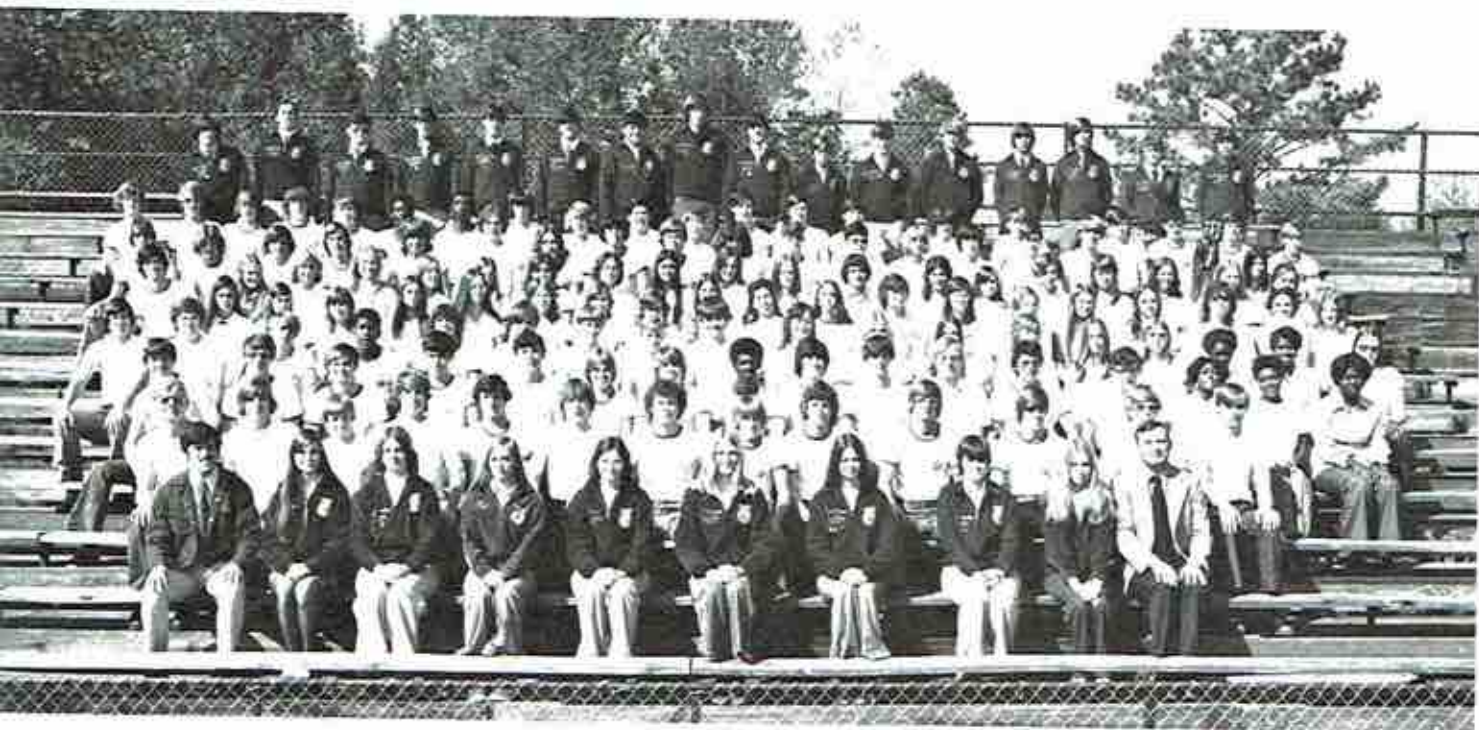
