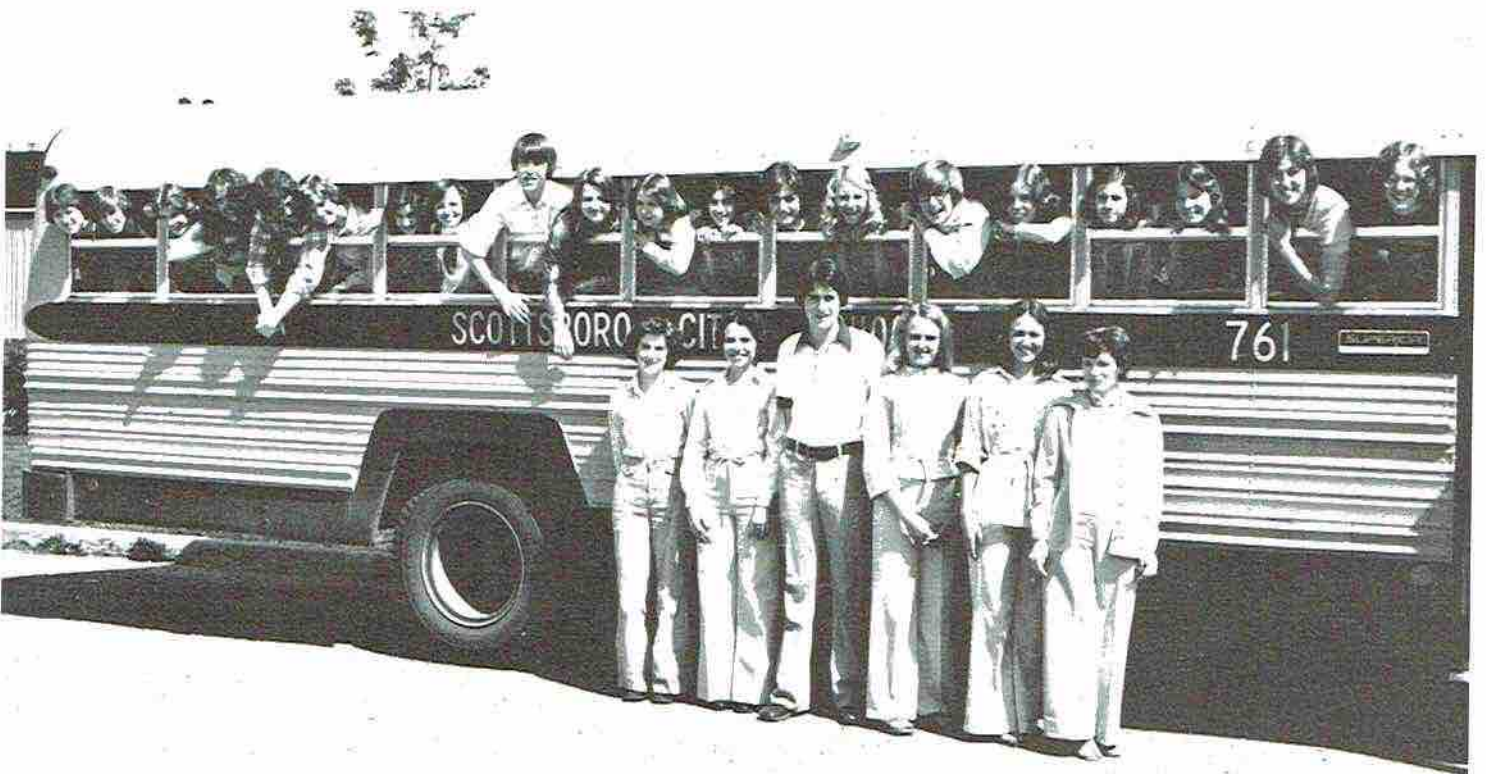


# Health Careers

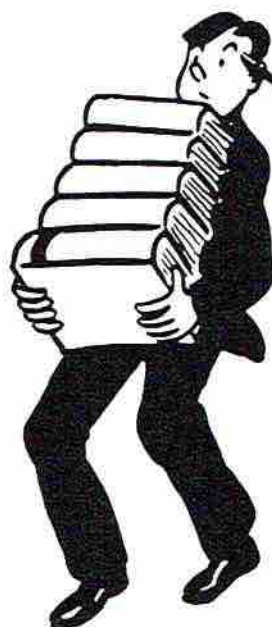

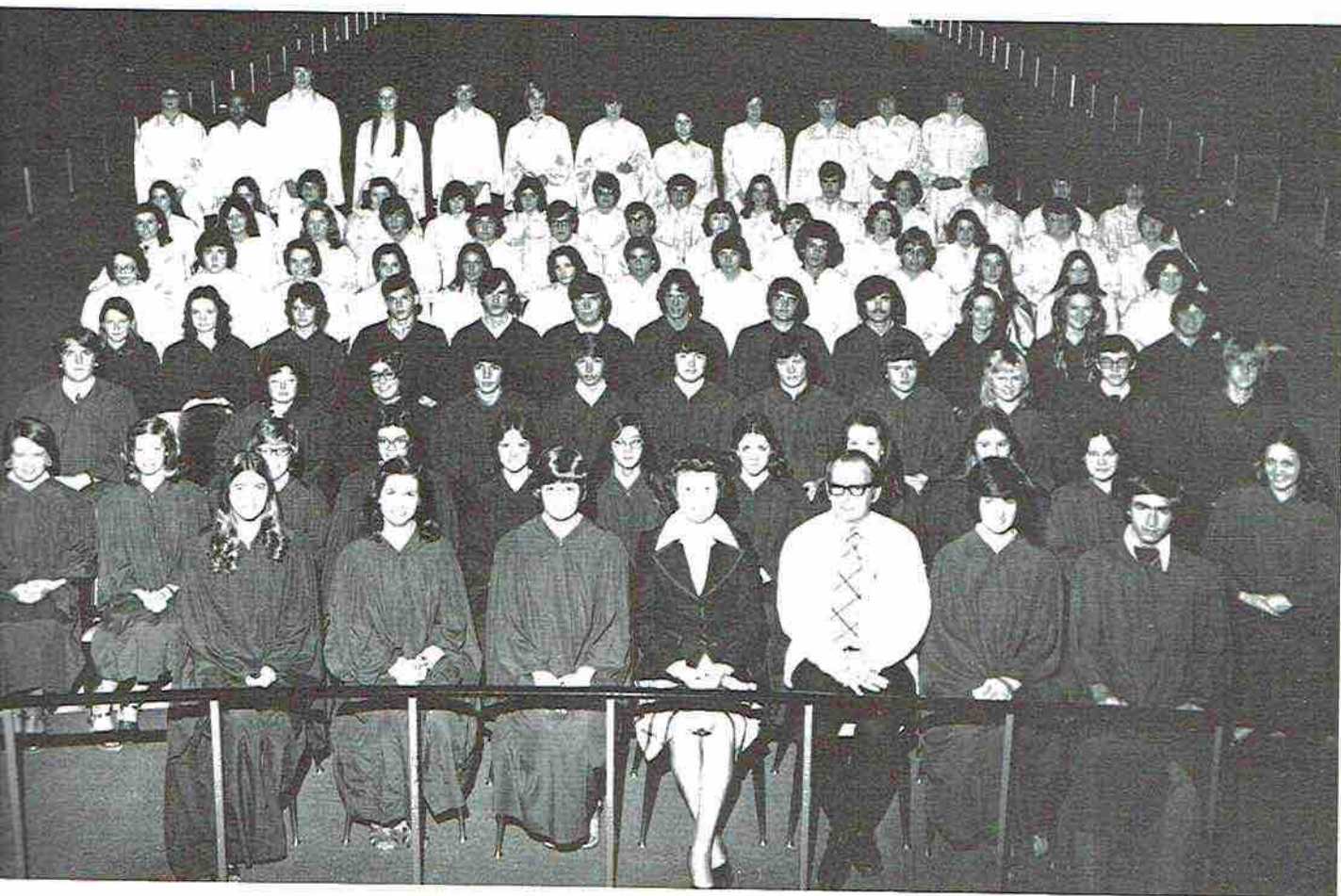


# National Honor Society

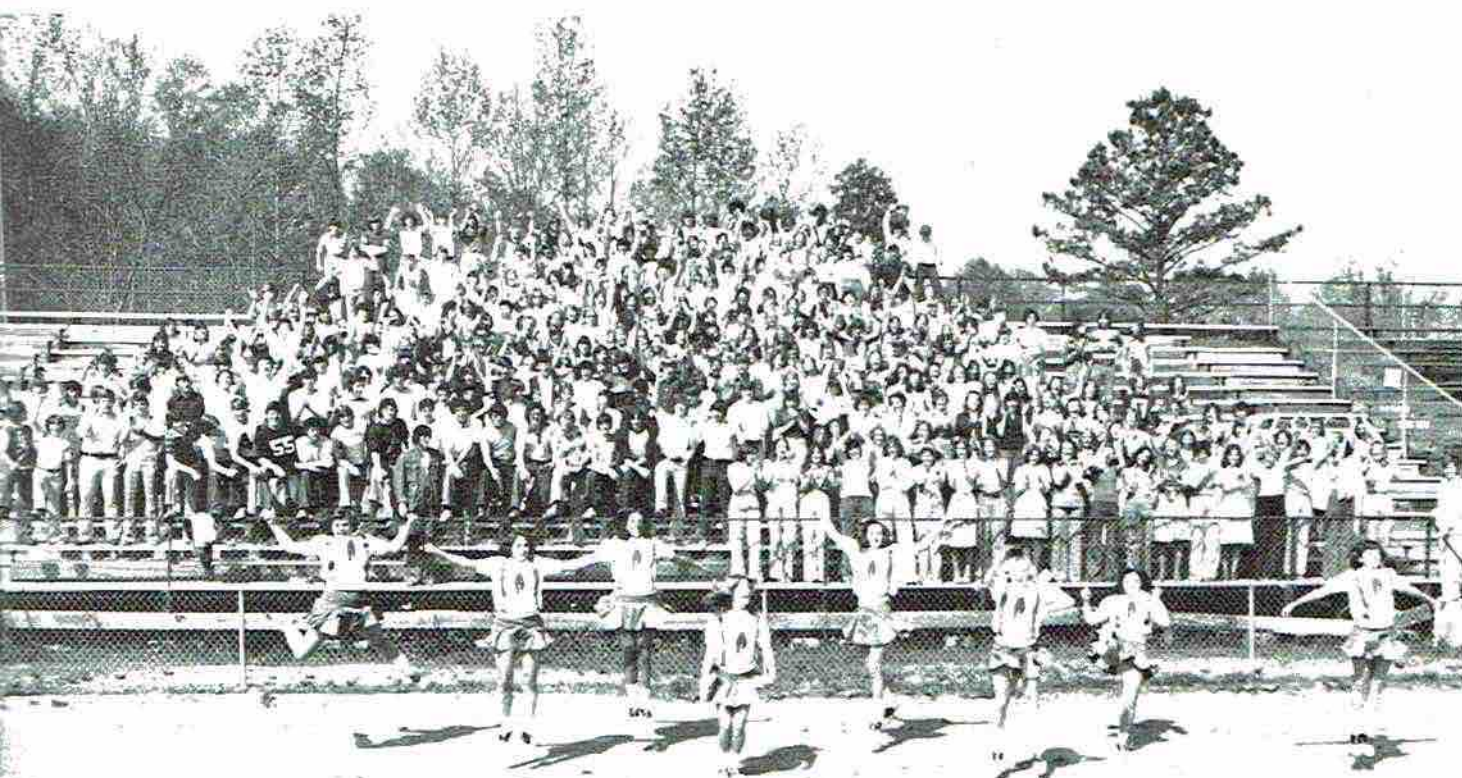


# Pep Club

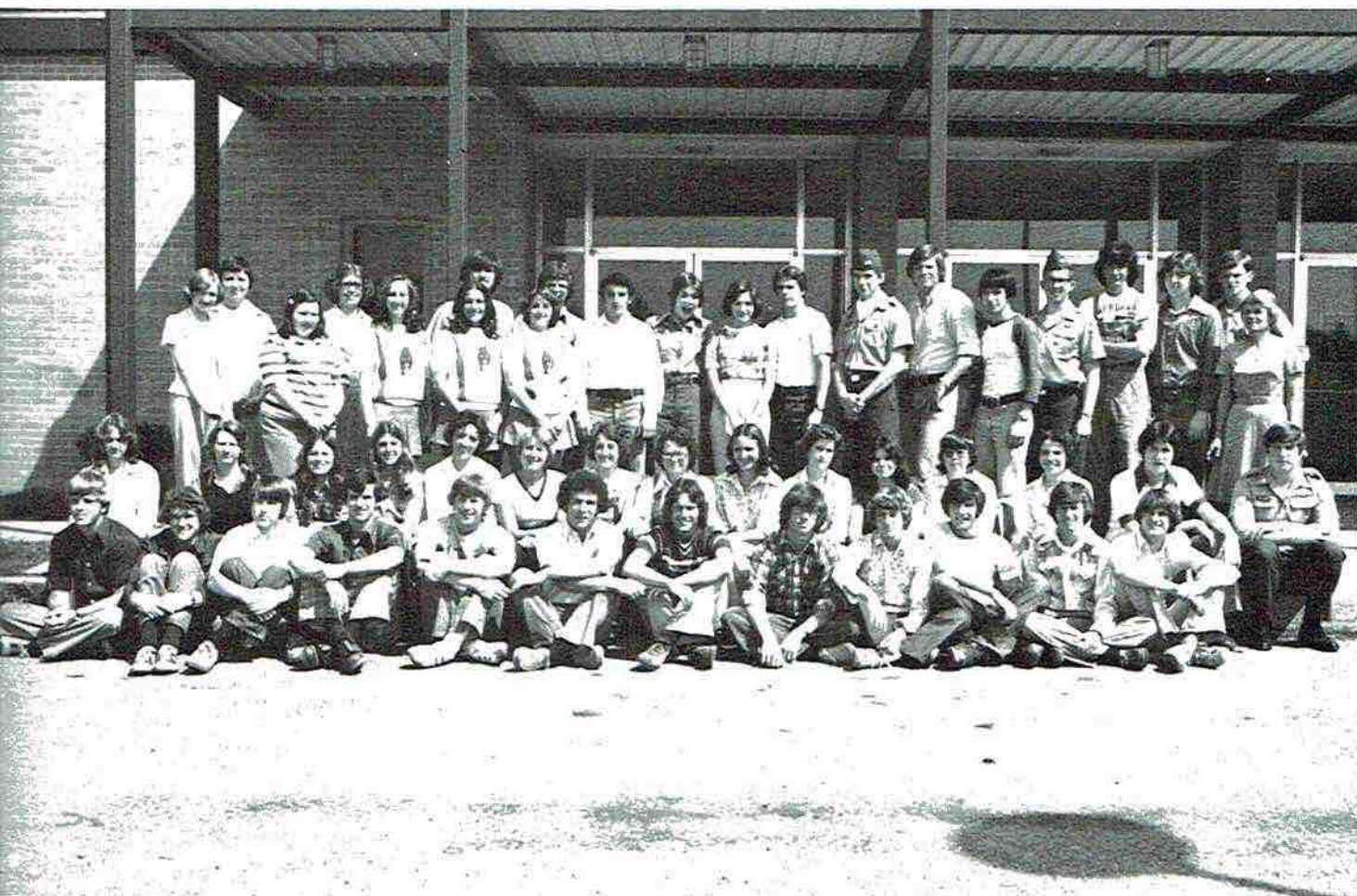


## Senior Science Club
