We can never express all of our respect for him, but we would like to try, by dedicating this page as a memoriam to Doyle Jackson Akin.

Coach Akin came to our school in 1959, teaching general science and biology, and serving as assistant football coach. He meant a great deal to our school. He was one of the hardest teachers at BHS--and one of the best. He had our respect--not because he demanded it, but because he earned it. He sponsored the Science Club, the Safety Patrol, the Junior Play and the Annual Staff. He worked the entire six years he taught at Bridgeport for an adequately equipped science laboratory. It is nearing completion now.

We will remember him for a great many reasons. We will remember all the parades, plays, banquets and fund raising projects that he was never too busy to help us with.

We will remember his brilliance. His classes were never dull, never boring. We could learn more by just listening to him than we could from any textbook, because he brought things down to our level.

We will remember his stinging wit. We had to laugh, even when his caustic comments were aimed at us. When they were at us, we didn't mind, because even as he laughed at others, he always laughed loudest at himself.

Most of all, we can never forget him because he was our friend. If we ever needed him for anything, he was there. He was on our side, no matter what trouble we might be in.

He is gone now, and BHS will never be the same without him. But while he is no longer with us, his memory always will be.

## Tribute to Miss Allie Mae Loyd

This day--Sunday, January 22, 1967--is the ninetieth birthday of the oldest member of the Bridgeport congregation. The late Mr. Maggie Ellis assisted her in similar work with the colored children. Miss Allie Mae is still active in the support of missionary work in this country and foreign fields. May she, with others, continue Christian work for many years to come.

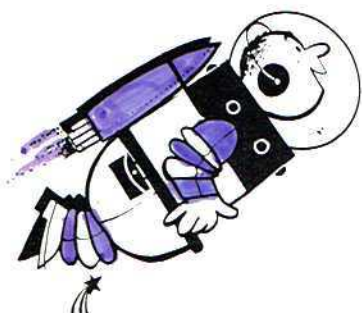

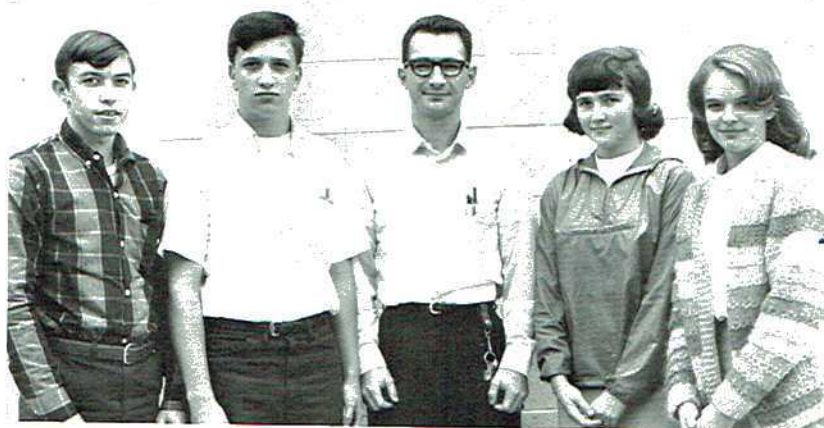
**NICKAJACK DAM**
