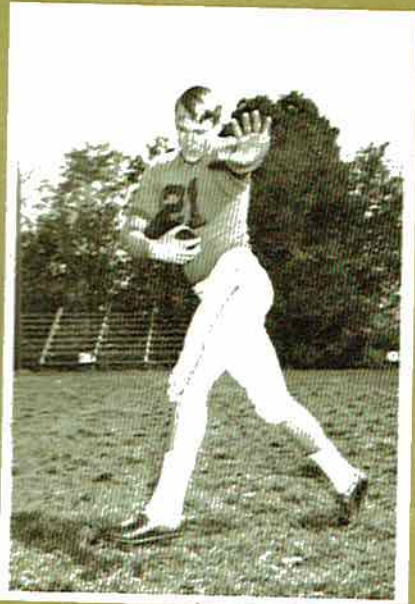

## *The Way Of The World*

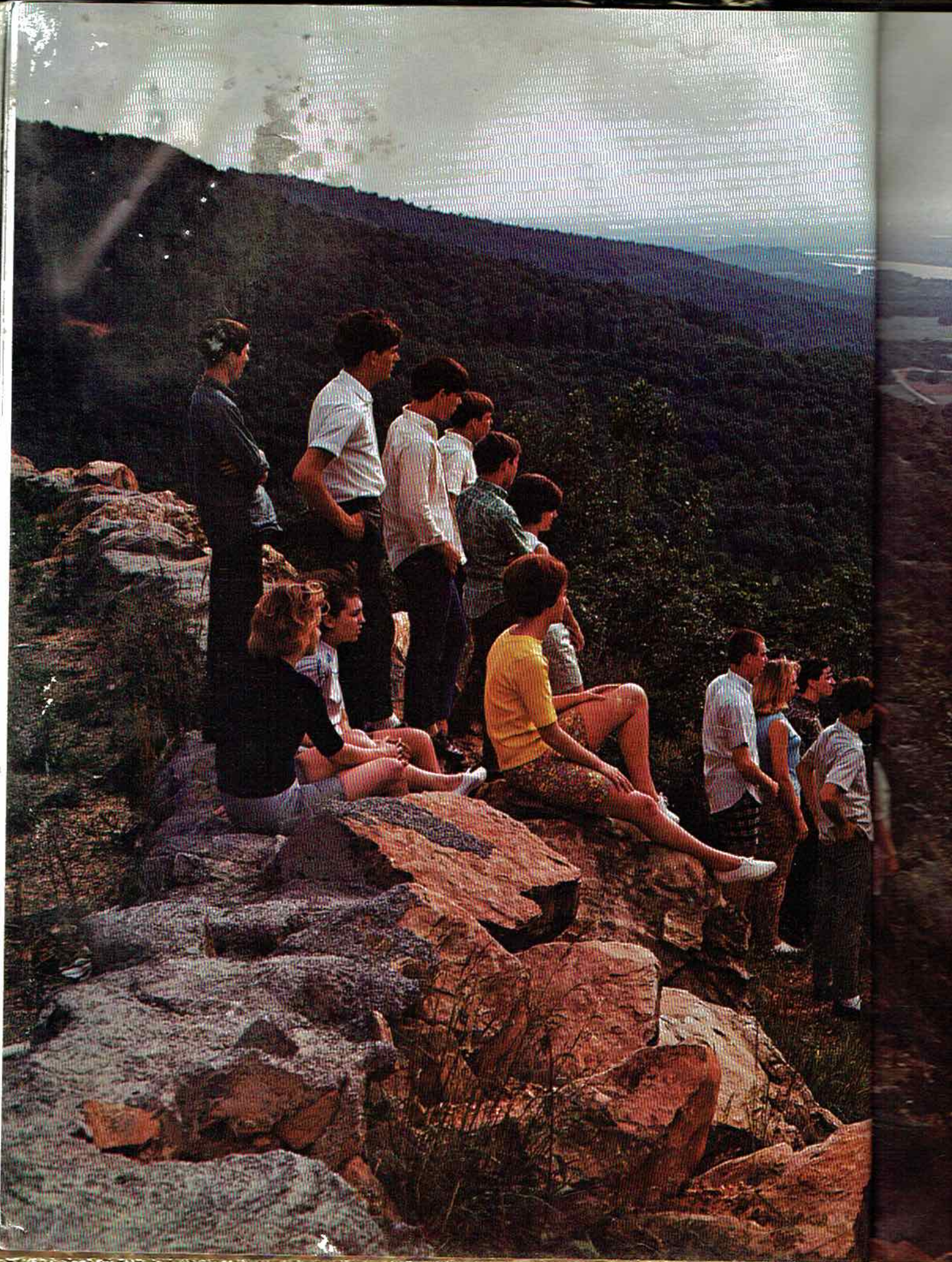
Laugh, and the world laughs with you,

And shrink from voicing care.

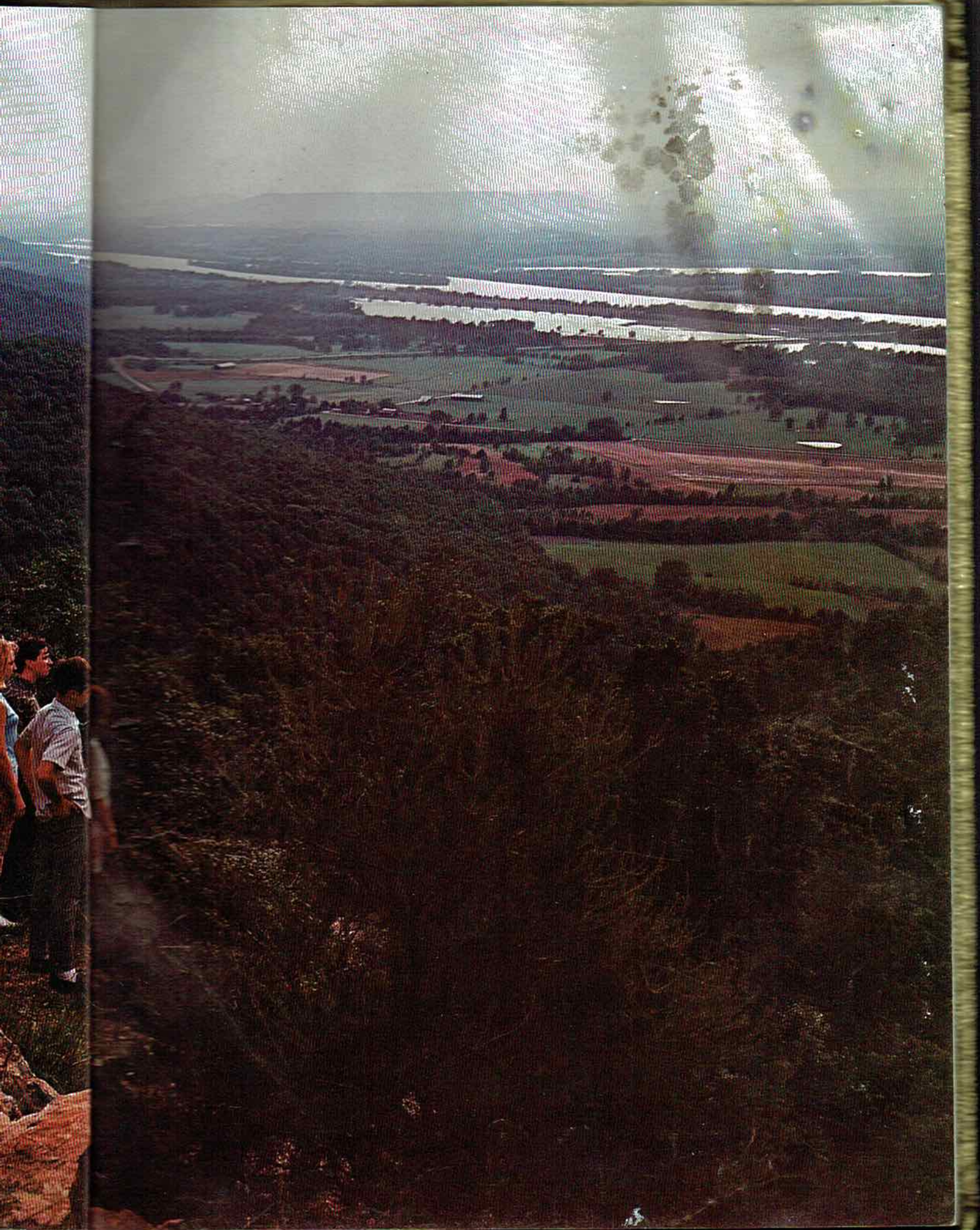
Rejoice, and men will seek you,
