### COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENTS

BRYANT COMMUNITY IS MAKING SOME BIG IMPROVEMENTS. WE ARE GOING TO GET A PAVED ROAD FROM FLAT ROCK, ALA. TO SHELLMOND AND CONNECT ONTO HIGH WAY FORTY ONE, GOING INTO CHATTANOOGA, TENN. WE WILL HAVE A BETTER AND QUICKER WAY TO GET OUR PRODUCE TO MARKET. THIS WILL BE A DIRECT ROUTE FROM BIRMINGHAM ACROSS SAND MOUNTAIN INTO CHATTANOOGA. THERE WILL ALSO BE A BUS ROUTE. WE HAVE CERTAINLY WORKED HARD TO GET THIS ROAD THROUGH OUR COMMUNITY, AND IT WILL BE A BIG IMPROVEMENT. WE HAD THE GOVERNOR OUT HERE AT OUR SCHOOL THE FIRST MONDAY IN AUGUST. WE ARE EXPECTING MORE PEOPLE TO MOVE TO THE MOUNTAIN WHEN WE GET OUR ROAD. AND THAT TOO WILL HELP US ABOUT GETTING A SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL AT BRYANT. THE SUPT. OF EDUCATION HAS ALSO PROMISED US A SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL AND A NEW LUNCH ROOM. A SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL ON THIS SIDE OF THE RIVER WOULD CERTAINLY BE A BIG IMPROVEMENT. WE WOULDN'T HAVE TO CROSS THE RIVER TO GET TO HIGH SCHOOL.

WE ARE ALSO GETTING ELECTRICITY IN THIS COMMUNITY, THEY ARE BUILDING ABOUT FIVE HUNDRED MILES OF LINE TO SERVE THE RURAL DISTRICTS NEAR US. THE IRBY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY IS BUILDING THE LINE AND ARE ABOUT ONE FOURTH THROUGH WITH IT.

WE HAVE ALSO A WOMANS HOME DEMONSTRATION CLUB, WHICH MEETS THE FIRST MONDAY IN EVERY MONTH. IT IS ALSO DOING A GOOD JOB IN HELPING IMPROVE THE COMMUNITY. WITH ALL THESE IMPROVEMENTS COMING BRYANT OUGHT TO BE A BIGGER AND BETTER PLACE TO LIVE.
