Jimmy Holman leaves his model airplanes to Jerry Mulkey.

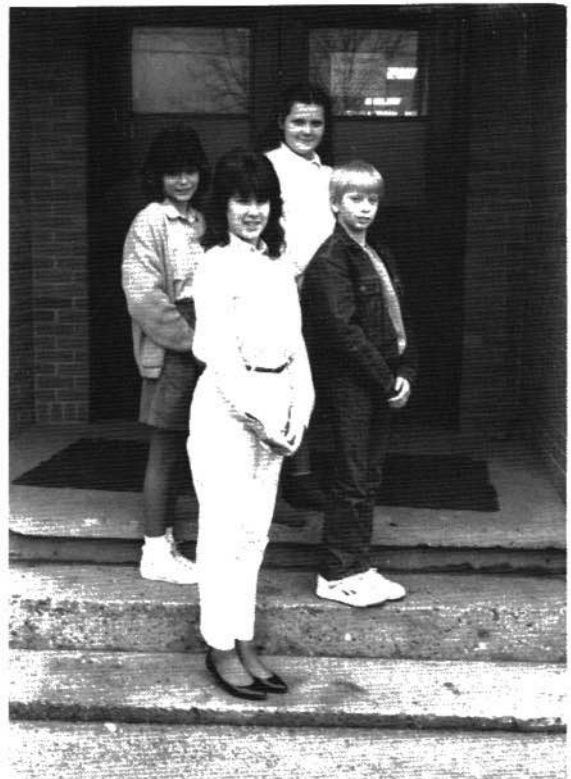
