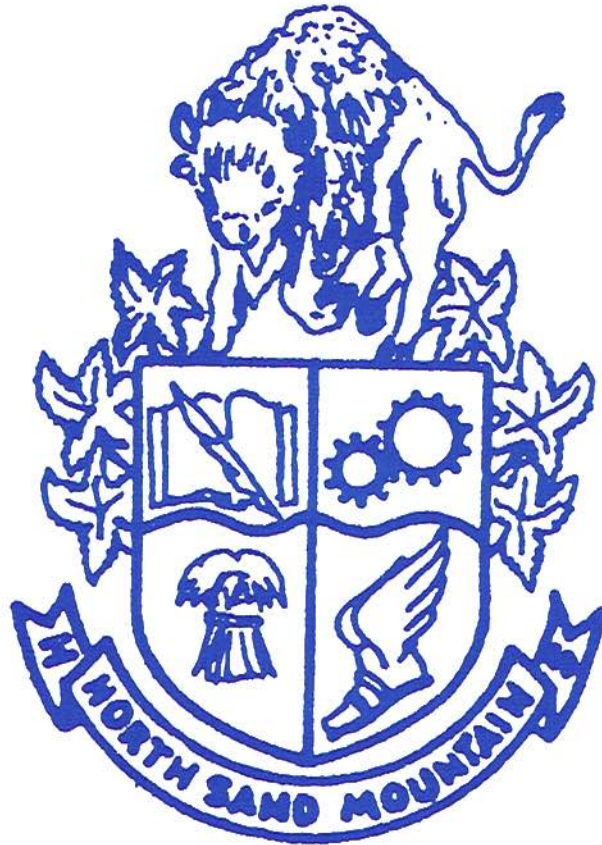


Dedication
