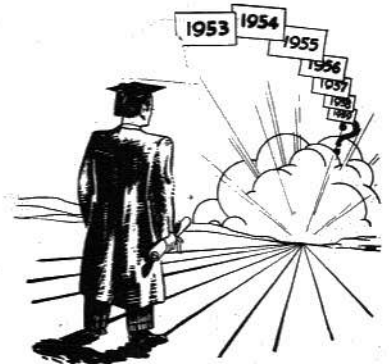

Verbon Hill is an Electrical Engineer.

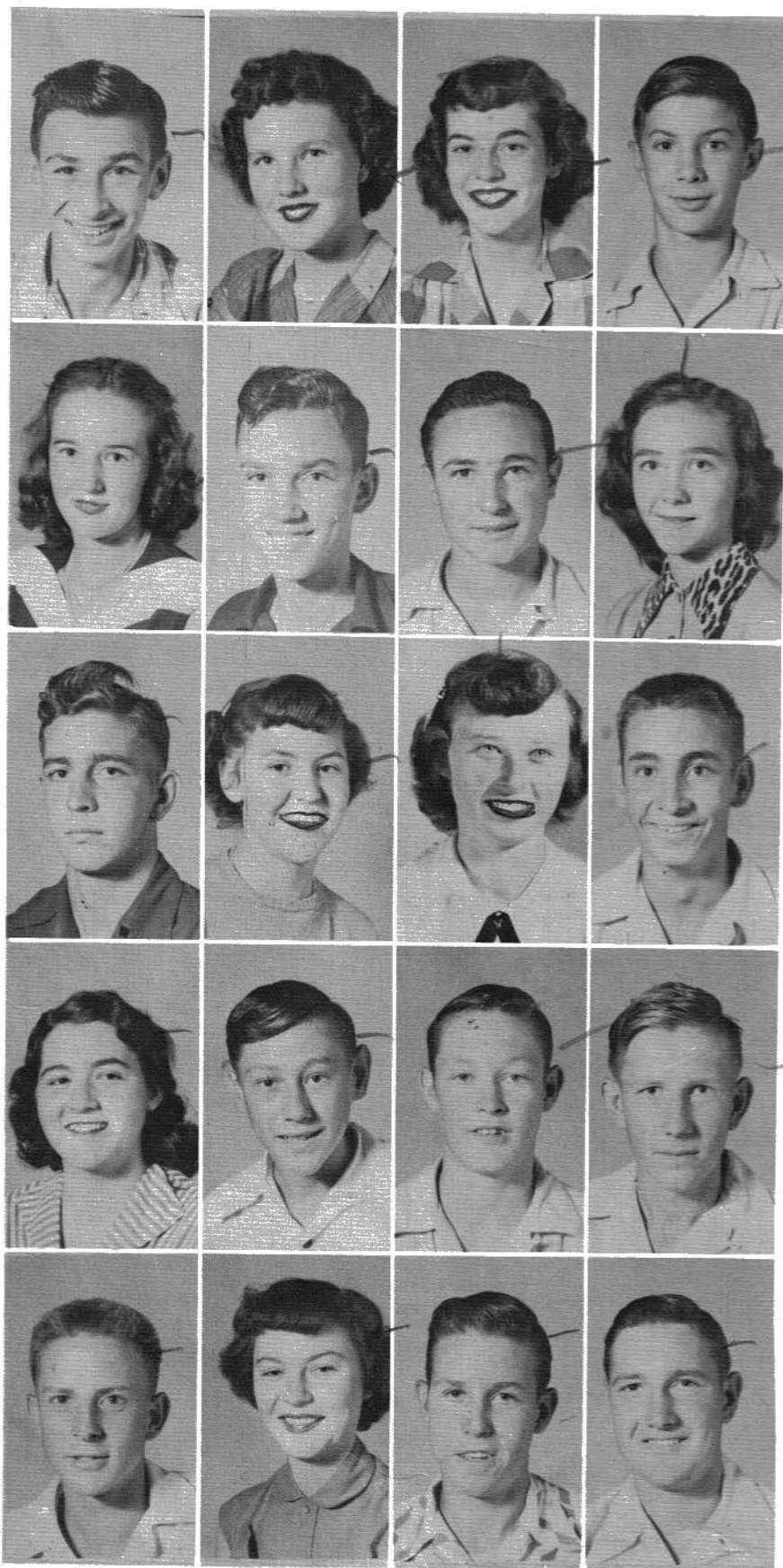
