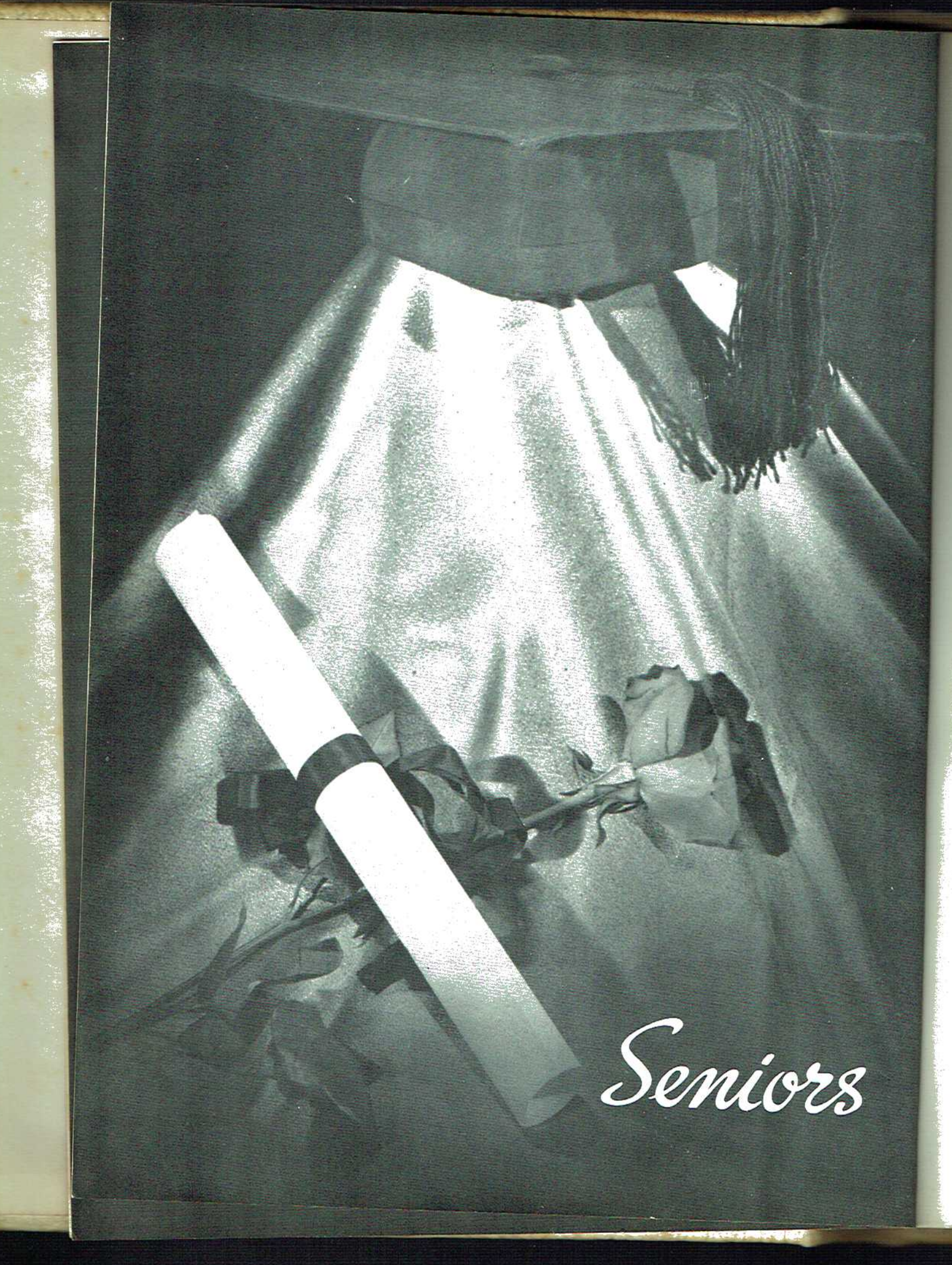

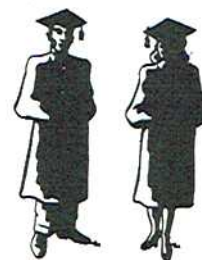

We have left behind us many friends and most helpful teachers, but we can face the future with a pleasing smile and pleasant memories.
