Virginia Farmer, Wilma Vann, and Mavis Townson are now champion golfers around these parts.

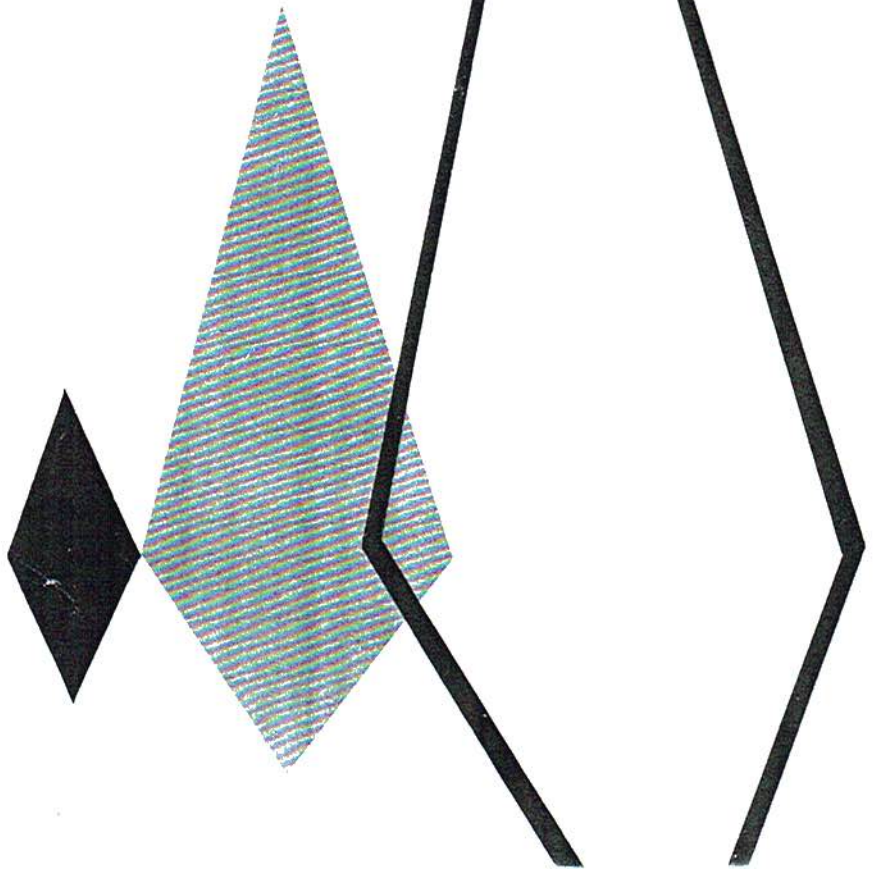
