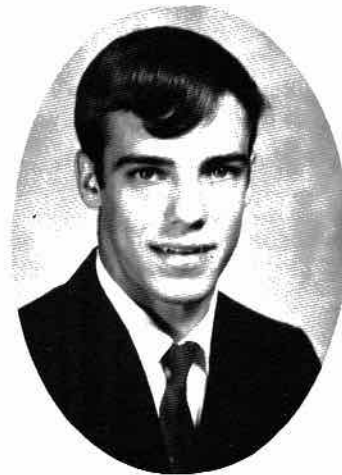


F.F.A. Sweetheart
