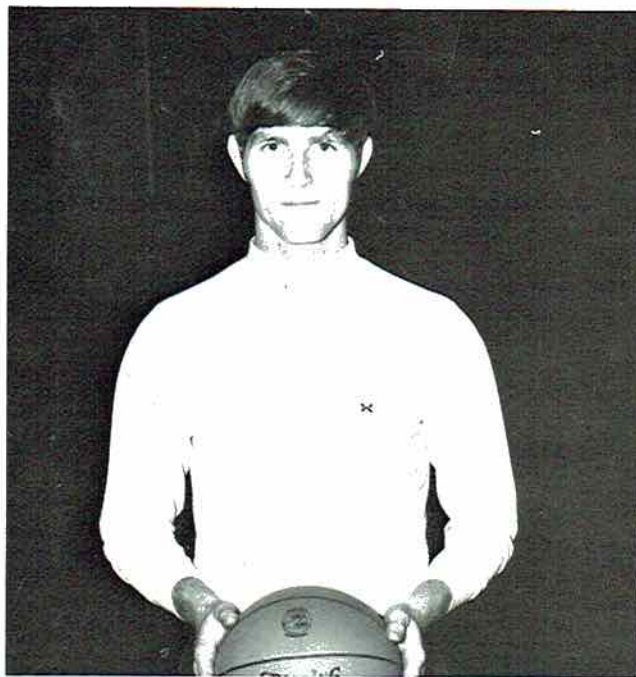
MR. BRUCE PICKETT

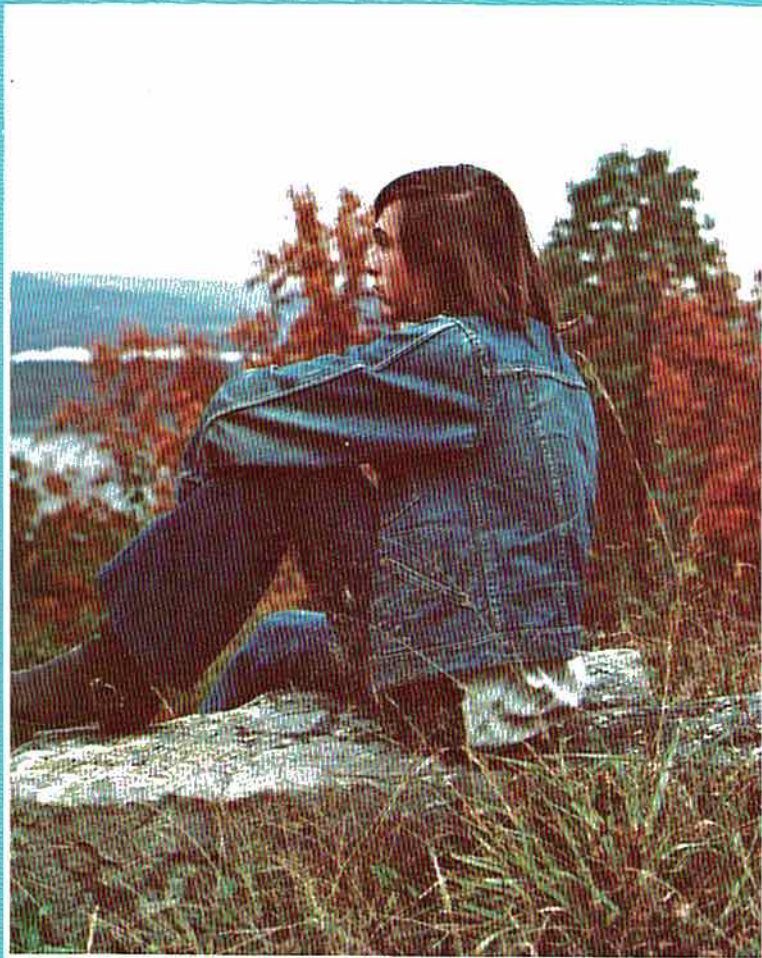
Coach Bruce Pickett is a graduate of Jacksonville State University and has been at Section High for three years.
