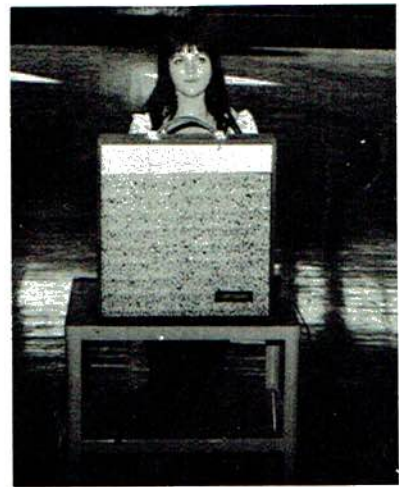

is yours: to reign, to listen, to accomplish, to lead.

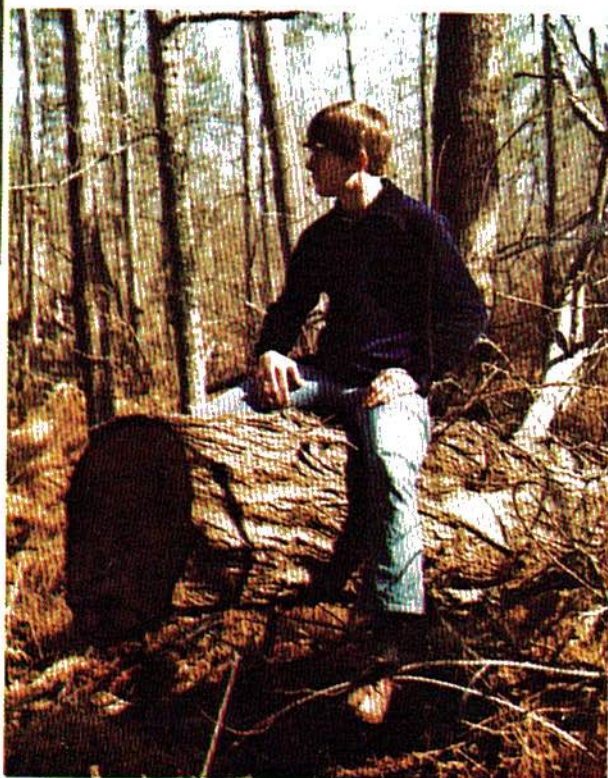

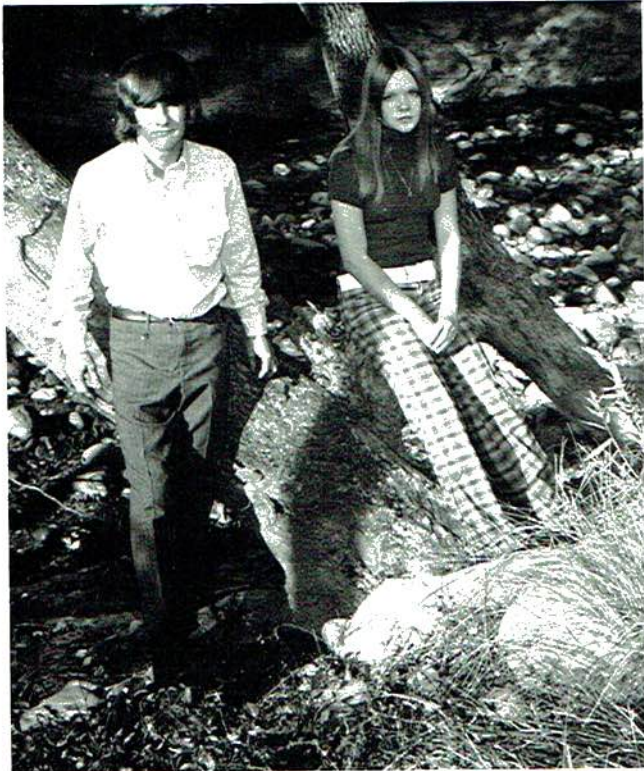
In September 1973, the Jackson County Technical School opened and many of SHS's students attended.

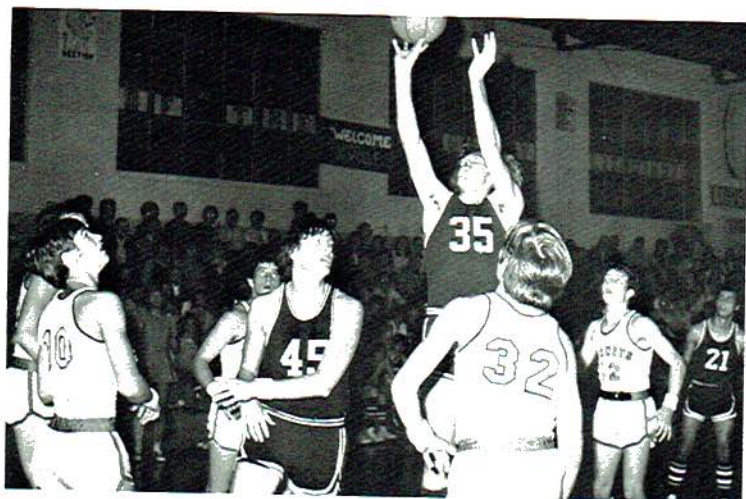

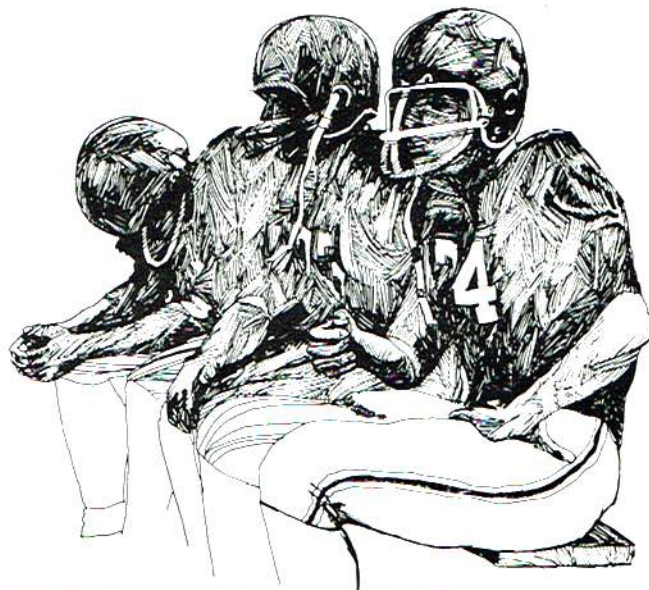
