I, Jeff Sparks, leave all my left-over brownie points that I don't need to graduate to James Thornberry.

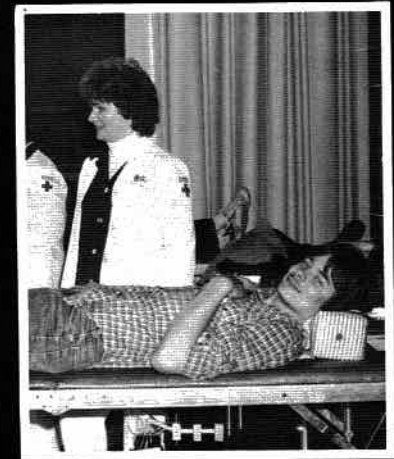
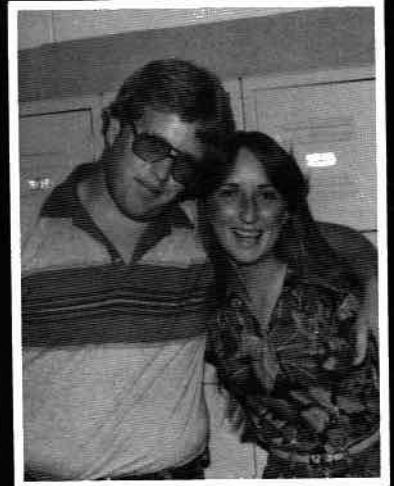
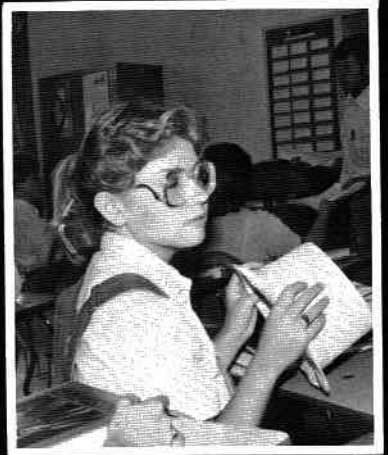

Darlene Bramblett moved to Kentucky where she trains thoroughbreds for the Kentucky Derby.


Cathy Evans works along side Darlene as a Vet for the horses.
