So you can see that the Class of 1984 made a BIG impression on the world.







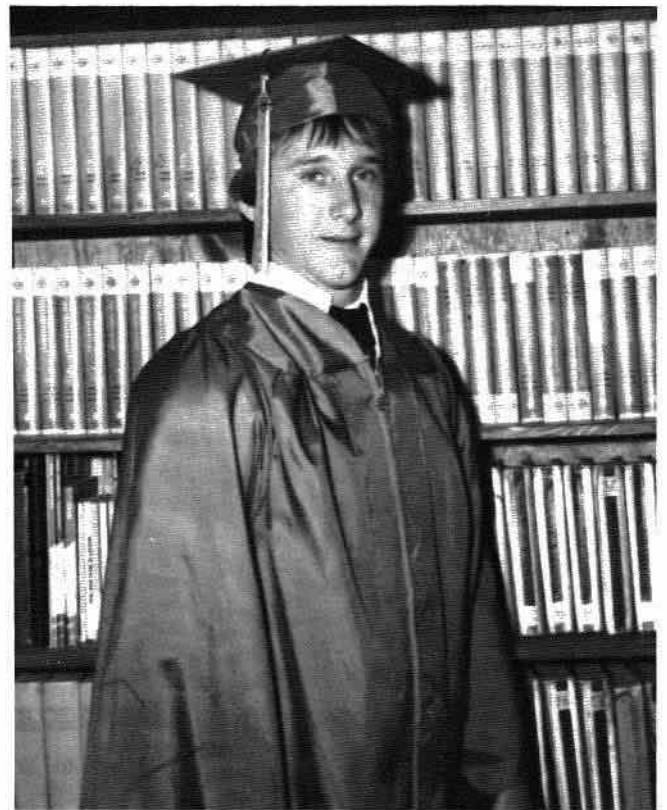
