CAROL SWADER went professional; she is now a lady wrestler; her trainer TERESA WILKS says "We expect Carol to win the gold medal in the Olympics this year."


TINA MYERS owns her own heating company. She can now keep her office as warm as she wants it. She owes her inspiration to her 3rd period English class.

So you can see that the Class of 1984 made a BIG impression on the world.


















