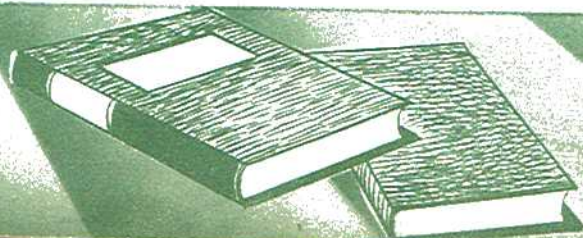


## HISTORY OF SKYLINE SCHOOL


SKYLINE SCHOOL OPENED ITS DOORS FOR INSTRUCTION SEPTEMBER 1935, WITH AN ENROLLMENT OF 285. ONE HUNDRED OF THESE WERE IN THE FIRST GRADE. THE AGES OF THESE FIRST-GRADERS RANGED FROM SIX TO EIGHTEEN WITH MORE THAN FIFTY OVER THE AGE OF TWELVE. THE REASON FOR THE WIDE RANGE OF AGES WAS THAT THERE HAD BEEN NO SCHOOL AVAILABLE FOR THESE CHILDREN. A SCHOOL WHICH HAD BEEN AT ALTO CLOSED ITS DOORS IN THE MID-TWENTIES, LEAVING THE COMMUNITY WITHOUT A SCHOOL FOR SEVERAL YEARS; AND BESIDES, SEVERAL FAMILIES HAD MOVED IN FROM COMMUNITIES THAT HAD NO SCHOOLS. THESE FIRST-GRADERS WERE DIVIDED INTO AGE GROUPS.

THE GROWTH OF SKYLINE SCHOOL HAS BEEN CONTINUOUS AND STEADY, AND THIS IS THE RESULT OF THE UNITY AND CONSCIENTIOUS EFFORT OF THOSE WHO HAVE LIVED AND THOSE WHO NOW LIVE IN THE COMMUNITY. THE NOW PROSPEROUS COMMUNITY HAD BEEN HEWED OUT OF THE WILDERNESS IN PIONEER FASHION BY RUGGED RESOURCEFUL INDIVIDUALS WHO NOW BEGAN TO BE AWARE OF THE NEED OF EDUCATION IF THEY WERE TO ACHIEVE THEIR CHERISHED AMBITION OF FULLEST DEVELOPMENT.

THE CITIZENS WERE NOT TOO MUCH DISCOURAGED BY THE FACT THAT THE SCHOOL HAD NOT SUCH ORDINARY NECESSITIES AS DESKS, CHAIRS AND TABLES. THERE WERE PLENTY OF TREES AT HAND AND THEY MADE THEIR OWN EQUIPMENT BY SAWING LOGS IN SECTIONS AND NAILING BOARDS ON THEM. THEN, THEY DID NOT STOP BECAUSE THEY HAD SOMETHING WITH WHICH THEY COULD MAKE OUT. THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT HAD MADE AN APPROPRIATION FOR A BUILDING, AND SOME MONEY WAS RAISED FROM OTHER SOURCES. WHEN IT WAS PLAIN THAT THE MONEY IN SIGHT WOULD NOT MEET ALL NEEDS, THE MEN OF THE COMMUNITY LAY TO AND CONTRIBUTED THEIR OWN LABOR TO THE TASK. THEY WOULD DO THEIR OWN WORK IN FIVE DAYS AND GIVE SATURDAY TO THE SCHOOL. THE WOMEN MADE THEIR CONTRIBUTION BY PREPARING AND BRINGING LUNCHEONS TO THE MEN AT WORK. IN THIS WAY, EVERYONE DOING HIS PART, THE BUILDING WAS SOON BROUGHT TO COMPLETION, LEAV-







ING A RECORD OF WHICH EVERYONE IS STILL JUSTLY PROUD. IN THE SAME WAY THE PROGRESS OF THE SCHOOL HAS CONTINUED UNTIL NOW.

THE SCHOOL TAKES PRIDE IN PRESENTING HERewith A QUOTATION FROM A LETTER WRITTEN BY MR. M. C. COUCH, PRINCIPAL OF JACKSON COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL, TO MR. C. L. FOSSETT, PRINCIPAL OF SKYLINE SCHOOL:

"SCOTTSBORO, ALABAMA, APRIL 30, 1949

"DEAR MR. FOSSETT:

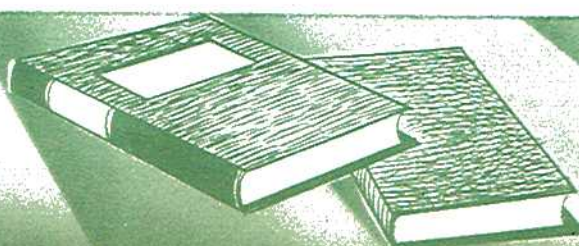

BOULDIN, SECOND GRADE; MISS BONNIE KENNEMORE, THIRD GRADE; MRS. LURA DUKE, FOURTH GRADE; MRS. GUSSIE SPEARS, FIFTH GRADE; MRS. ETHELENE BLACK WOODALL, SIXTH GRADE; MR. JAMES H. HAWKINS, SEVENTH GRADE AND COACH; MR. C. EDWIN SPENCER, EIGHTH GRADE; MR. G. W. BOULDIN, NINTH GRADE; ALL ABLY DIRECTED AND ASSISTED BY OUR VERY COOPERATIVE PRINCIPAL, MR. C. L. FOSSETT.

SKYLINE HAS AN EXCELLENT LUNCHROOM IN WHICH A LARGE MAJORITY OF THE STUDENTS AND ALL THE TEACHERS TAKE THEIR NOON MEAL. MR. FOSSETT IS ABLY ASSISTED IN THE LUNCHROOM BY MRS. SAM POTTER AND MISS LUCILE HOLT. MR. MCGAHEE SMITH IS DOING A GOOD JOB AS JANITOR. THE SCHOOL BUSES ARE DRIVEN BY MR. RALPH HILLIARD AND MR. S. B. MANNING WHO DO AN UNUSUALLY GOOD JOB OF GETTING THE CHILDREN TO SCHOOL SAFELY AND ON TIME.






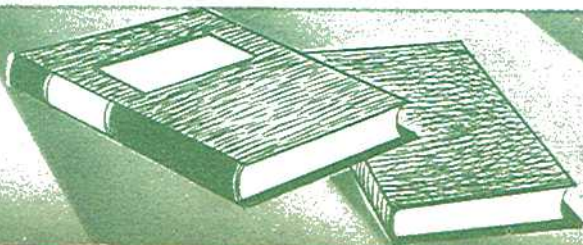

WHAT OF THE FUTURE? THE RECORDS OF THE PAST GIVE HOPE AND COURAGE FOR THE FUTURE. BUT NEW DISCOVERIES HELP ALSO. IT HAS BEEN FOUND OUT THAT THERE IS MANY AN ACRE OF LAND ON CUMBERLAND PLATEAU, ALMOST THE TYPICAL ACRE, WHICH CAN BE MADE TO PRODUCE 100 BUSHELS OF CORN. IT WILL PRODUCE BLUE GRASS AND ALFALFA. BOYS AND GIRLS HAVE BEEN FOUND HERE WHO CAN LEAD CLASSES IN SCOTTSBORO. LIME GETS RESULTS IN THE SOIL AND GRIT WILL TURN THE TRICK IN THE YOUNG FOLKS.

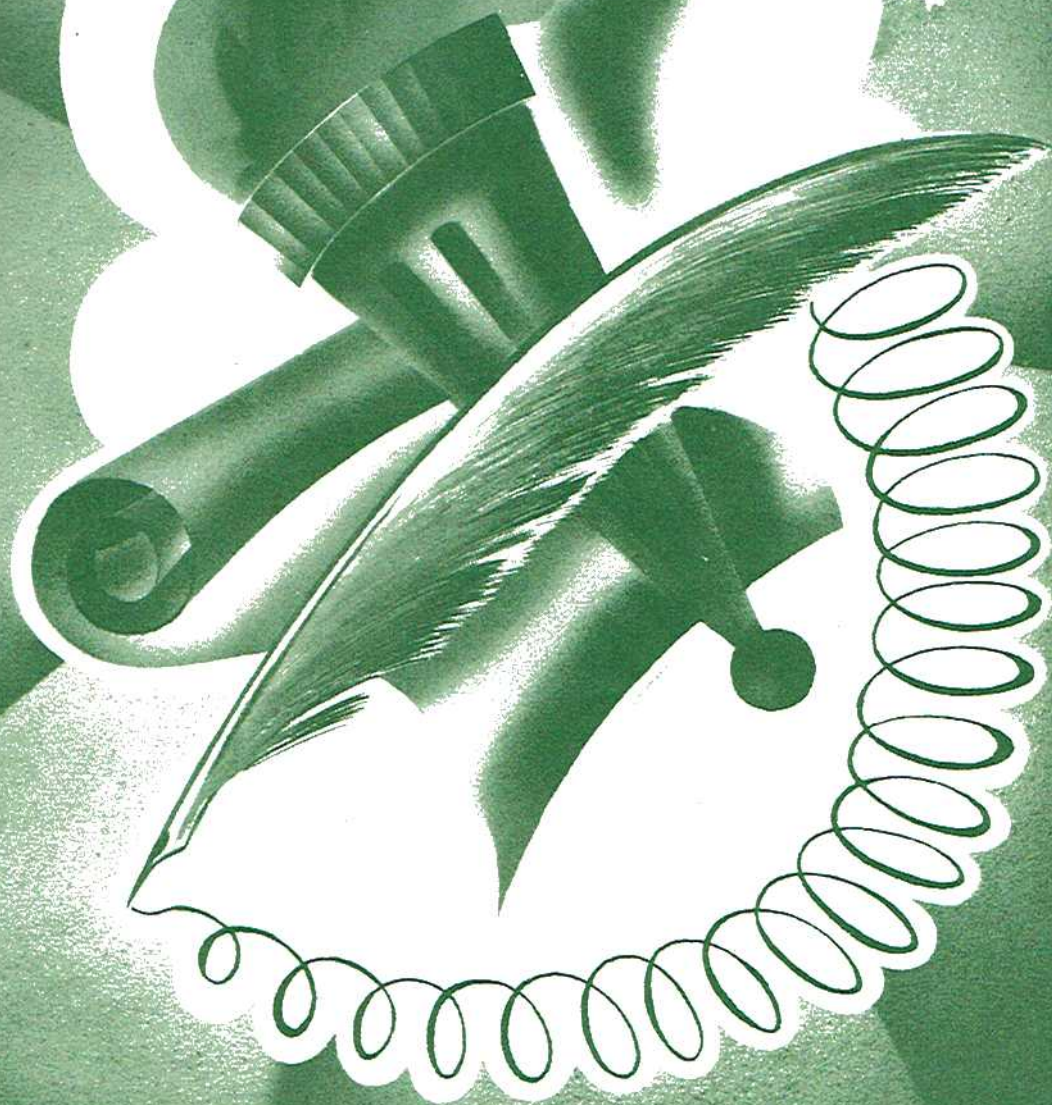
