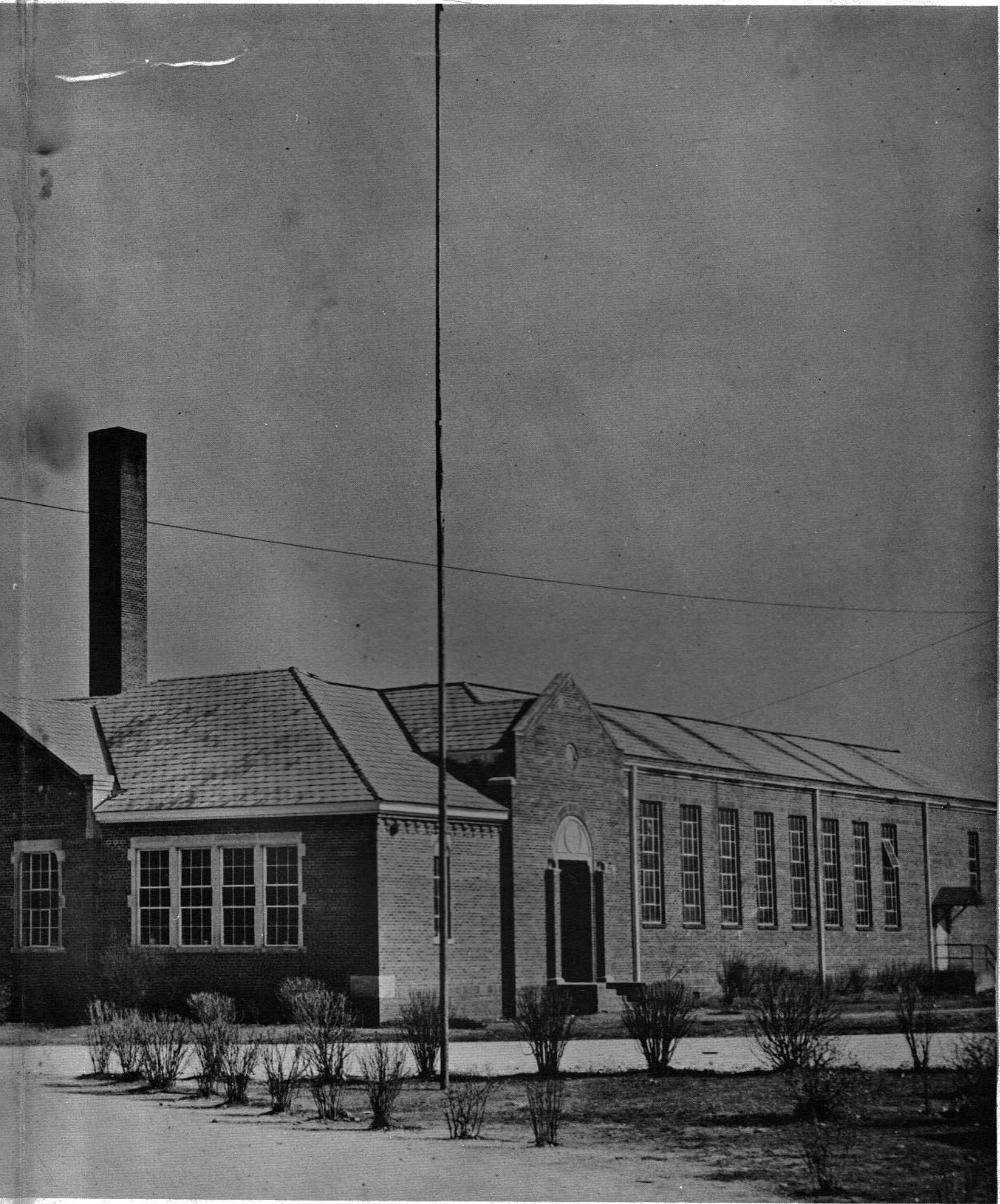

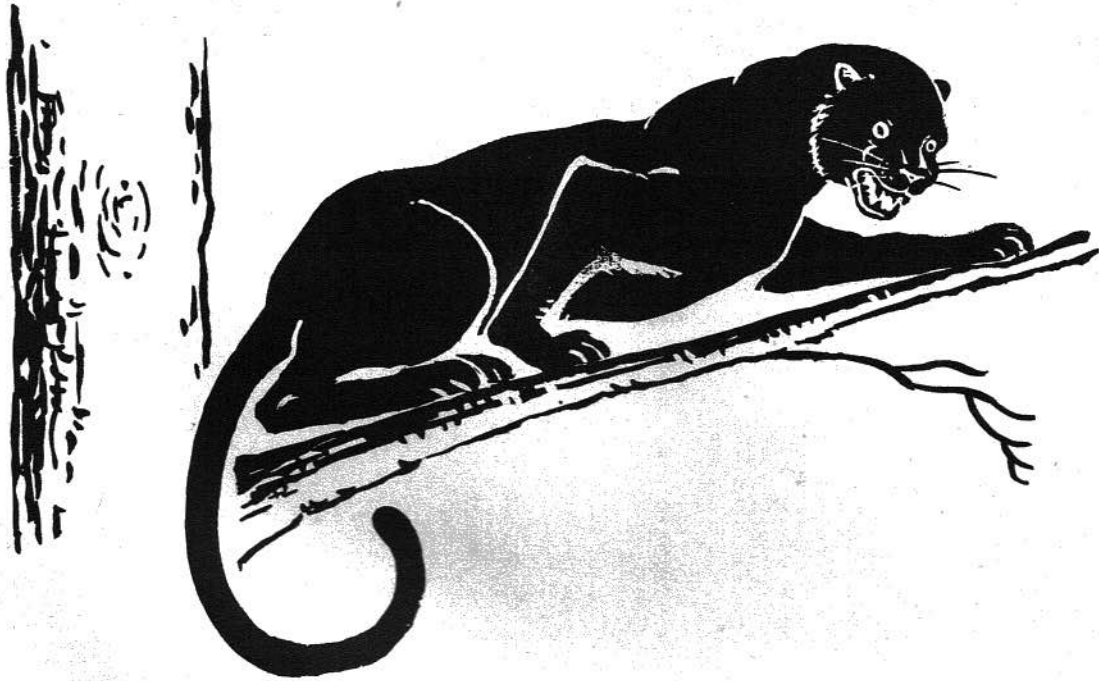

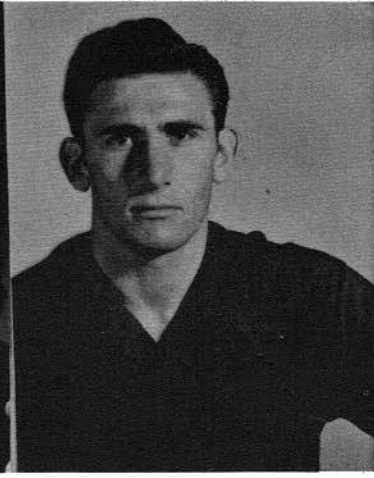

CONCERNING OUR PRINCIPAL--

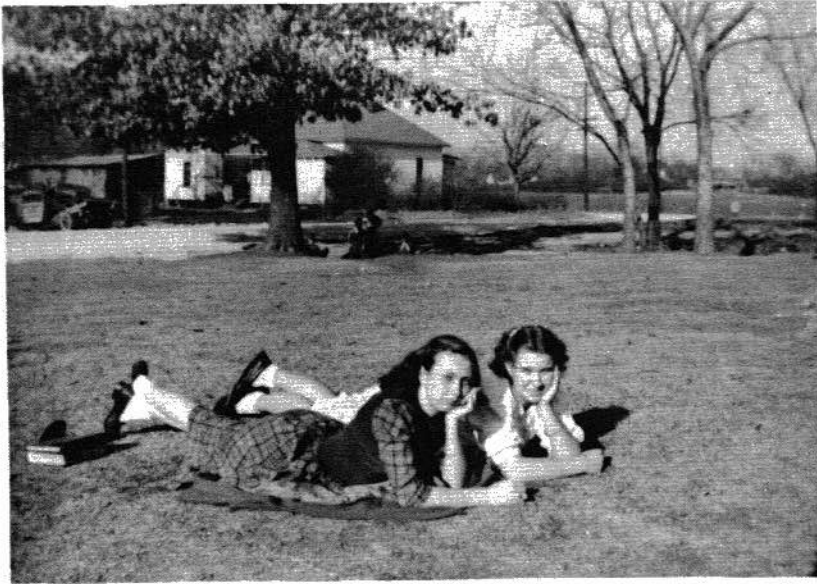

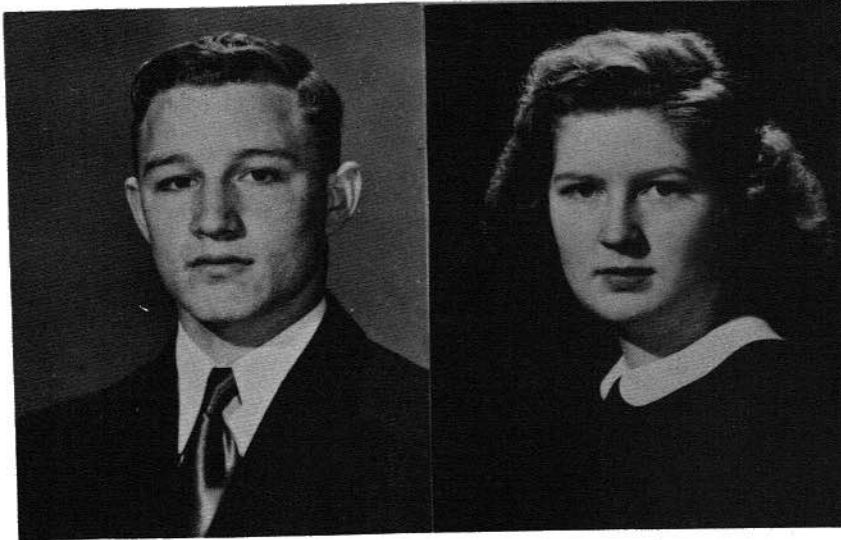
Classmates, this is our hope: "May you forget all the bad we have done but remember the good always."
