1954.



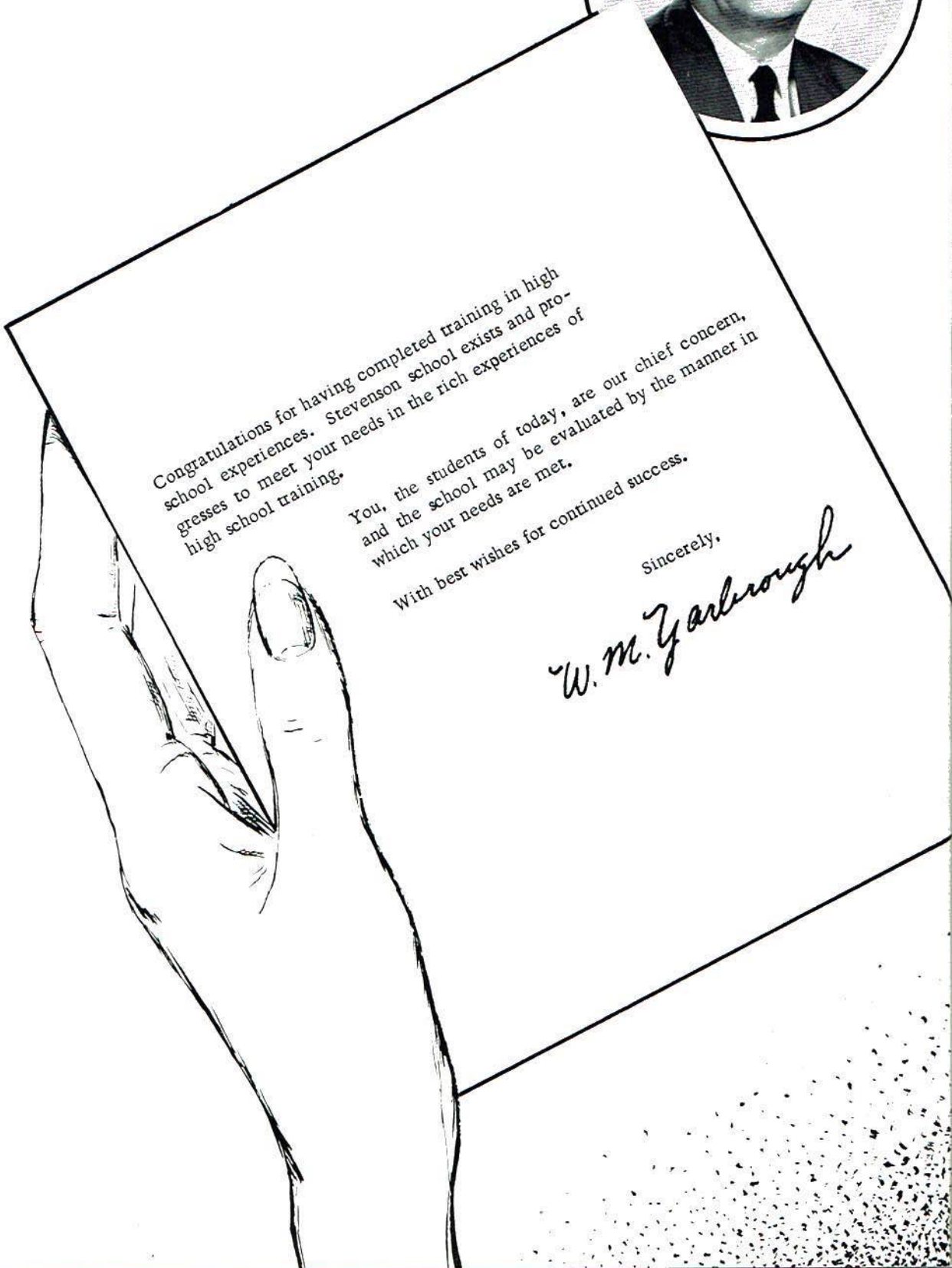
