










Foreword



Mr. Maples has worked hard to remove many of the major deficiencies from our accreditation report. Stevenson High is and has been accredited by the State of Alabama Department of Education.


We, the student body, thank you, Mr. Maples for doing a fine job for us and for our school. Ours is one of the finest schools in Jackson County.


Events in the Life Classes . . . Classes . . .
