












The Class of 1981

There were some mighty big questions that came up in 1980-81 — mighty big. Some of them were answered; some were not. Some probably never will be. Future historians will record some of the answers.








Why do you teach?

Anita won the Junior Miss Physical Fitness Award and placed in the top five scholastically. Both girls showed all of Jackson County the SHS championship style.




















At the State Indoor Meet in February, Rorex won the 880 and the I-mile; and Nerche was second in the 2-mile. The girls' mile relay team placed fifth.

1981 was a very good season; and with most members returning, next year should be just as successfu.


