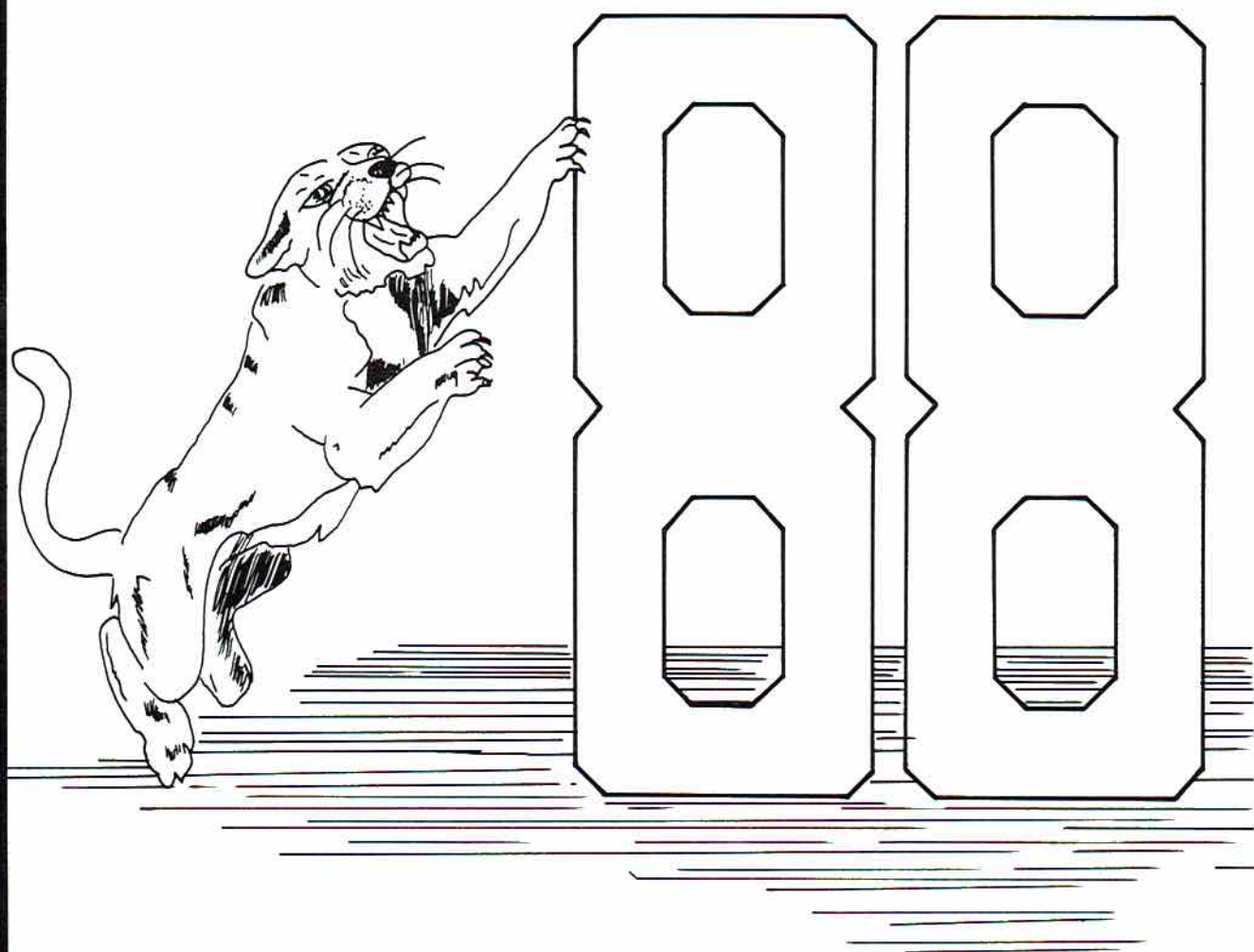

### TO A BELOVED TEACHER

She was born here, she lived here, she worked here, she died here. She was truly one of our own. Therefore, it is with a feeling of pride and deep appreciation that the 1988 PANTHERS TALES staff of Stevenson High School dedicates the last issue of the yearbook to its first principal, Mrs. Mattie Cargile Pittman.

"Miss Mattie" was an excellent teacher — a dedicated teacher — whose high academic standards demanded the very best from her students. She always showed a keen interest in their goals and ambitions. Many former students have received a special message of praise and encouragement from "Miss Mattie" long after they graduated from high school. On the other hand, she had little patience with those who habitually wasted time and opportunities. She was indeed a special lady — one who treated her colleagues and her students with respect. In turn, she expected and received the same from them.

Oliver Goldsmith so aptly described "Miss Mattie" when he described the village master in his poem, "The Deserted Village:"

"Yet she was kind, or, if severe in aught,  
The love she bore to learning was at fault" . . .  
"The village all declared how much she knew," . . .  
"And still they gazed, and still their wonder grew,  
That one small head could carry all she knew."

"Miss Mattie," like the school she loved so much, will continue to live in the hearts and minds of those whose lives she touched.

Mr. Carl Bain

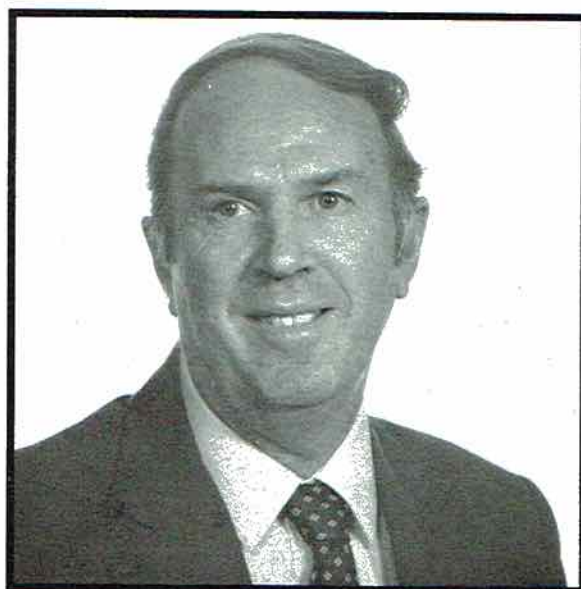

1919-1929

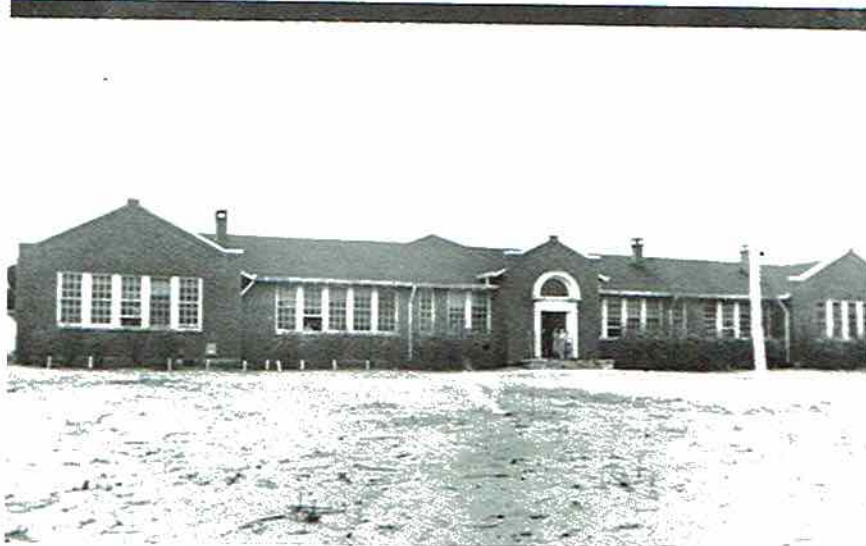
The 1900's began a new era in history for Stevenson. In 1919, the first Stevenson High School, consisting only of the 7th and 8th grades, was housed in the Elementary School Building at the present site of the city cemetery. The first permanent Stevenson High School was built in 1922 at the present site and in 1923 boasted its first graduates. The 1920's brought sports to Stevenson High. The 1920's basketball and 1922 football teams were very competitive. The 1929 football team produced an All-American, D. P. Wimberly, and Mack Stewart went on to pitch for the St. Louis Cardinals. The 1920's were the beginning of 68 years of academic and athletic excellence.
