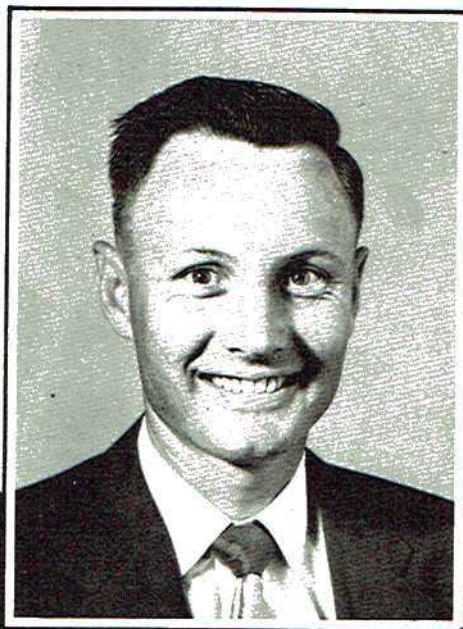

Principal's Message

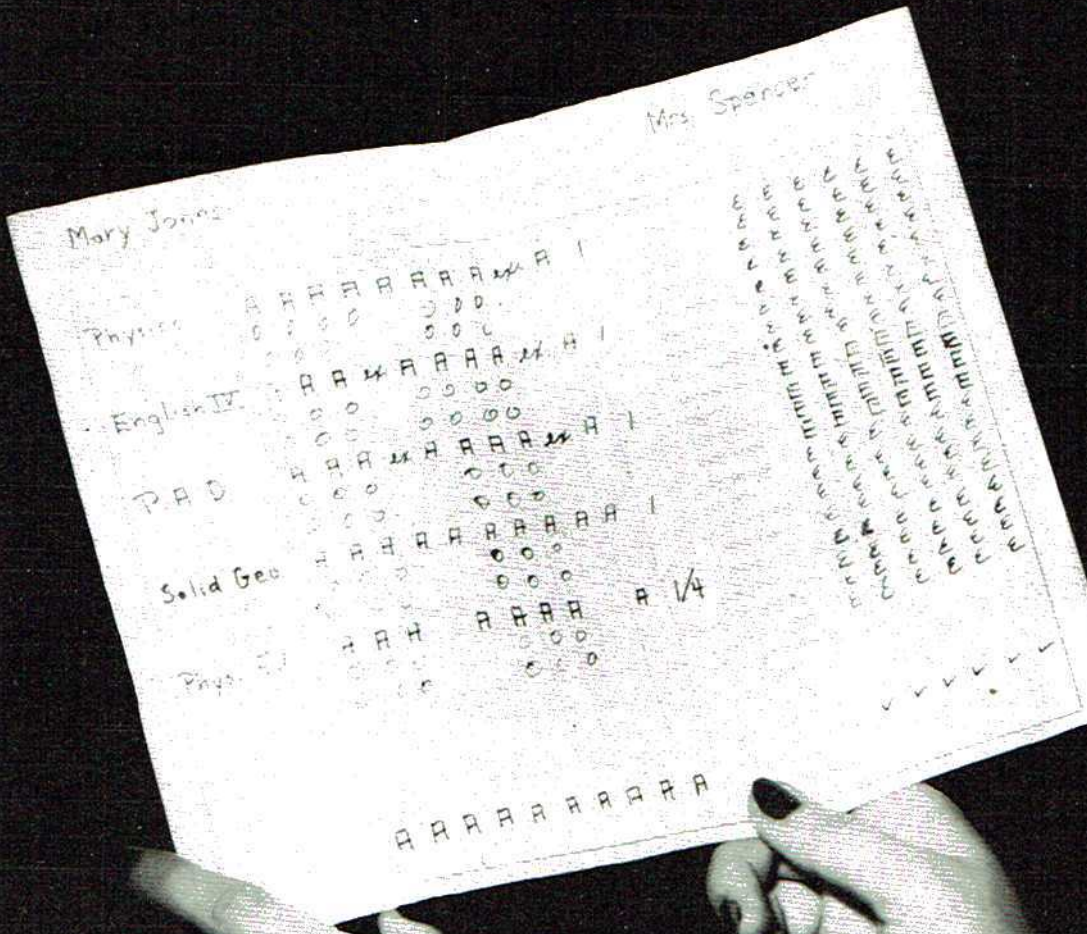


To you, the students of Woodville High School, in this year of our Lord Nineteen Hundred and Fifty Seven, I direct these few thoughts.

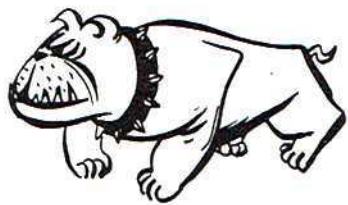

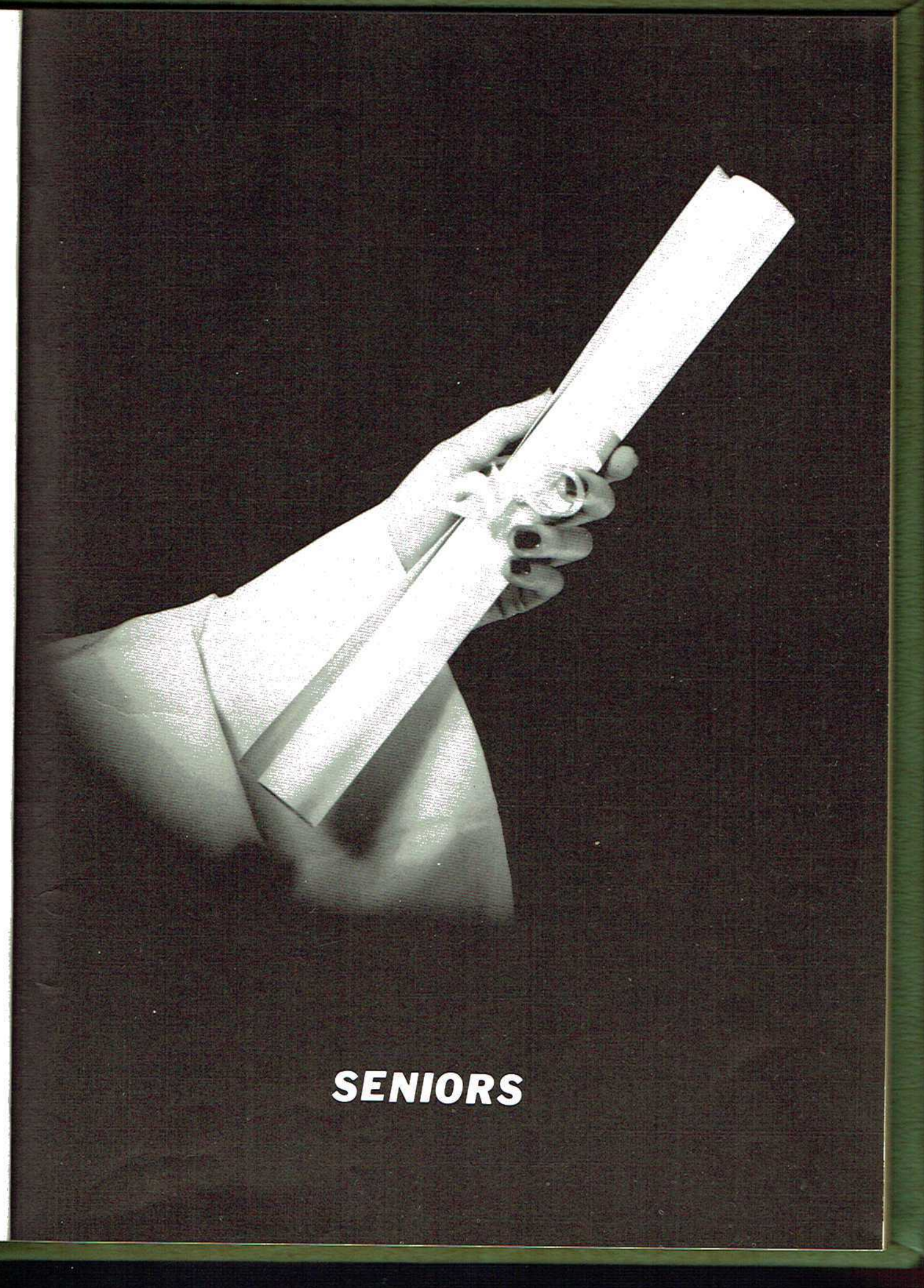

I, Virginia Hopper, am now married and trying to make a good housewife. I believe this is all the crystal ball holds for me.

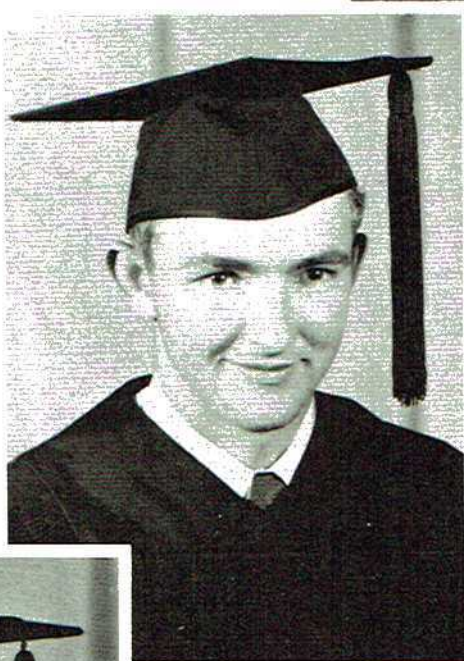
