Ruth Houk is using her athletic build a lot now days. She is the World Heavyweight Lady Wrestler.


Annie Ruth McAllister and Charoltte Pace are busy laying blocks, well, they always said when they graduated people would stop bragging about the Empire State Building.


Bobbie Sue Sheavers is making her living by telling fortunes. She is seldom right, but everyone keeps coming back.
