Miss Skelton is still one of Woodville's most eligible old maids. Of course she is still trying to pound English into a lot of empty headed students.

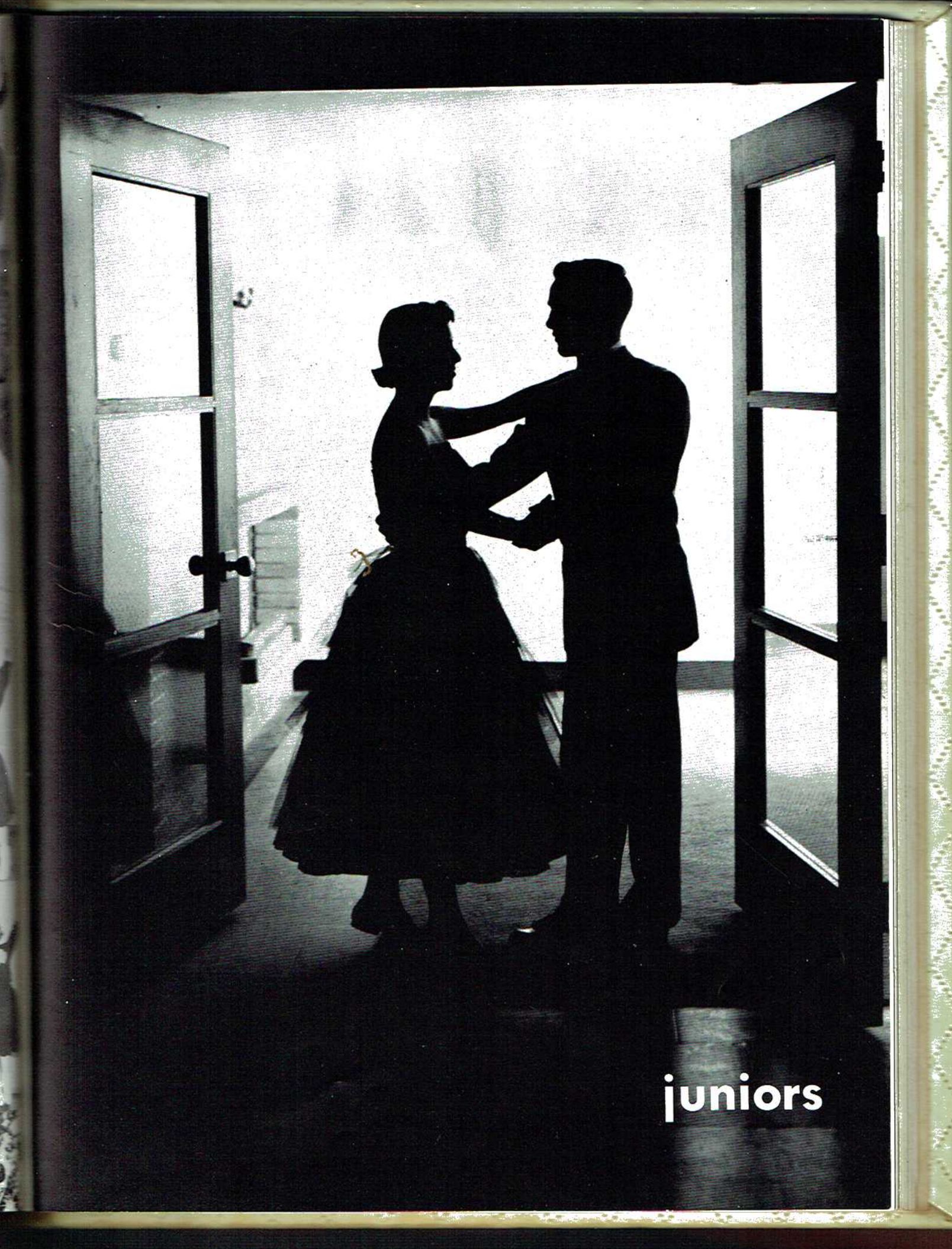
Two final figures appear; it is Ernest White and Tex Miller; they are making a good living as escape artists. Their wives tag along to keep them out of trouble.
