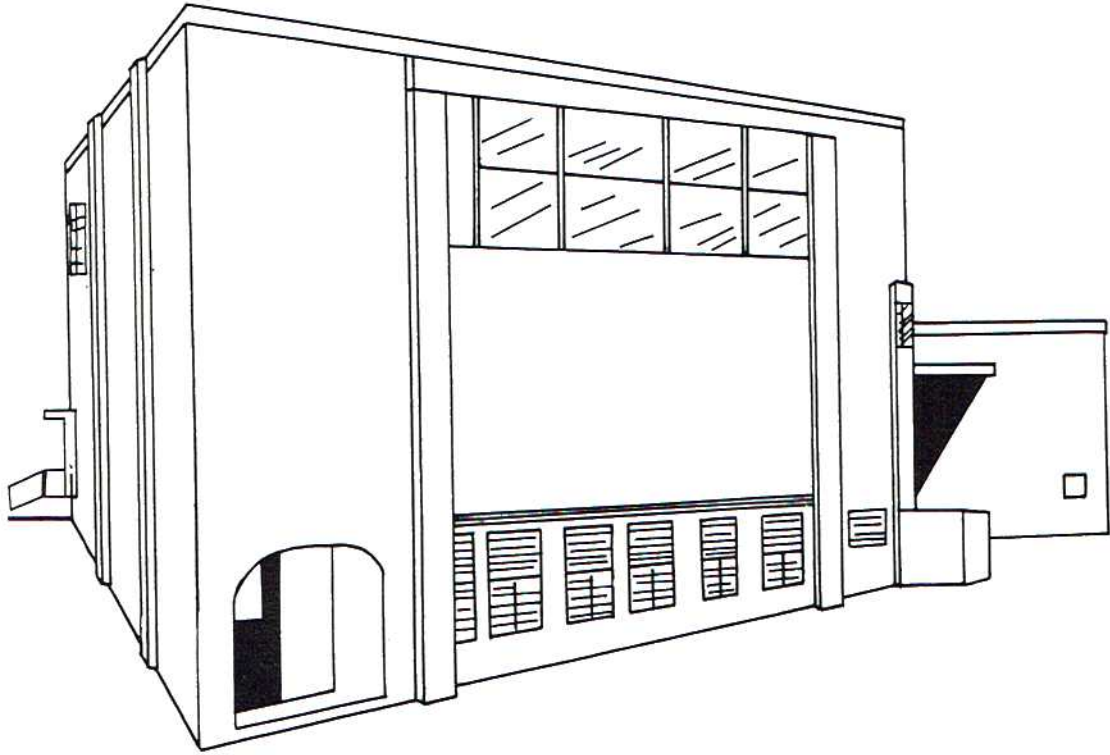

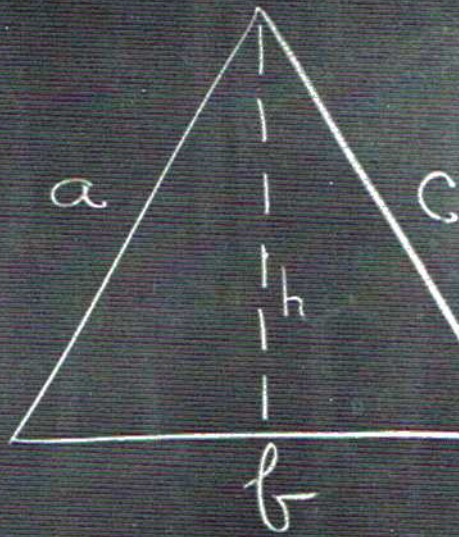
Congratulations on the completion of your high school work. My association with you for the past two years has been a pleasant one.
